

**CDC/PIHOA one-on-one USAPI weekly check-ins**  
**Week: 5/15/2021-5/21/2021**

**Regional Summary:**

- COVID-19 cases
  - Guam has reported 8,131 total cases and 139 deaths with 52 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
  - CNMI has reported 176 total cases and 2 deaths with 4 new cases (imported) and 0 new deaths reported this week
  - American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary Figures, 18 updated tables and figures listed below)
  - A total of 152,034 people in the region are fully vaccinated (50% of all eligible adults in the region)
    - An additional 25,346 people in the region are partially vaccinated (8% of eligible adults in the region)
  - **80% of USAPI main-island residents age 50 and over have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine**
  - **60% of USAPI main-island residents age 18/16 and over have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine**
  - **Palau reports 88% completion coverage for all residents age 18 and over**
  - **Guam joins Am Samoa, CNMI, Palau, Majuro Proper, Ebeye, and Yap Proper to reach at least 50% fully vaccinated (eligible)**
  - April and May orders provide enough vaccine for 100% of 16+/18+ in all USAPI
  - Guam, CNMI, and Am Samoa have initiated vaccinations for 12 to 15 yrs with Pfizer vaccine
    - Additional allocations are expected for adolescent vaccinations with Pfizer
  - Outer island vaccinations are in progress in Majuro, Ebeye, Chuuk, Palau and are planned for Yap and Pohnpei in June
  - USAPI jurisdictions are reporting a slowdown in vaccination rate and are working to keep up momentum
    - USAPI Programs want Incentives to improve community participation, but funding/coordination not clear yet
    - Some USAPI with lower vaccination rates have indicated the need for more staff
  - Federal vaccine teams have assisted USAPI including Palau (completed), Guam (on-going), and CNMI (on-going)
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
  - Guam and CNMI are allowing travelers with facility quarantine and testing requirements (some exceptions for vaccinated travelers)
  - Palau is allowing flights from Taiwan and military flights with testing and quarantine requirements and will soon open Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (restricted movement instead)
  - AS has conducted four repatriation flights; regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/AS quarantine and testing requirements
  - RMI has conducted five repatriation flights; regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/RMI quarantine and testing requirements
  - FSM repatriated its first cohort from Guam to Pohnpei last week (42 stranded residents and diplomats)
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
  - All USAPI have at least Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax NOW, and GeneXpert capacity
  - At present, there are no shortages of testing kits nor testing supplies in the USAPI region
- Community mitigation strategies
  - Guam is in PCOR-3 and continues to relax mitigation measures
  - CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed most mitigation measures
- PPE: All USAPI have a stockpile of PPE for COVID-19, though quantities vary





3. "Race to 80%": Percent of population 18+ who have had at least one vaccine dose (as of 05/22/2021)






FSM COVID-19 Vaccine Progress: 50 yrs and over (May 22, 2021)



5. Pace of Vaccine Delivery in USAPI (as of 05-22-2021)






## COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in CNMI: May 22, 2021


## COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Guam: May 22, 2021


## COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Palau: May 22, 2021

## COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in RMI: May 22, 2021




## COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in RMI (Main Islands): May 22, 2021




## COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in FSM (Main Islands): May 22, 2021


## COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Pohnpei (Main Islands): May 22, 2021


## COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Chuuk (Main Islands): May 22, 2021


## COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Kosrae: May 22, 2021
