Week: 5/29/2021-6/4/2021

Regional Summary:

- COVID-19 cases
 - Guam has reported 8,204 total cases and 139 deaths with 48 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
 - CNMI has reported 183 total cases and 2 deaths with 0 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
 - American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
 - A total of 166,778 people in the region are fully vaccinated (52% of all eligible individuals in the region)
 - An additional 22,182 people in the region are partially vaccinated (6% of individuals in the region)
 - For progress towards the Presidents National Goal of 70% of all adults with at least 1 dose by July 4, 2021:
 - USAPI Region is at 62.4% overall and needs to vaccinate 830 new persons each day to reach our July 4th goal
 - **Already Completed: Palau (100%), Kwajalein (79%), Majuro Proper (72%), CNMI (70%), Yap Proper (74%)**
 - Expected to Complete: American Samoa (69.9%), Guam (65.2%)
 - Not Expected to Complete: Chuuk Lagoon (47%), Pohnpei Proper (43%), Kosrae (50%), Outer Islands of RMI and FSM
 - **82% of USAPI residents at highest risk for COVID hospitalization (age 50 and over) have at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine**
 - **65% of all USAPI main island residents age 18/16 and over have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine**
 - **Palau reports 100% vaccine completion for all residents age 18 and over**
 - USAPI Programs want incentives to improve community participation
 - Local funding submittals, federal approvals, and national coordination for incentives are still incomplete/pending
 - Outer island vaccinations are in progress in Majuro, Ebeye, Chuuk, Palau and are planned for Yap and Pohnpei in June
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
 - Guam and CNMI are allowing travelers with facility quarantine and testing requirements (some exceptions for vaccinated travelers)
 - Palau is allowing flights from Taiwan (temporarily paused due to Taiwan clusters) and military flights with testing and quarantine requirements and will soon open Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (restricted movement instead)
 - AS has conducted five repatriation flights; regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/AS quarantine and testing requirements
 - RMI has conducted eight repatriation flights; regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/RMI quarantine and testing requirements
 - FSM has repatriated one cohort from Guam to Pohnpei (42 stranded residents and diplomats)
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
 - All USAPI have at least Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax NOW, and GeneXpert capacity
 - At present, there are no shortages of testing kits nor testing supplies in the USAPI region
- Community mitigation strategies
 - Guam is in PCOR-3 and continues to relax mitigation measures
 - CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed most mitigation measures
- PPE: All USAPI have a stockpile of PPE for COVID-19, though quantities vary

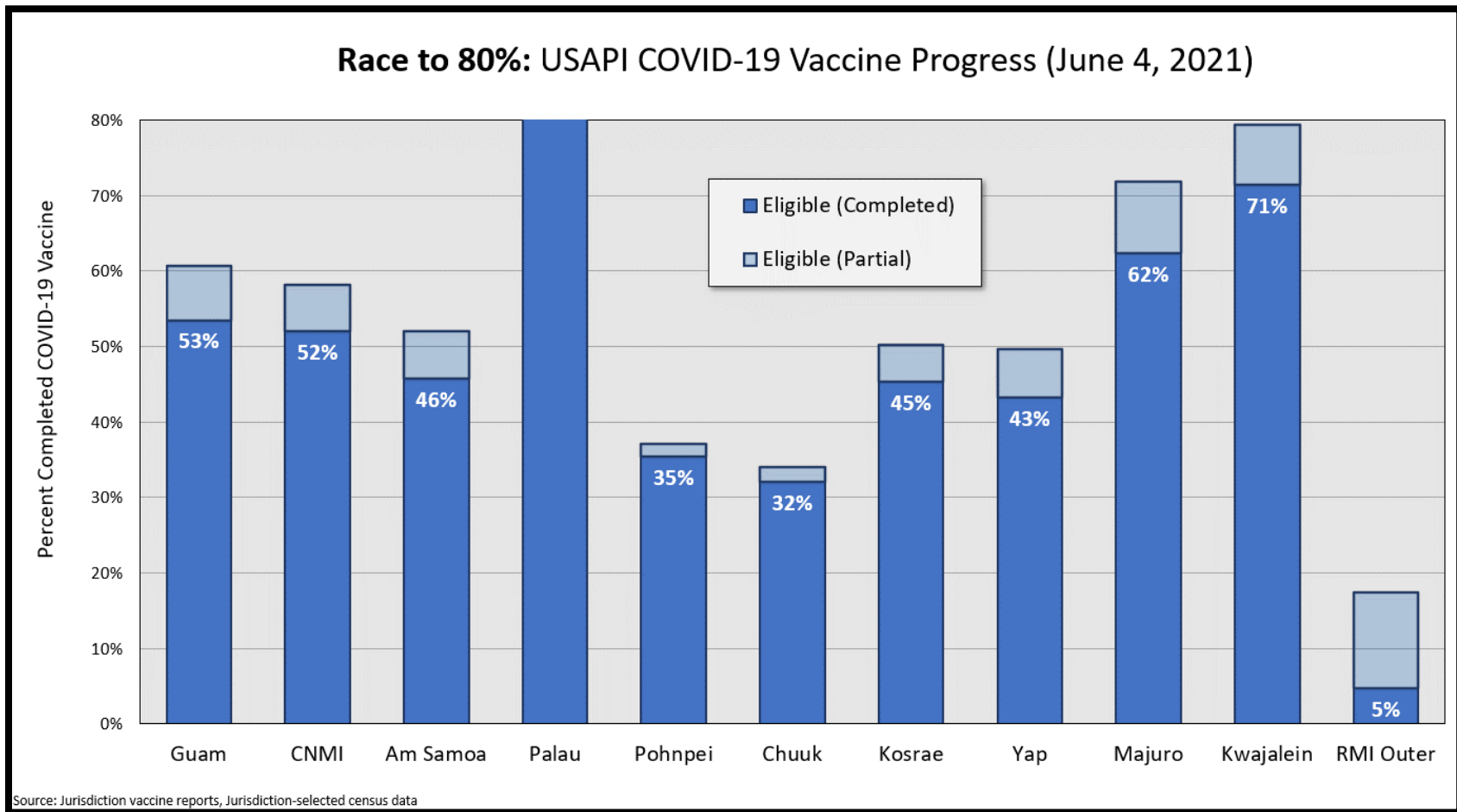

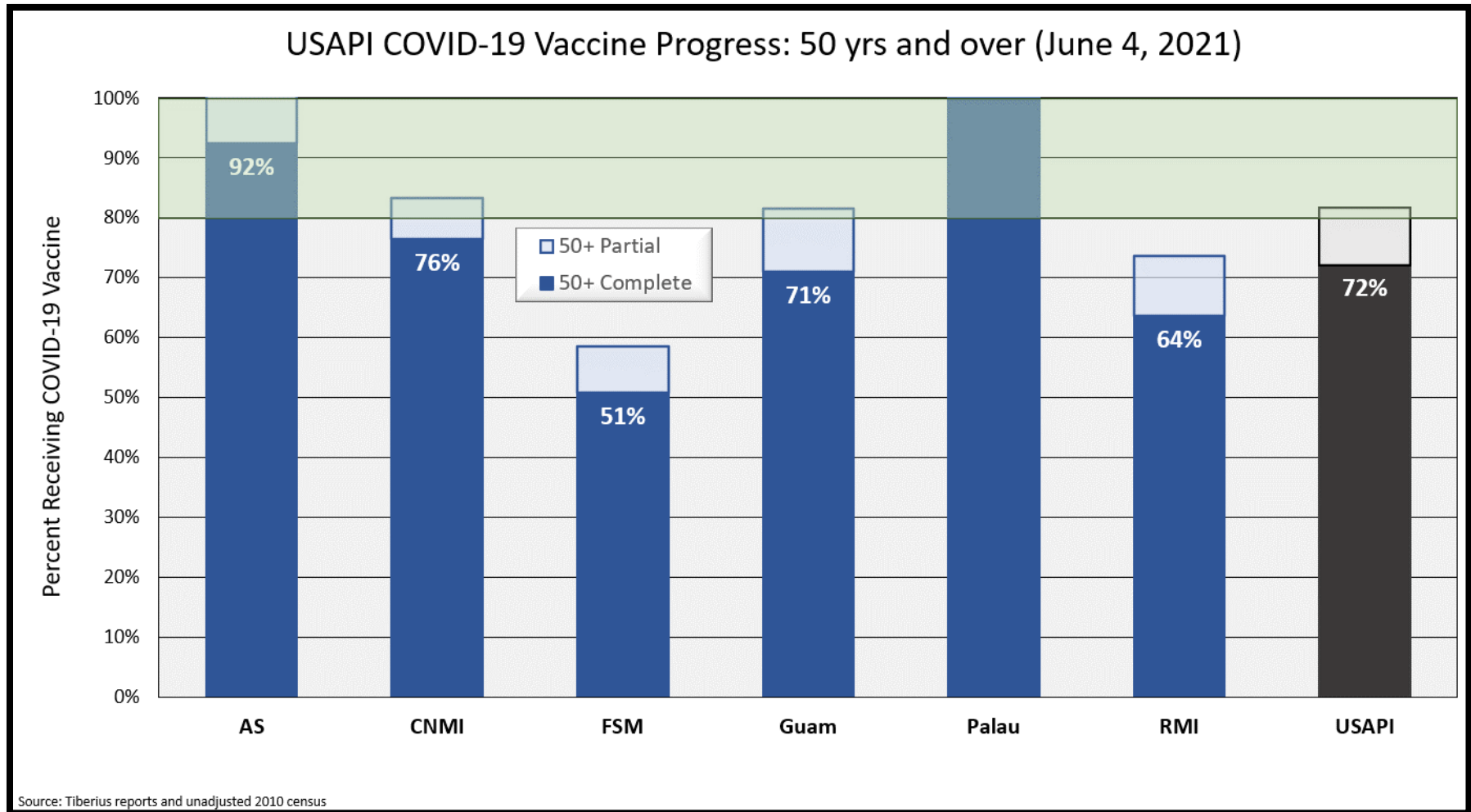

5. "Race to 80%": Percent of eligible population with at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine



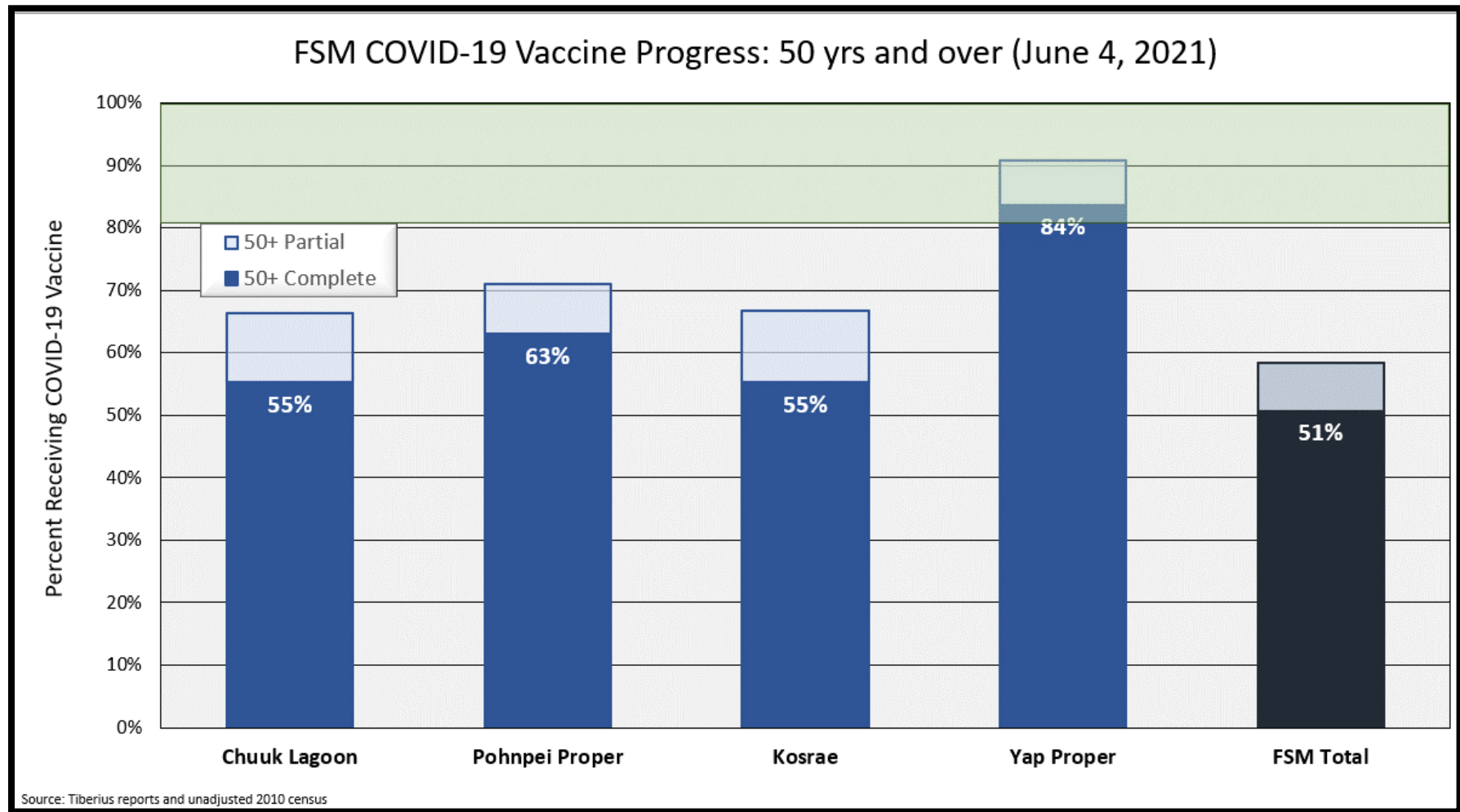

6. Protecting the Most Vulnerable in the USAPI: Vaccine Progress for 50 years and over



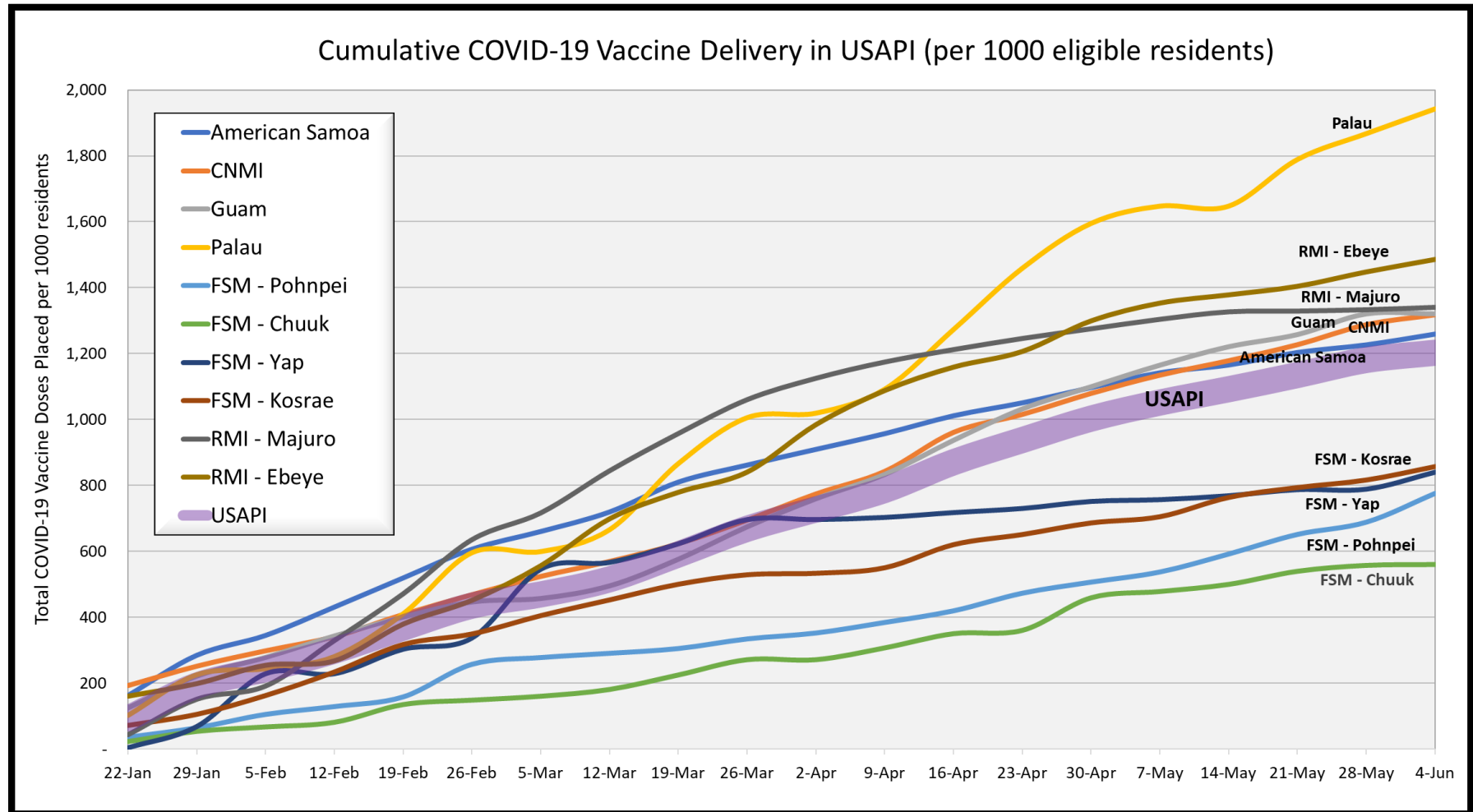

7. Protecting the Most Vulnerable in the Federated States of Micronesia: Vaccine Progress for 50 years and over



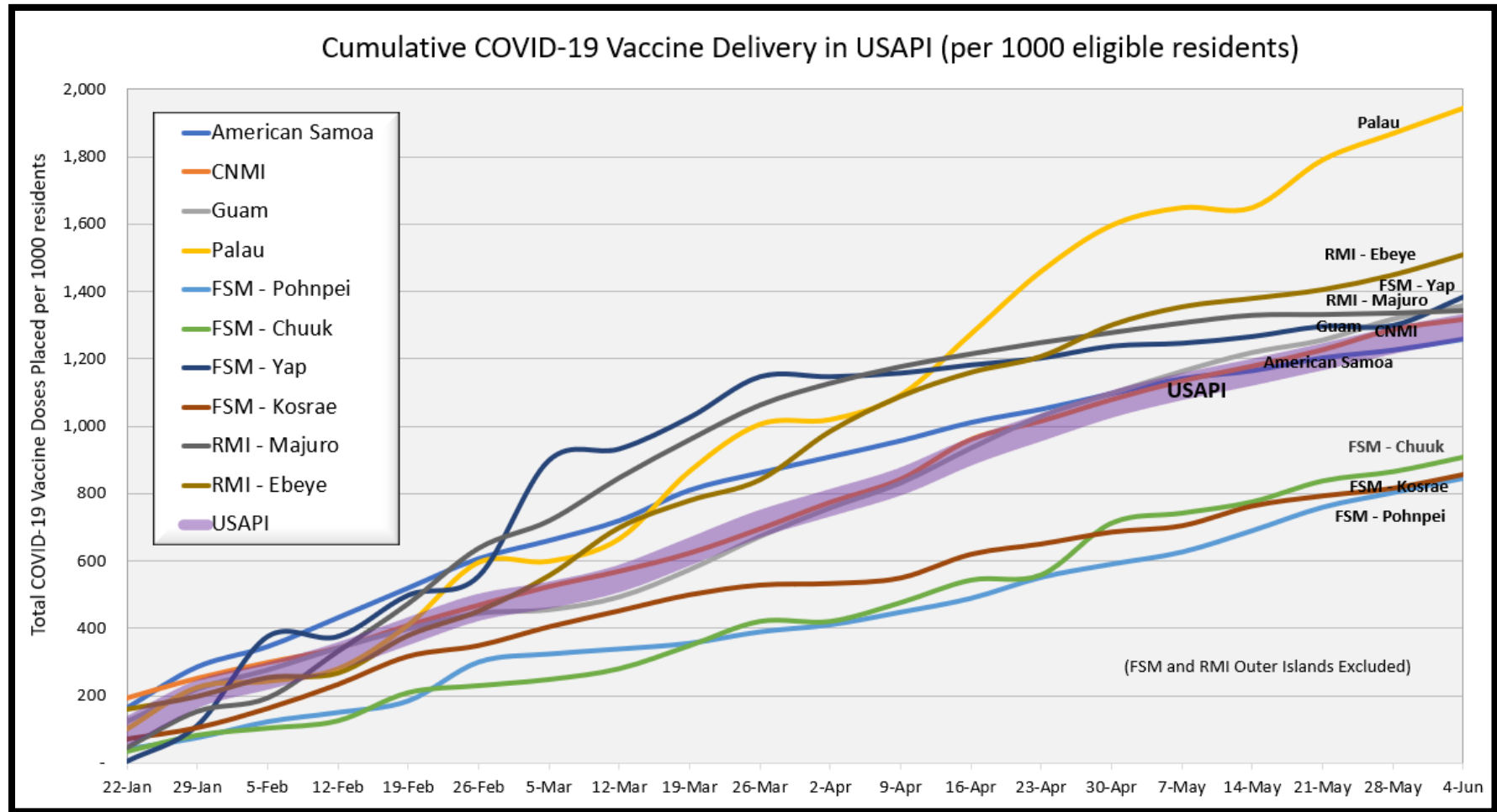

8. Pace of Vaccine Delivery in USAPI (including the FSM outer islands)



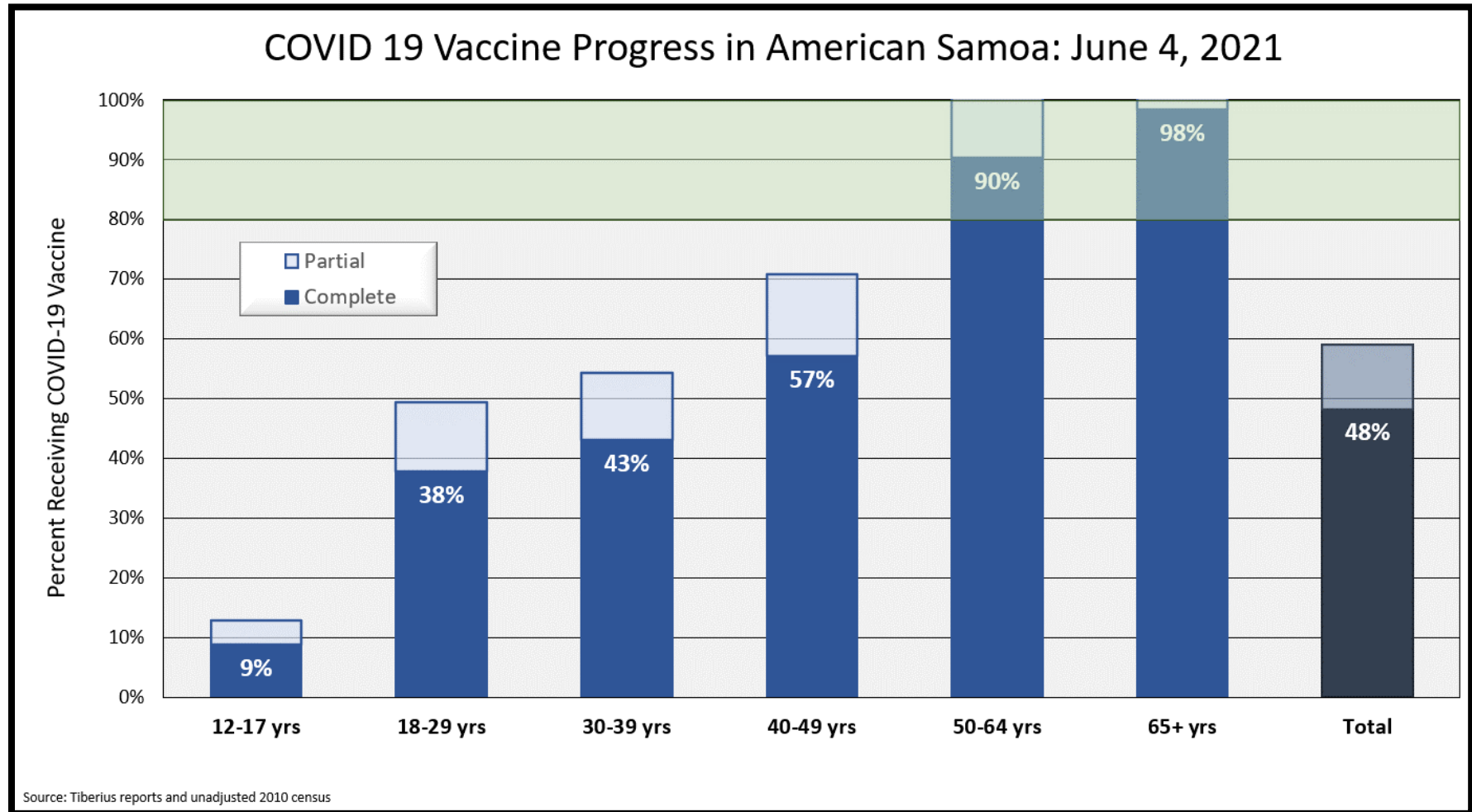

9. Pace of Vaccine Delivery in USAPI (excluding the FSM outer islands)



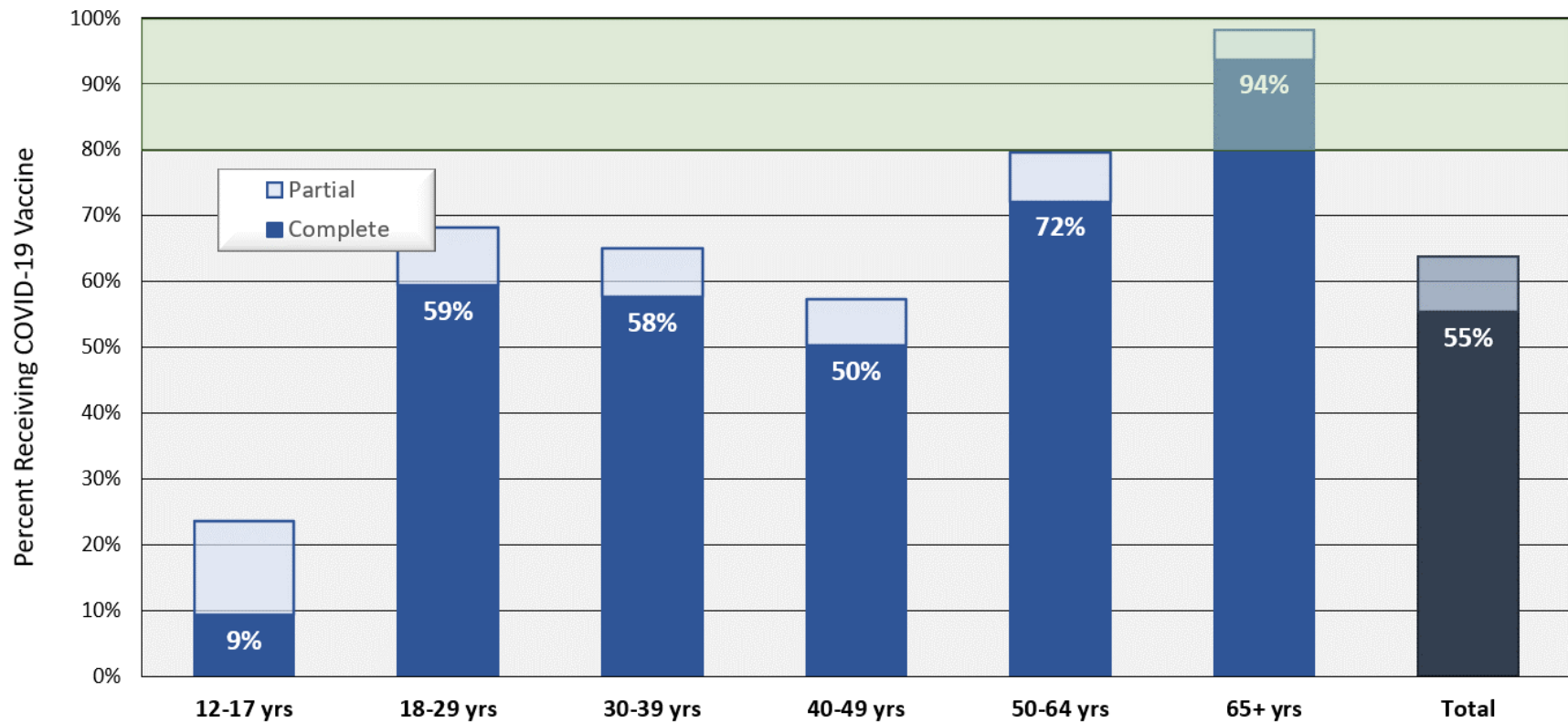

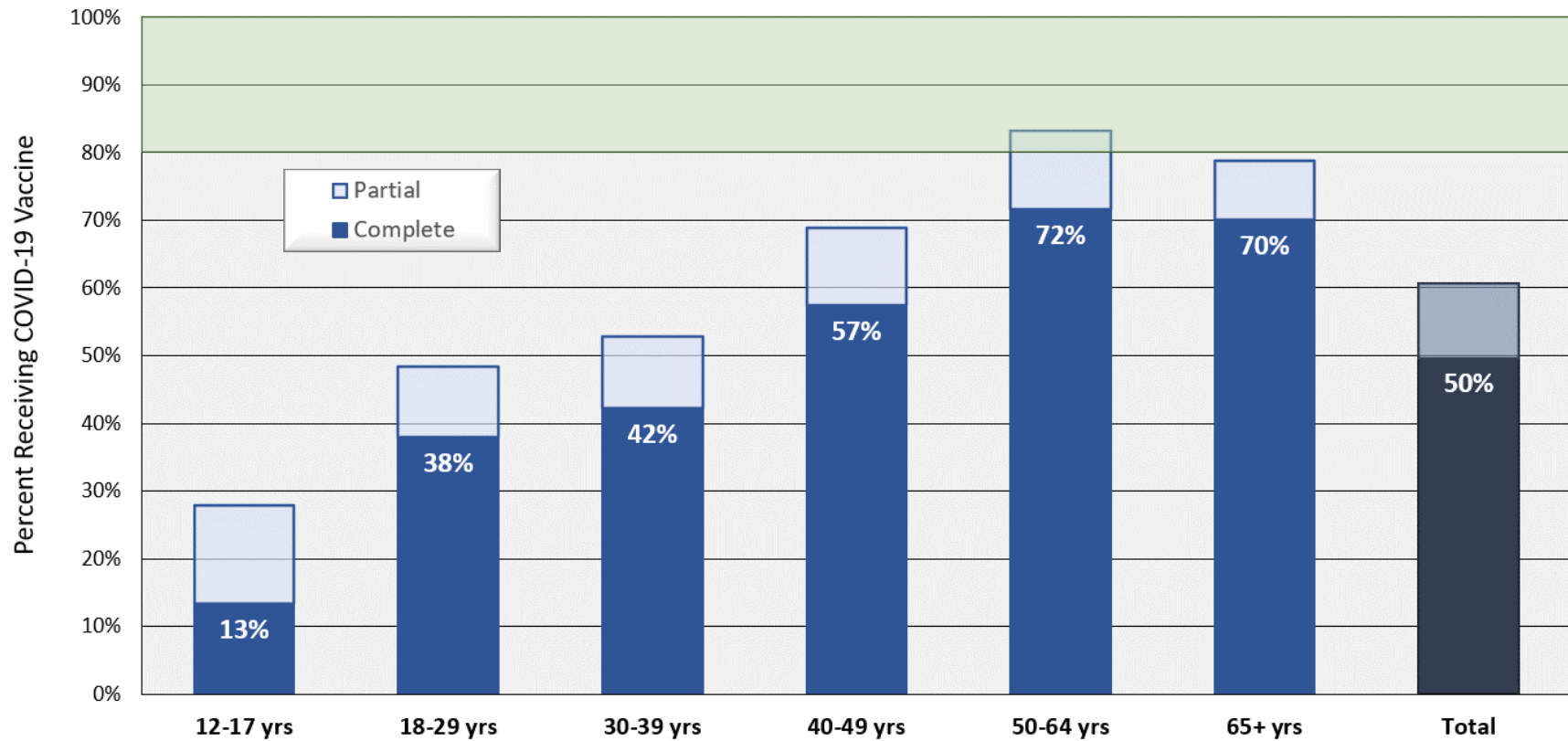
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in CNMI: June 4, 2021

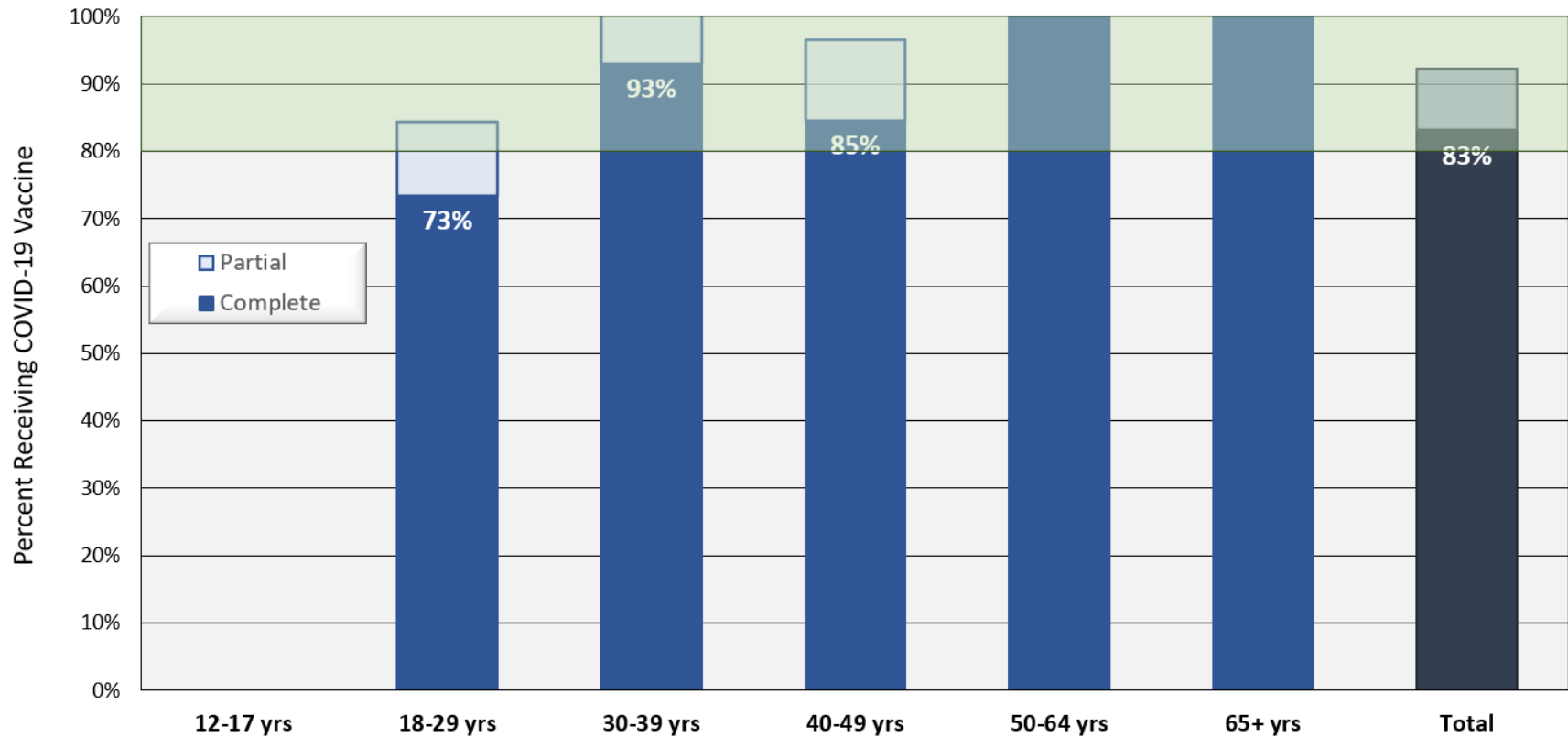
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Guam: June 4, 2021

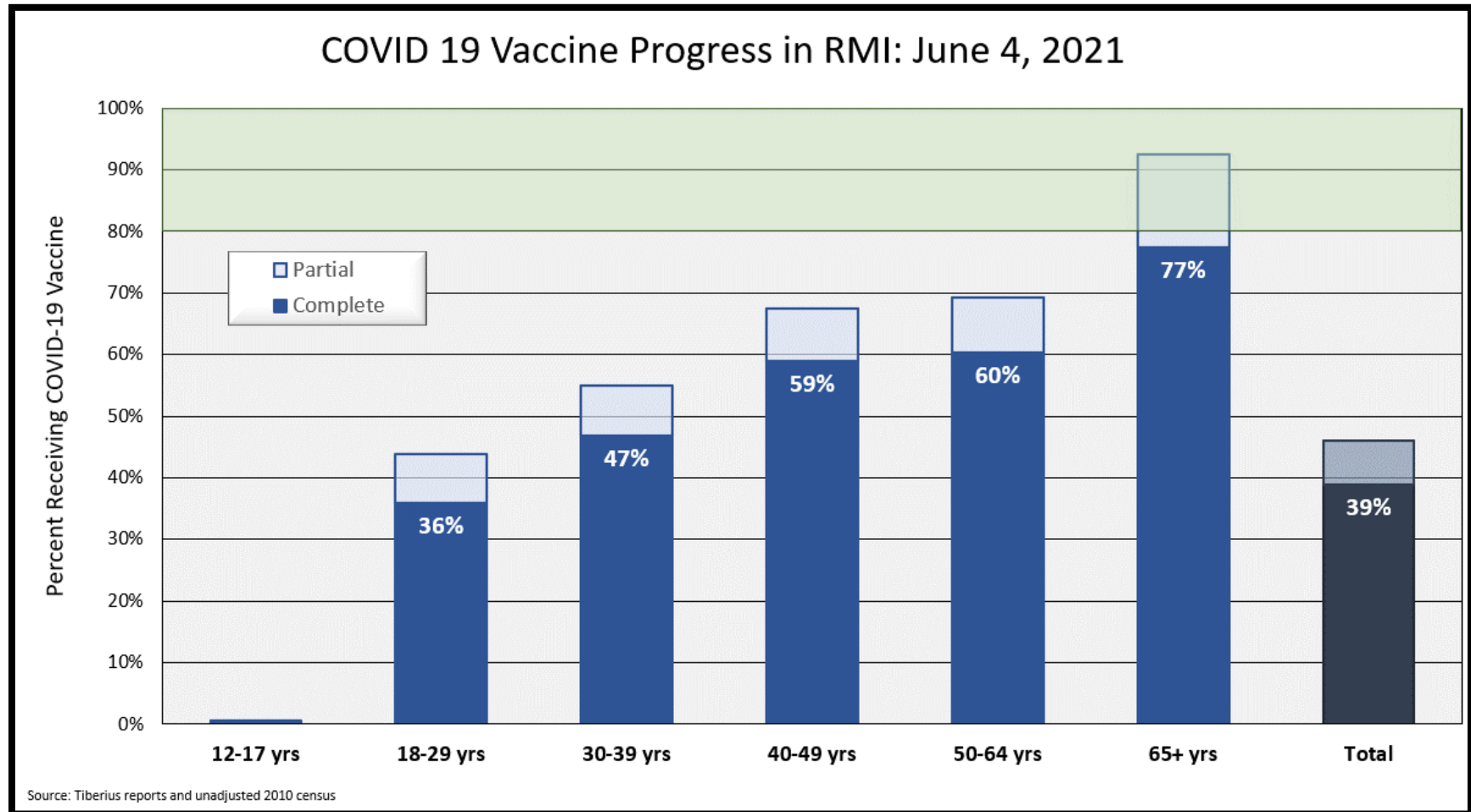

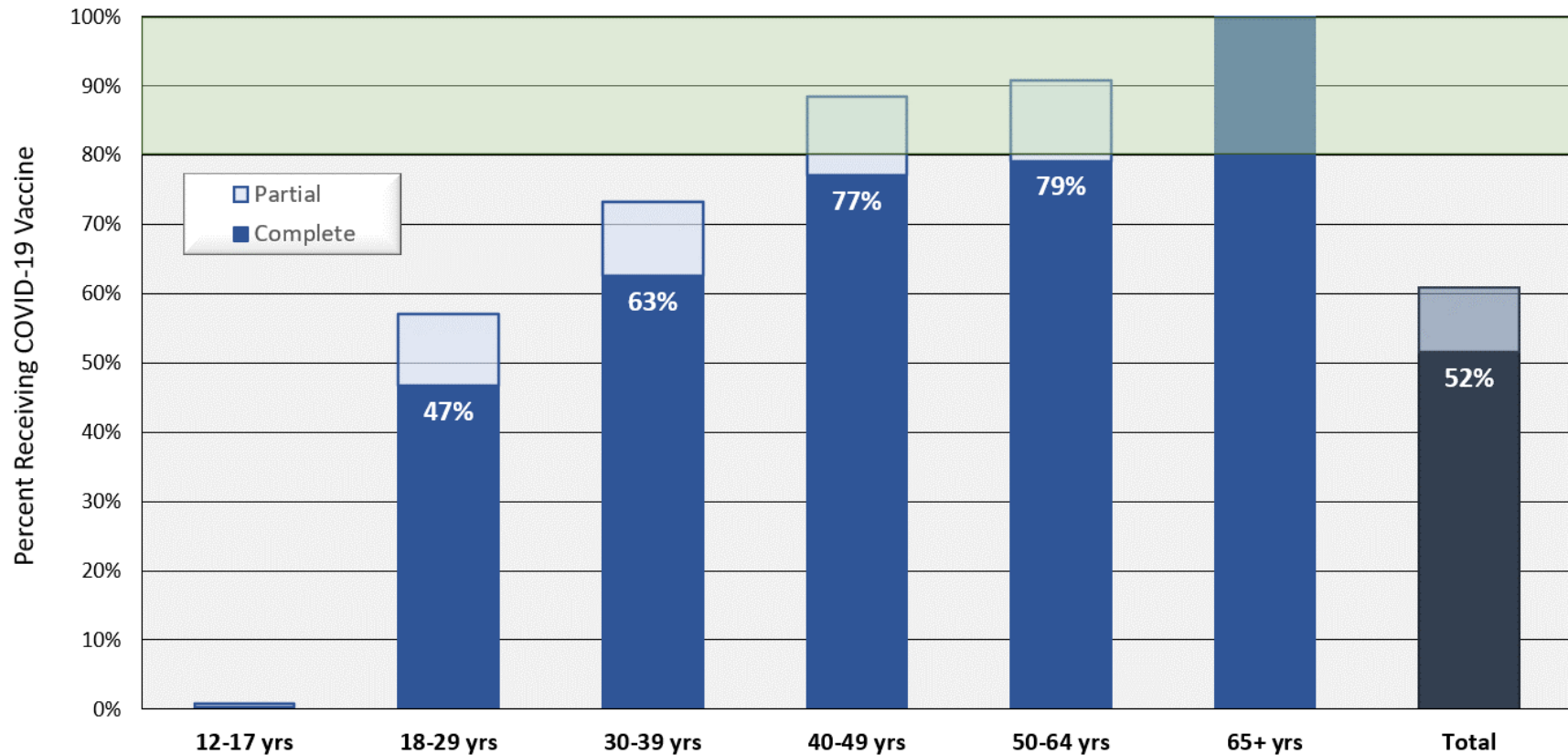

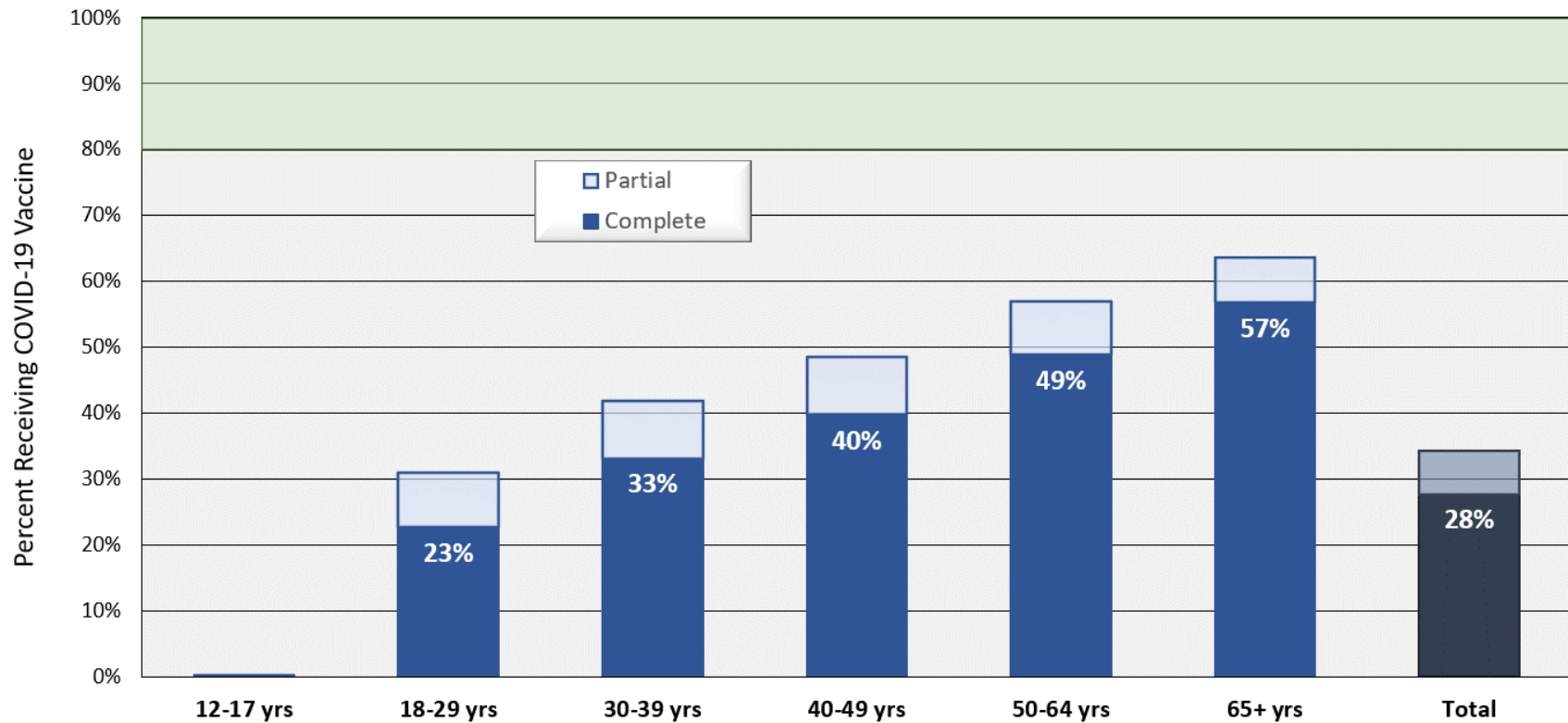
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in RMI (Main Islands): June 4, 2021

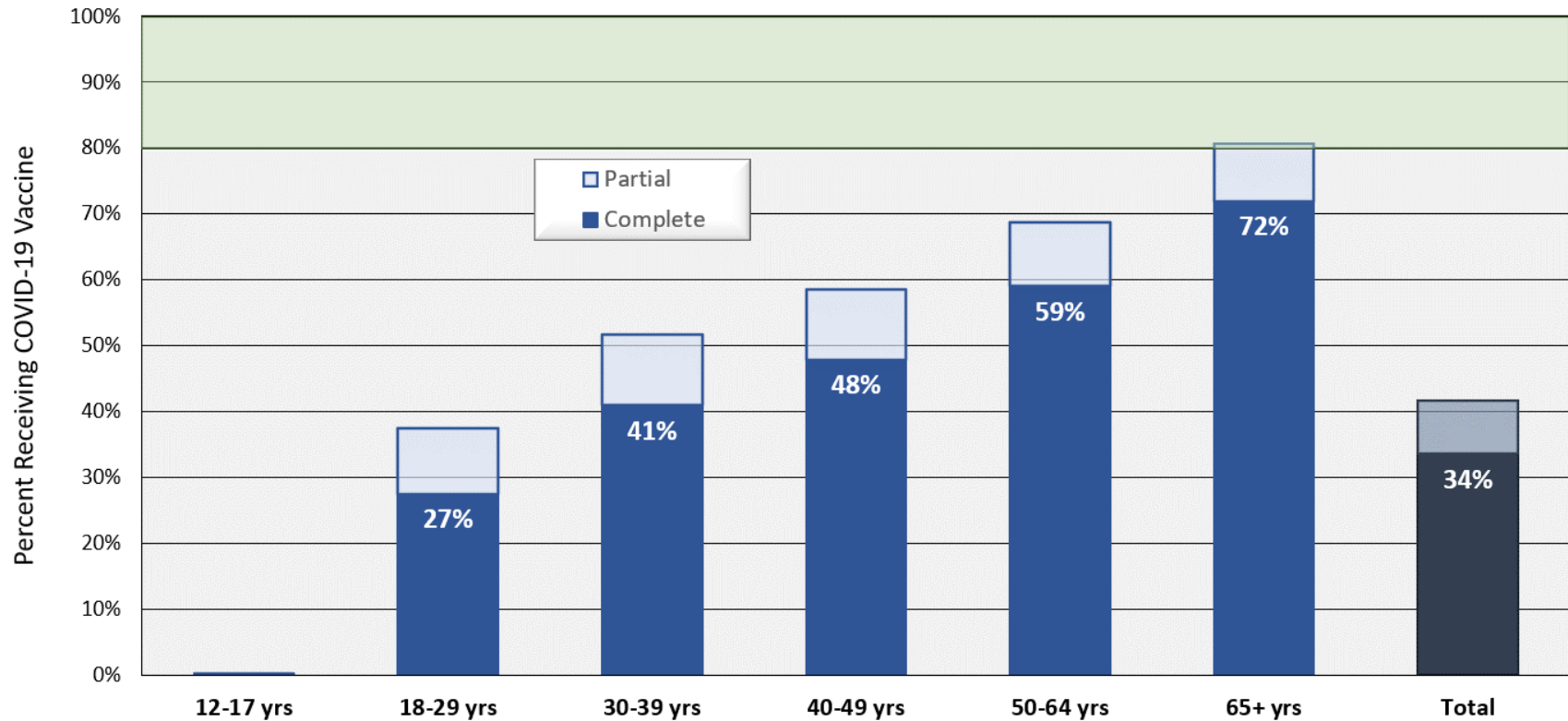
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in FSM: June 4, 2021

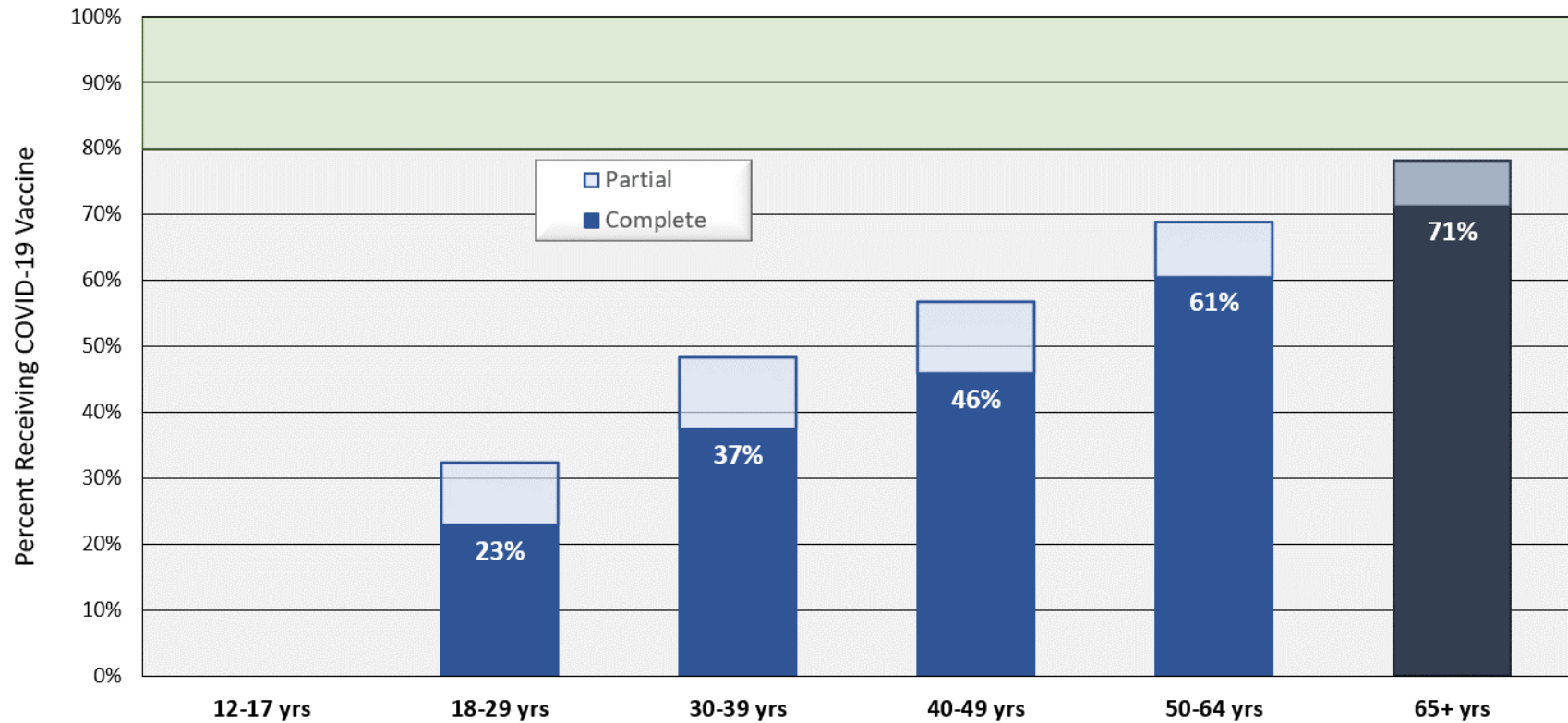
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in FSM (Main Islands): June 4, 2021

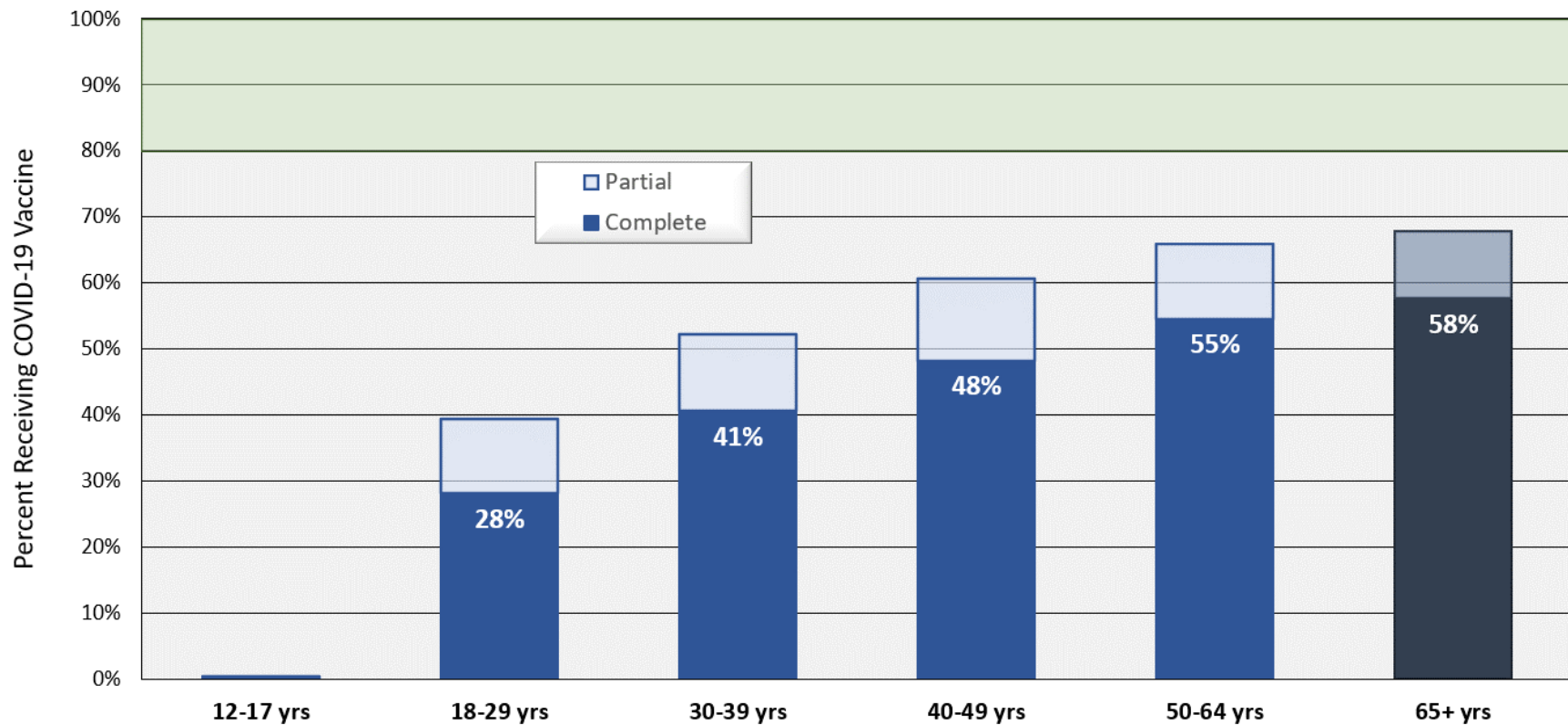
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Pohnpei (Main Islands): June 4, 2021

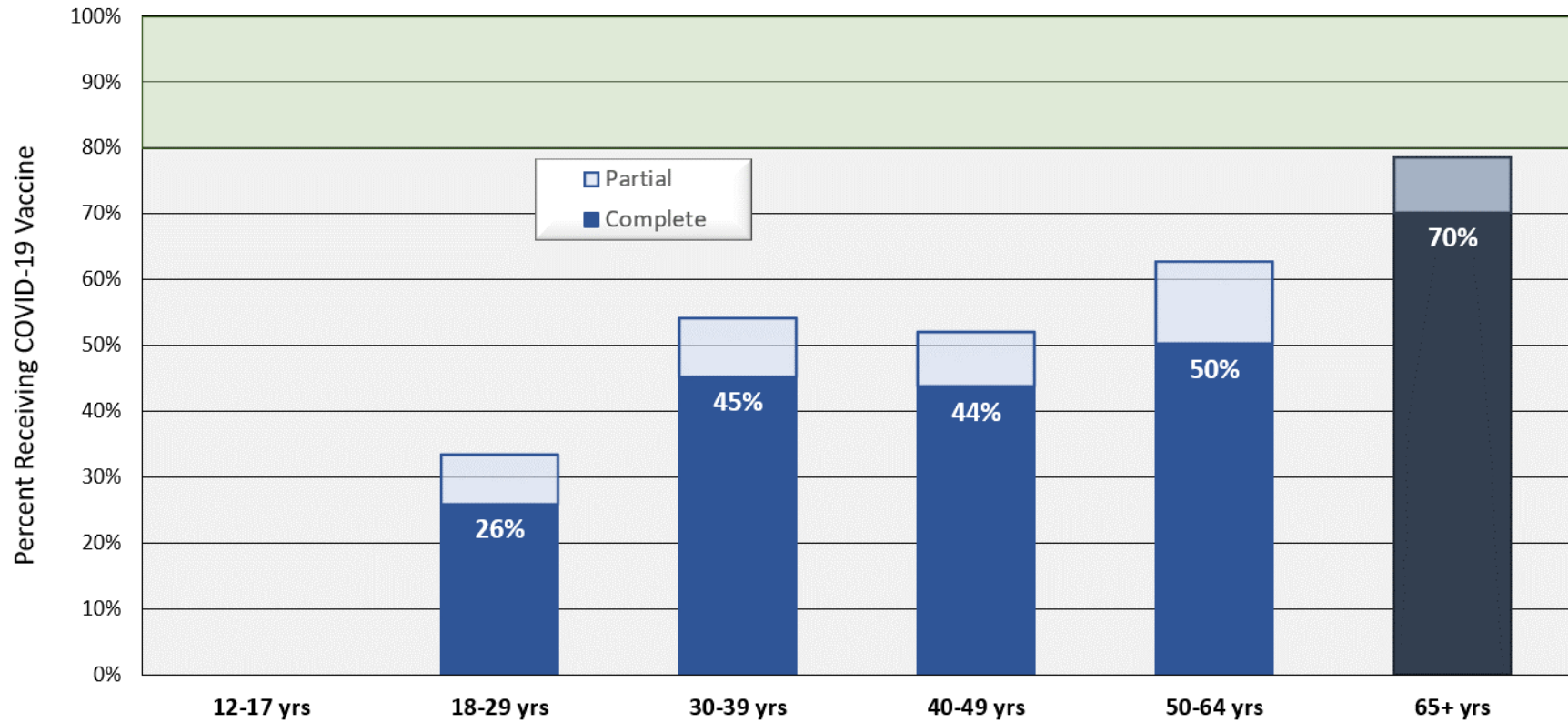
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Chuuk (Main Islands): June 4, 2021

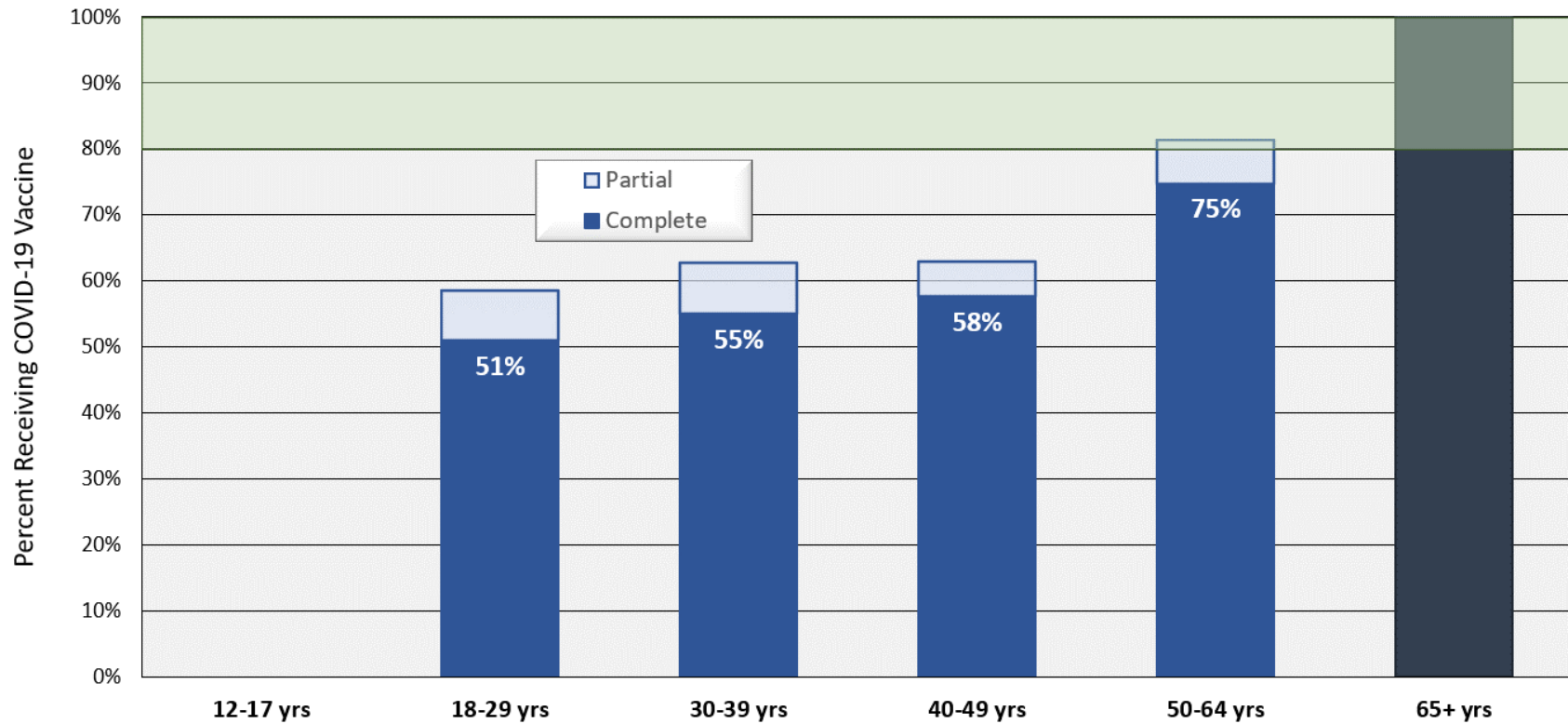
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Kosrae: June 4, 2021
