- COVID-19 cases
 - Guam has reported 7,833 total cases and 136 deaths with 21 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
 - CNMI has reported 160 total cases and 2 deaths with 1 new case reported this week (imported)
 - o RMI has reported 4 total cases identified in mandatory quarantine on Kwajalein military base (all imported, and all recovered)
 - o American Samoa, FSM, and Palau remain COVID-free
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary Figures with 10 updated tables and figures listed below)
 - All USAPI residents age 18+ (age 16+ for AS, Guam, CNMI) are now eligible for vaccine
 - o CDC is actively shipping Pfizer (AS, CNMI, Guam), Moderna (all USAPI), and J-3 (all USAPI) into the region with first and second doses
 - April allocation adjusted to "Finish Line" doses and ordering/shipping/delivery on-going
 - April and May orders will provide enough vaccine for 100% of 18+ in all USAPI (16+ in AS, CNMI, Guam)
 - 269,580 doses of Pfizer and Moderna, plus 3,700 J-3 doses have been delivered to the USAPI in total (enough vaccine to fully vaccinate 138,490 people). Additional April orders are shipping.
 - A total of 91,370 people in the region are fully vaccinated (32% of all adults 18+ in the region)
 - An additional 44,756 people in the region are partially vaccinated (16% of all adults in the region)
 - CNMI, Pohnpei, Palau, and Ebeye are now using J3
 - o HRSA clinics across the region are on-boarding as priority sites for vaccine distribution
 - FEMA and HHS partnerships for vaccine delivery are on-going with possible assistance for FSM
 - Vaccine demand remains strong overall in most jurisdictions, but vaccine delivery has slowed in FSM
 - CDC teams working with USAPI to help counter vaccine hesitancy and misinformation
 - USAPI are using novel private partnerships for delivery methods and community incentives
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
 - o Guam and CNMI are allowing travelers to enter with facility quarantine and testing requirements
 - o Palau is allowing essential air service flights from Taiwan and military flights with testing and quarantine requirements
 - o American Samoa currently has residents in quarantine in Honolulu for its fifth repatriation flight on 4/15 (236 pax)
 - o RMI currently has residents in quarantine in Hawaii (77 pax) for its fifth repatriation flight and will continue with monthly flights
 - o FSM plans to repatriate its first cohort from Guam to Pohnpei on 5/13 so they are currently preparing
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
 - o All USAPI have at least Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax NOW, and GeneXpert capacity
 - o There are currently adequate stocks of tests in the region
- Community mitigation strategies
 - $\circ\quad$ Guam is in PCOR-3 and continues to relax mitigation measures
 - o CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed most or all mitigation measures






2. "Race to 80%": Percent of population 18+ who have had at least one vaccine dose (as of 04/09/2021)




3. Vaccine targets for USAPI Region (as of 04/10/2021)





4. Pace of Vaccine Delivery in USAPI





5. Vaccine Delivery to High-Risk Individuals in USAPI Jurisdictions (as of 04/10/2021)







