Regional Summary:

- COVID-19 cases
 - Guam has 7,689 total cases and 130 deaths with 53 new cases and 1 new death reported this week
 - CNMI has 134 total cases and 2 deaths with 1 new case reported this week (imported); no community transmission
 - RMI has reported 4 total cases identified in mandatory quarantine on Kwajalein military base (all now recovered)
 - o American Samoa, FSM, and Palau remain COVID-free
- Testing capacity
 - All USAPIs have at least Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax NOW, and GeneXpert capacity
 - o There are currently adequate stocks of tests in the region
- Containment strategies
 - Guam and CNMI are allowing travelers to enter with facility quarantine and testing requirements
 - Palau is allowing essential air service flights from Taiwan and military flights with testing and guarantine requirements
 - American Samoa successfully conducted their first repatriation flight from Honolulu on 2/1 with 159 residents
 - RMI is planning a third repatriation from Honolulu on 2/12 (48 people)
 - o FSM repatriation in on hold until 70% of the population has been vaccinated
- Community mitigation strategies
 - Guam is in PCOR-2 and continues to relax mitigation measures due to decreasing cases
 - o CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed mitigation measures
- Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary Figures, 6 updated tables and figures listed below)
 - o CDC is actively shipping Pfizer (AS, CNMI, Guam) and Moderna (all USAPI) into the region with first and second doses
 - 157,100 doses of vaccine have been delivered to the USAPI
 - 63,847 individuals in the USAPI have received their first dose of vaccine (81% of all first doses received)
 - 22,049 individuals in the USAPI have completed their vaccination (both doses, 29% of all second doses received)
 - All USAPI are actively vaccinating and many are quickly going through February vaccine allocations
 - February waves have been received by all USAPI except for Majuro (reshipping), Chuuk, Pohnpei, and Kosrae
 - Majuro vaccine wasted due to delays and cold chain expiration- reshipping 5,400 Moderna doses in progress
 - o Jurisdictions report that they continue to work at well below their maximum capacity, limited by vaccine supply
 - o Vaccine demand remains high, and jurisdictions estimate over 90% of HCW with first dose of vaccine
 - o To-date, 56% of all USAPI age 65 and older have at least one dose of vaccine (up from 50% last week)
 - o CDC Foundation is working to procure freezers, coolers, temperature loggers, etc. to assist the USAPIs with vaccine distribution
 - Items have been purchased and some coolers have arrived into the region
 - o FSM and RMI are also donor-funded countries for COVAX; Palau is self-funded for COVAX
- PPE
 - o All USAPI have a stockpile of PPE for COVID-19, though quantities vary






2. Vaccine Delivery in USAPI Jurisdictions (as of 02/12/2021)
