

CDC/PIHOA one-on-one USAPI weekly check-ins
Week: 4/24/2021-4/30/2021

Regional Summary:

- COVID-19 cases
 - Guam has reported 7,964 total cases and 136 deaths with 53 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
 - CNMI has reported 166 total cases and 2 deaths with 2 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
 - RMI has reported 4 total cases identified in mandatory quarantine on Kwajalein military base (all imported, and all recovered)
 - American Samoa, FSM, and Palau remain COVID-free
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary Figures, 14 updated tables and figures listed below)
 - ***Congratulations to Palau who has vaccinated 93% of their eligible population!***
 - ***Palau has completed vaccination for 72% of all eligible residents plus 21% additional have received their first dose.***
 - May allocations are coming available this week and still being ordered
 - J3 ordering, delivery, and administration has been renewed
 - Jurisdictions provided requests for “precision” close-out orders
 - April and May orders provide enough vaccine for 100% of 16+/18+ in all USAPI
 - A total of 128,551 people in the region are fully vaccinated (43% of all eligible adults in the region)
 - An additional 33,071 people in the region are partially vaccinated (11% of eligible adults in the region)
 - **American Samoa, CNMI, Palau, and Ebeye have now fully vaccinated at least 50% of their eligible population**
 - ***74% of USAPI adults age 50 and over have received at least one dose of vaccine***
 - 60% or more of adults age 50 and over in Am Sam, Guam, and Palau have completed their COVID-19 vaccination
 - Some USAPI with higher vaccination rates are seeing a reduction in numbers and are working to keep up momentum
 - CDC teams working with USAPI to help counter vaccine hesitancy and misinformation
 - USAPI are using novel private partnerships for delivery methods and community incentives
 - Federal vaccine teams have assisted in USAPI including Palau (completed) and Guam (on-going)
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
 - Guam and CNMI are allowing travelers to enter with facility quarantine and testing requirements
 - Palau is allowing essential air service flights from Taiwan and military flights with testing and quarantine requirements
 - American Samoa has conducted three repatriation flights from Honolulu; regular repat flights ongoing
 - RMI has conducted five repatriation flights from Honolulu; regular repat flights ongoing
 - FSM plans to repatriate its first cohort from Guam to Pohnpei on 5/13, so they are currently preparing
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
 - All USAPI have at least Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax NOW, and GeneXpert capacity
 - At present, there are no shortages of testing kits nor testing supplies in the USAPI region
- Community mitigation strategies
 - Guam is in PCOR-3 and continues to relax mitigation measures
 - CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed most mitigation measures
- PPE: All USAPI have a stockpile of PPE for COVID-19, though quantities vary

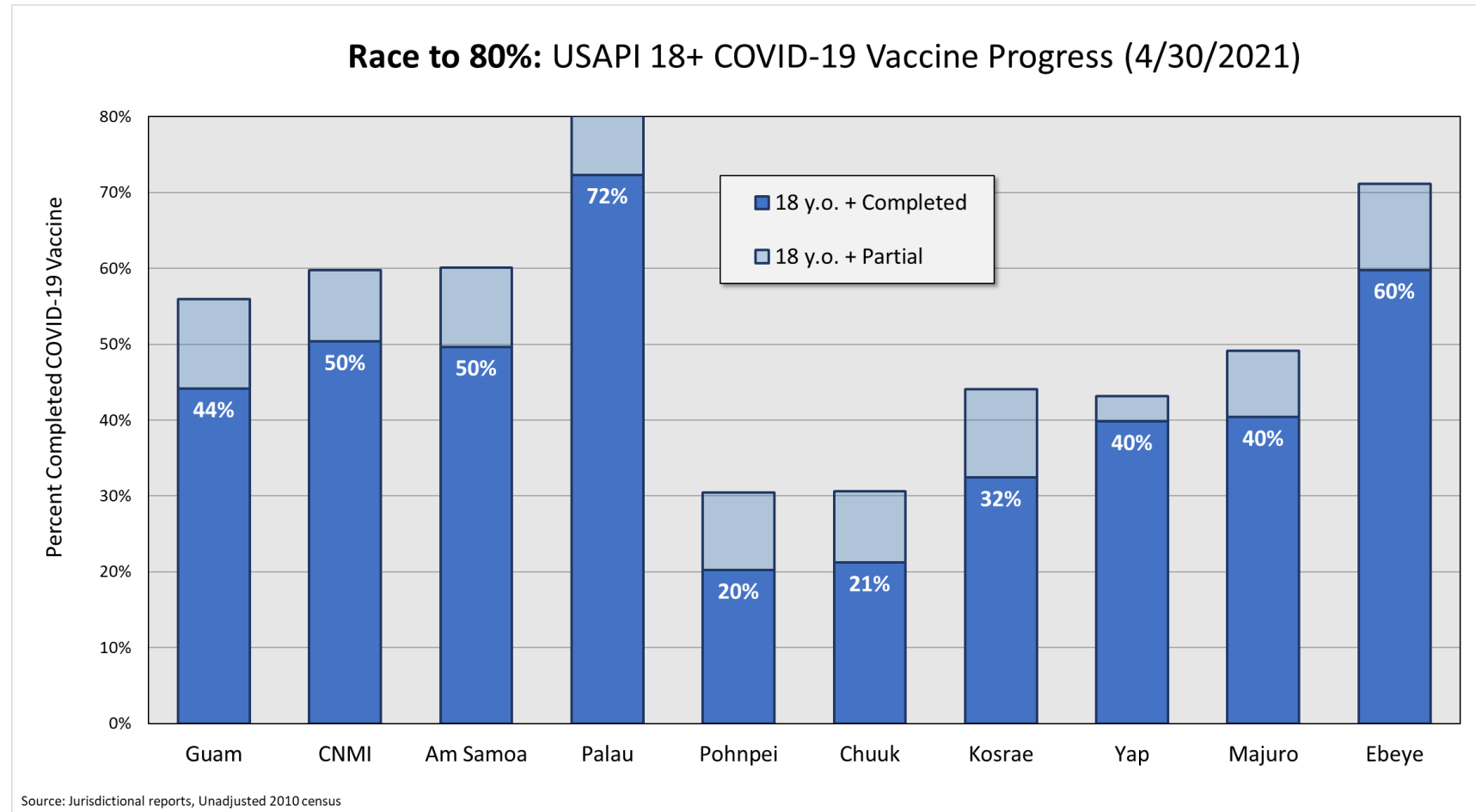

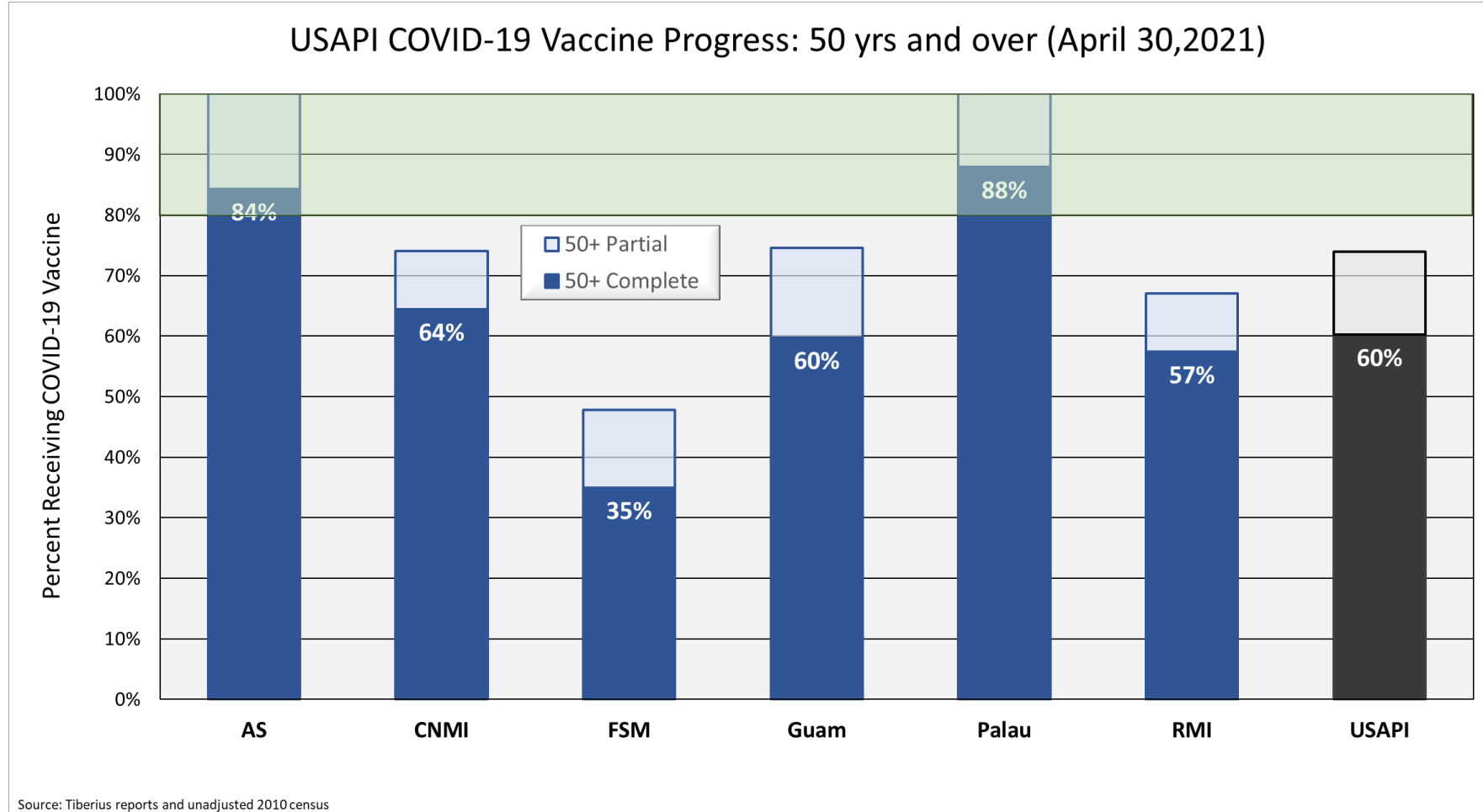

2. "Race to 80%": Percent of population 18+ who have had at least one vaccine dose (as of 04/30/2021)



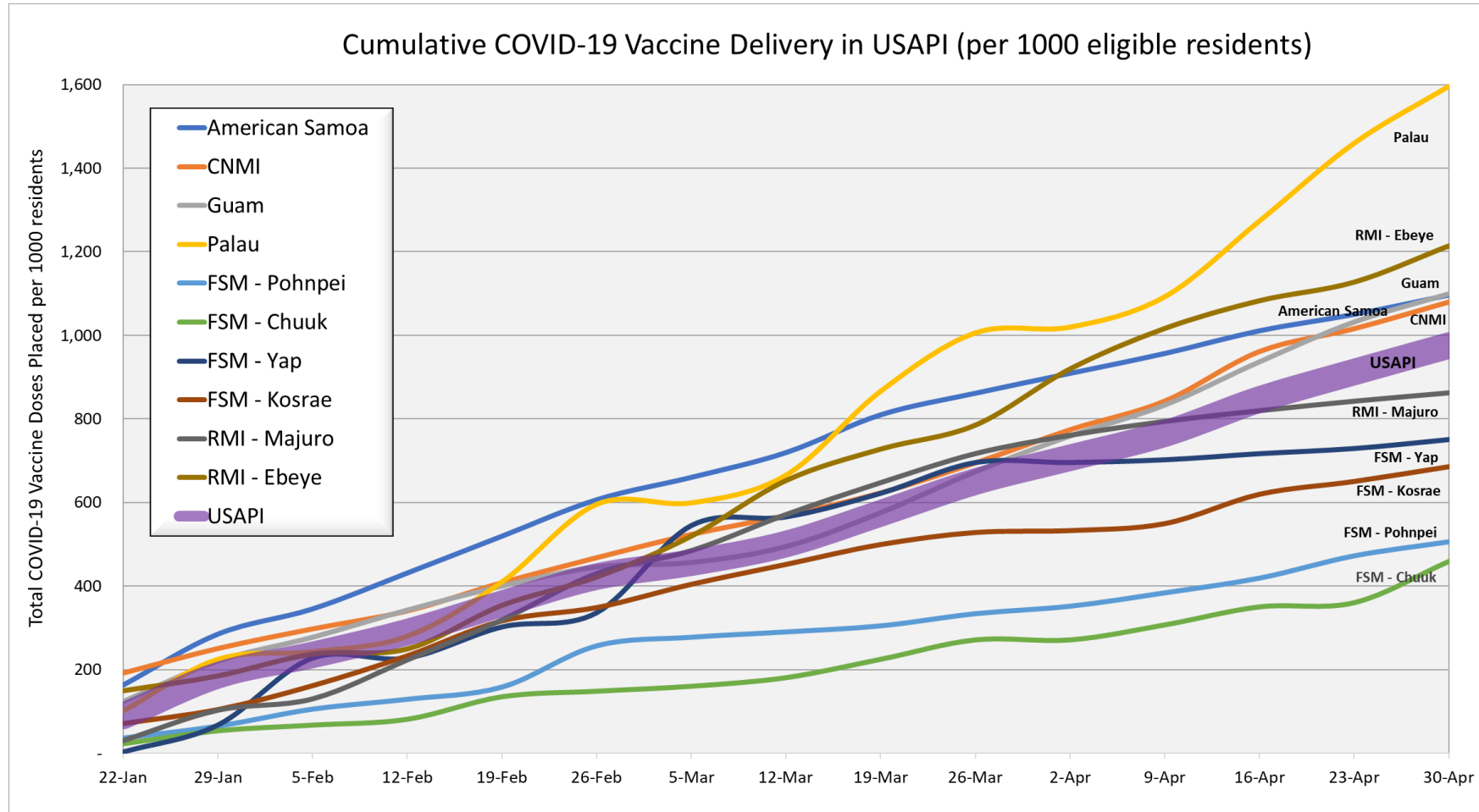

3. Vaccine targets for USAPI Region (as of 04/30/2021)



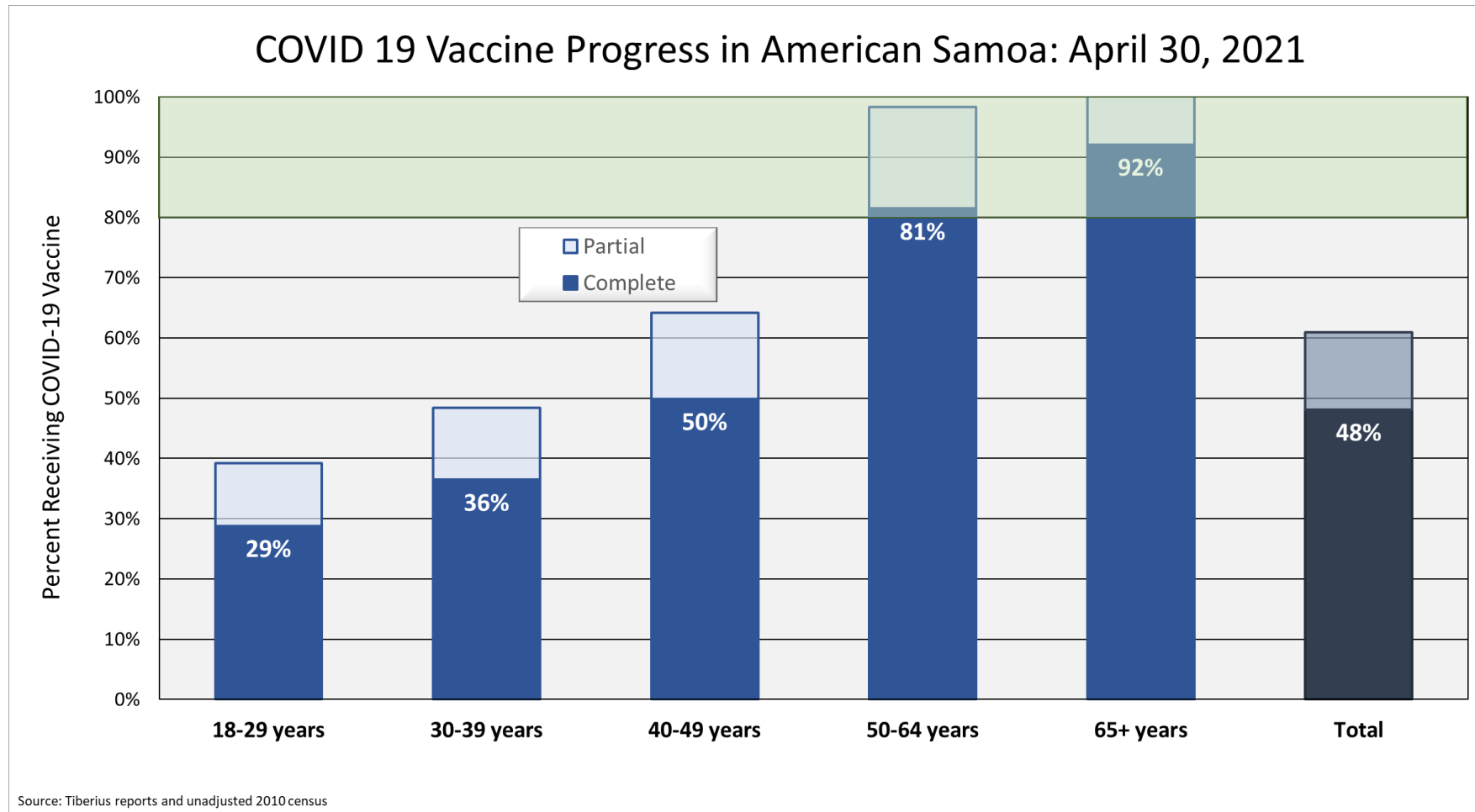

4. Pace of Vaccine Delivery in USAPI as of 04-30-2021



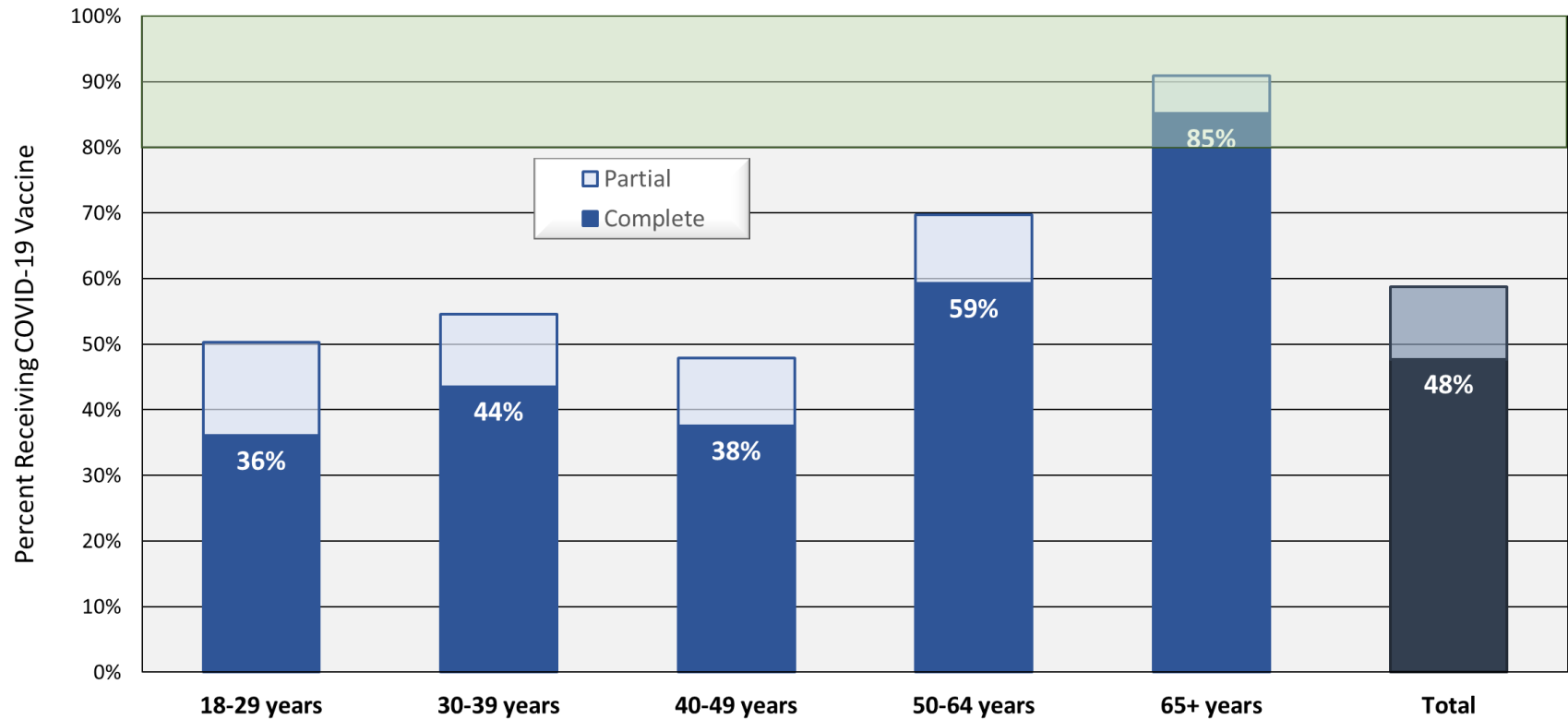

5. Vaccine Delivery to High-Risk Individuals in USAPI Jurisdictions (as of 04/30/2021)



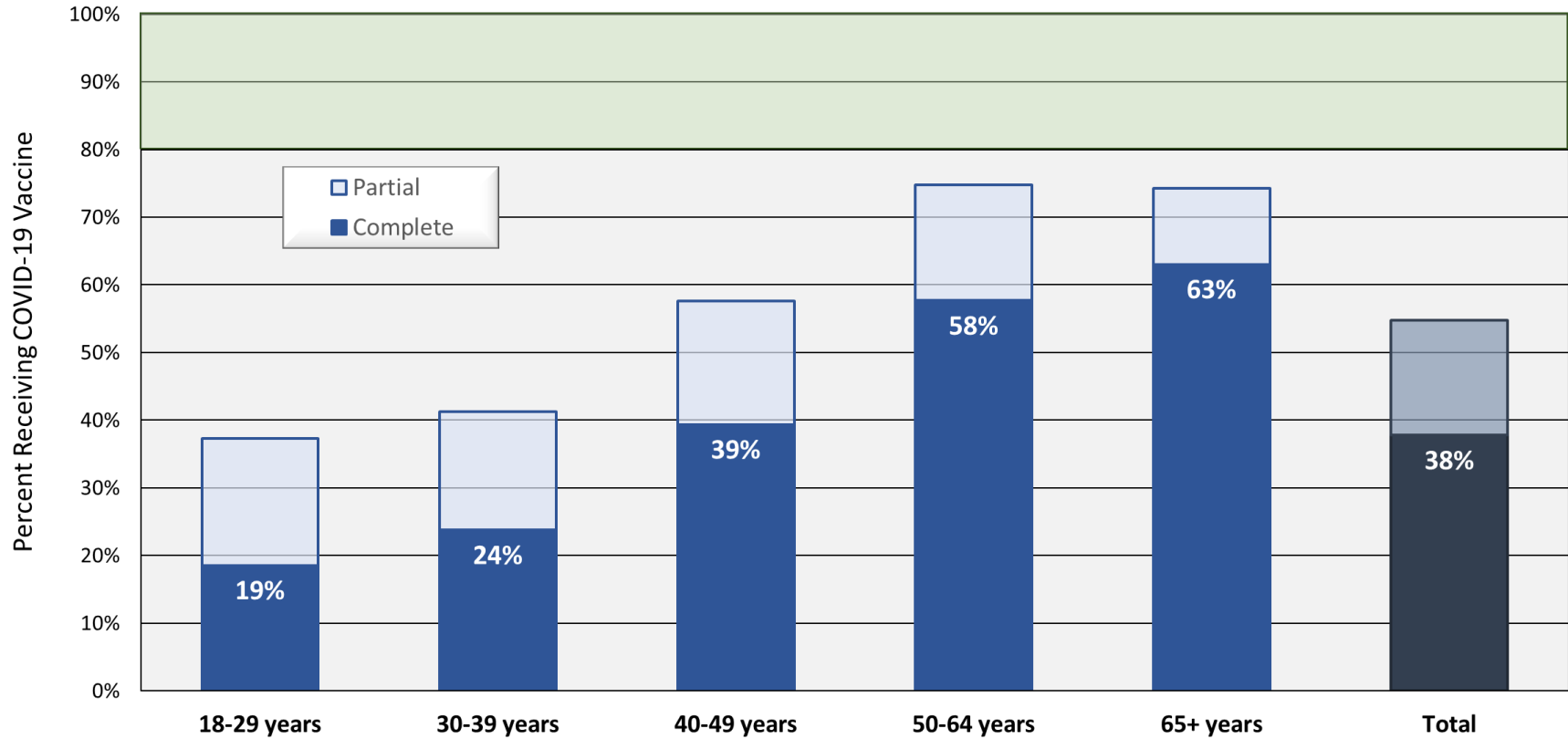

COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Guam: April 30, 2021

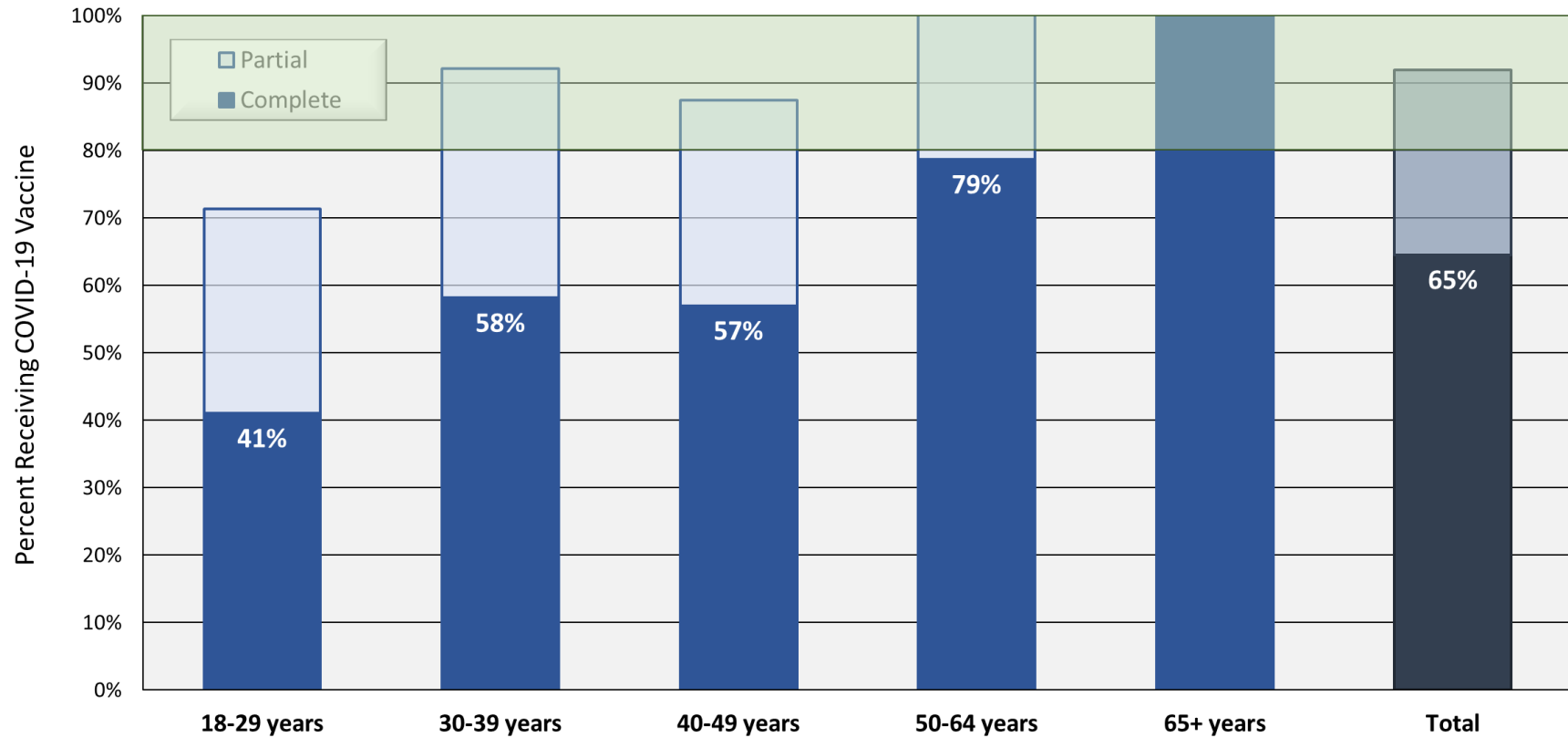

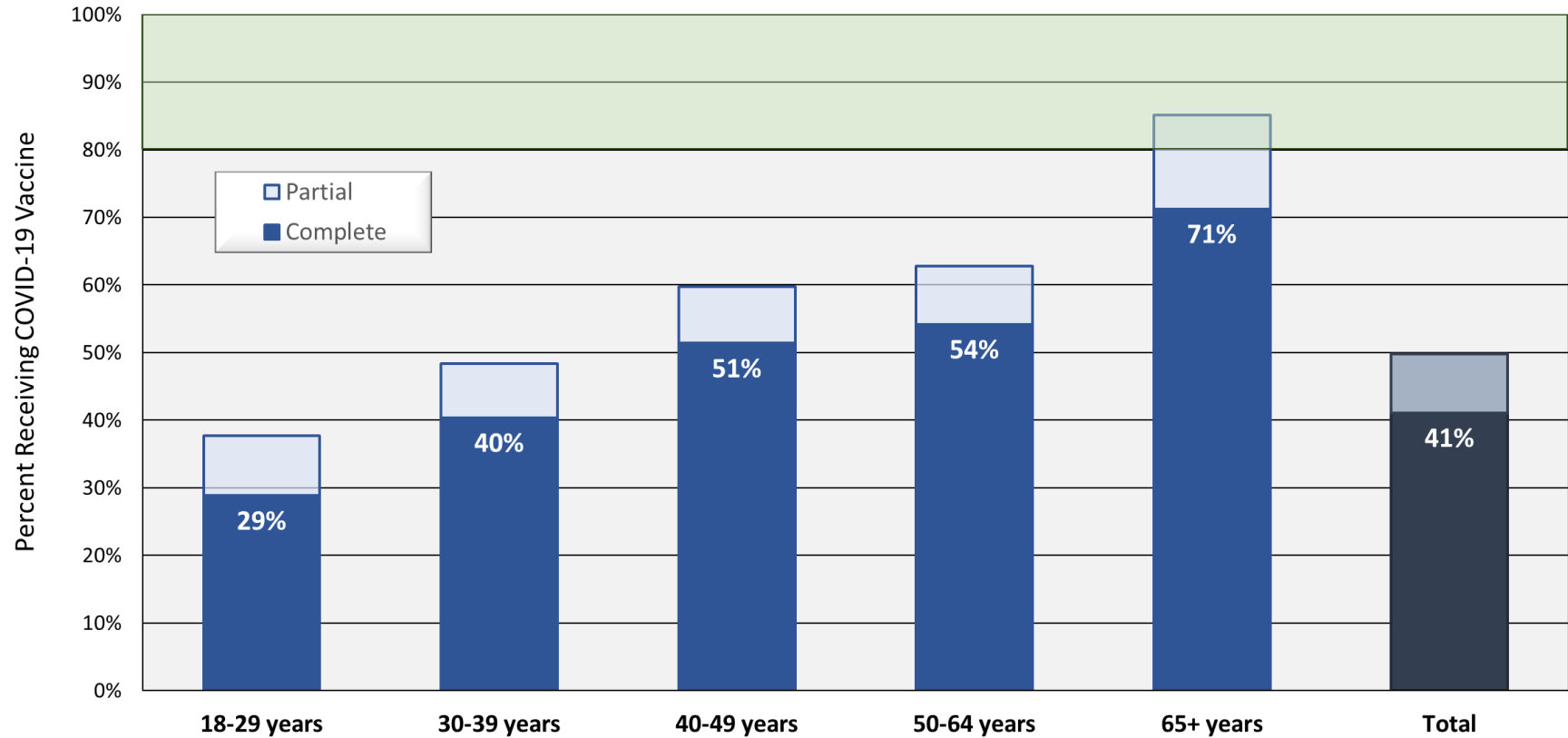
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Palau: April 30, 2021

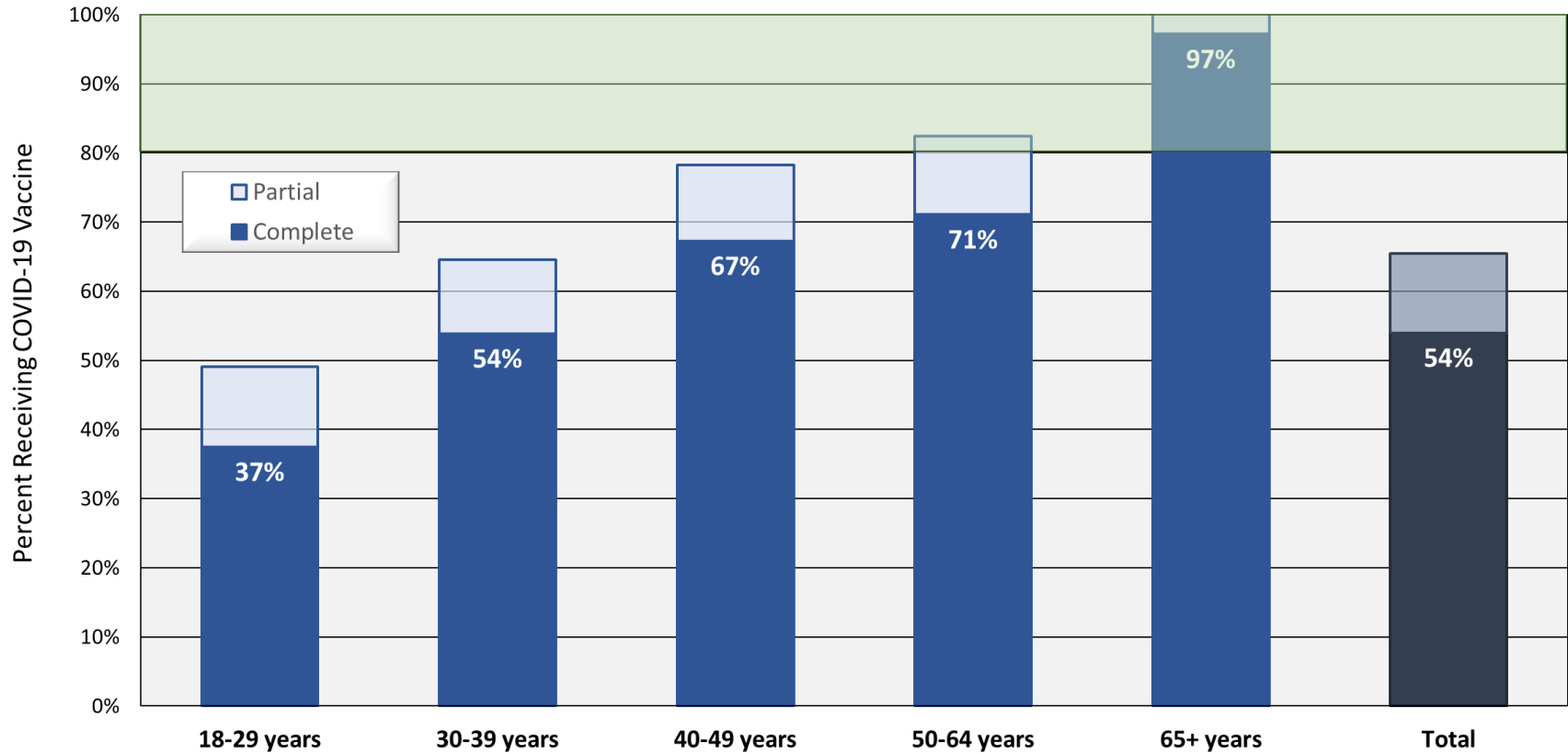
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in RMI: April 30, 2021

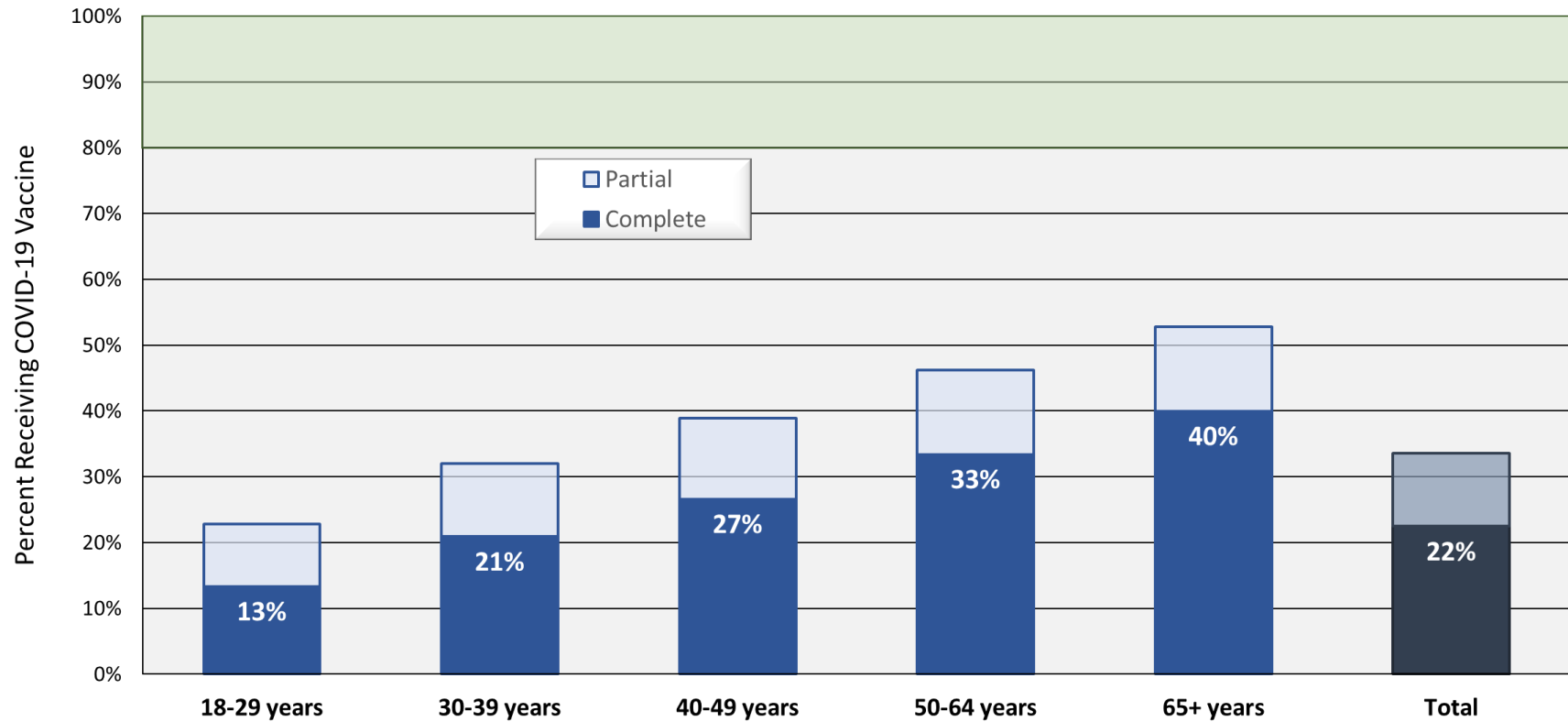

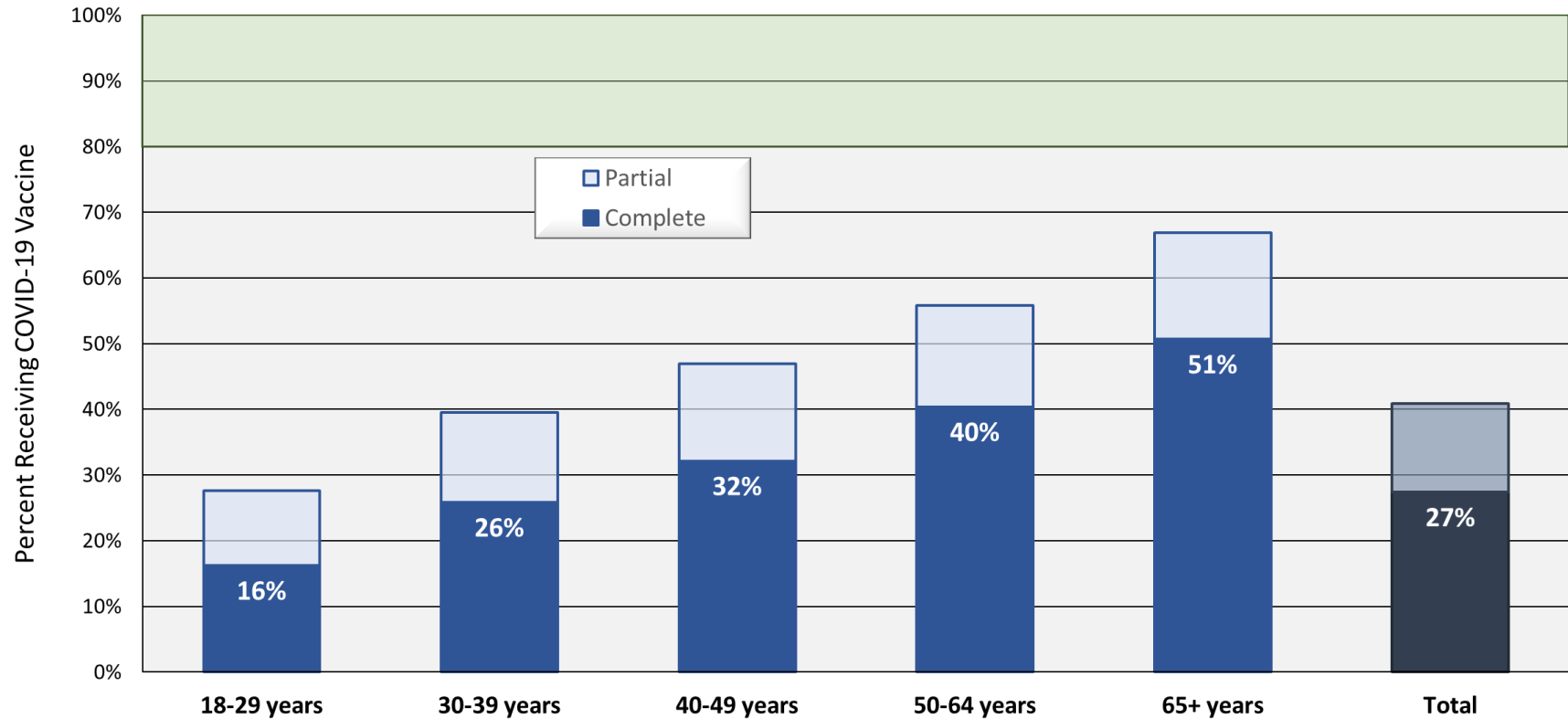
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in FSM: April 30, 2021
