#### **Regional Summary:**

- COVID-19 cases
  - o Guam has reported 8,156 total cases and 139 deaths with 25 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
  - CNMI has reported 183 total cases and 2 deaths with 7 new cases (imported) and 0 new deaths reported this week
  - American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary Figures, 18 updated tables and figures listed below)
  - A total of 160,905 people in the region are fully vaccinated (50% of all eligible individuals in the region)
    - An additional 20,622 people in the region are partially vaccinated (6% of individuals in the region)
    - NOTE: The "number eligible" was expanded this week to include 12 and older residents in AS, CNMI, and Guam
  - For progress towards the Presidents National Goal of 70% of all adults with at least 1 dose by July 4, 2021:
    - Completed: Palau (98%), Ebeye and Majuro Proper (72%)
    - Expected to Complete: American Samoa (67%), Guam (64%), CNMI (69%), Yap Proper (68%)
    - Not Expected to Complete: Chuuk Lagoon (51%), Pohnpei Proper (47%), Kosrae (50%), Outer Islands of RMI and FSM
  - o 80% of all USAPI residents age 50 and over have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine
  - o 61% of all USAPI residents age 18/16 and over have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine
  - Palau reports 96% completion coverage for all residents age 18 and over
  - o Guam joins Am Samoa, CNMI, Palau, Majuro Proper, Ebeye, and Yap Proper to reach at least 50% fully vaccinated (eligible)
  - USAPI Programs want Incentives to improve community participation, but funding/coordination not clear yet
  - o Outer island vaccinations are in progress in Majuro, Ebeye, Chuuk, Palau and are planned for Yap and Pohnpei in June
  - o Guam, CNMI, and Am Samoa have initiated vaccinations for 12 to 15 yrs with Pfizer vaccine
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
  - o Guam and CNMI are allowing travelers with facility quarantine and testing requirements (some exceptions for vaccinated travelers)
  - Palau is allowing flights from Taiwan and military flights with testing and quarantine requirements and will soon open Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (restricted movement instead)
  - AS has conducted four repatriation flights; regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/AS quarantine and testing requirements
  - RMI has conducted five repatriation flights; regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/RMI quarantine and testing requirements
  - o FSM has repatriated one cohort from Guam to Pohnpei (42 stranded residents and diplomats)
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
  - o All USAPI have at least Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax NOW, and GeneXpert capacity
  - At present, there are no shortages of testing kits nor testing supplies in the USAPI region
- Community mitigation strategies
  - Guam is in PCOR-3 and continues to relax mitigation measures
  - o CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed most mitigation measures
- PPE: All USAPI have a stockpile of PPE for COVID-19, though quantities vary






3. "Race to 80%": Percent of population 18+ who have had at least one vaccine dose (as of 05/29/2021)

4. Vaccine targets for USAPI Region (as of 05/29/2021)








5. Pace of Vaccine Delivery in USAPI (as of 05-29-2021)





6. Vaccine Delivery in USAPI Jurisdictions by Age (as of 05/29/2021)


















