#### **Regional Summary:**

- COVID-19 cases
  - o Guam has 7,715 total cases and 130 deaths with 26 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
  - CNMI has 135 total cases and 2 deaths with 1 new case reported this week (imported); no community transmission
  - o RMI has reported 4 total cases identified in mandatory quarantine on Kwajalein military base (all now recovered)
  - American Samoa, FSM, and Palau remain COVID-free
- Testing capacity
  - o All USAPIs have at least Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax NOW, and GeneXpert capacity

- Containment strategies
  - Guam and CNMI are allowing travelers to enter with facility quarantine and testing requirements

  - o FSM and RMI are donor-funded COVAX countries and may receive vaccine through that mechanism
- PPE
  - All USAPI have a stockpile of PPE for COVID-19, though quantities vary






2. Vaccine Delivery in USAPI Jurisdictions (as of 02/19/2021)
