Week: 6/19/2021-6/25/2021

Regional Summary:

- COVID-19 cases
 - Guam has reported 8,328 total cases and 139 deaths with 61 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
 - CNMI has reported 183 total cases and 2 deaths with 0 new cases and 0 new deaths reported this week
 - American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
 - A total of 185,744 people in the region are fully vaccinated (58% of all eligible individuals in the region)
 - An additional 18,066 people in the region are partially vaccinated (6% of individuals in the region)
 - For progress towards the Presidents National Goal of 70% of all adults with at least 1 dose by July 4, 2021:
 - USAPI Region is at 68.2% overall and needs to vaccinate 907 new persons each day to reach our July 4th goal
 - **As expected, Guam completed their 70% target this week (70.8%). Great job Guam team!**
 - **Already Completed: Palau (100%), Kwajalein Atoll (84%), Majuro Atoll (74%), CNMI (75%), American Samoa (75%) have reached the target set by the White House**
 - Not Expected to Complete: Chuuk State (44%), Pohnpei State (53%), Kosrae State (59%), Yap State (61%)
 - **84% of USAPI residents at highest risk for COVID hospitalization (age 50 and over) have at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine**
 - **70% of all USAPI main island residents age 18/16 and over have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine**
 - **Palau reports 100% vaccine completion for all residents age 18 and over**
 - **We are unable to generate "outer island" vaccine coverage this week while we verify our new data extraction methodology.**
 - USAPI Programs want incentives to improve community participation
 - To-date, no written requests for incentives using CDC COVID funds have been submitted to CDC PO for review
 - Outer island vaccinations are in progress in Majuro, Ebeye, Chuuk, Palau, and Yap. Pohnpei will begin in July
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
 - Guam and CNMI are allowing travelers with facility quarantine and testing requirements (some exceptions for vaccinated travelers)
 - Palau is allowing military flights with testing and quarantine requirements and has just opened regular Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (restricted movement)
 - AS has conducted six repatriation flights; regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/AS quarantine and testing requirements
 - RMI has conducted eight repatriation flights; regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/RMI quarantine and testing requirements
 - FSM has repatriated two cohorts from Guam to Pohnpei (total= 107 stranded residents and diplomats)
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
 - All USAPI have at least Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax NOW, and GeneXpert capacity
 - Some stock-outs of Abbott ID NOW being reported
- Community mitigation strategies
 - Guam is in PCOR-3 and continues to relax mitigation measures
 - CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed most mitigation measures
- PPE: All USAPI have a stockpile of PPE for COVID-19, though quantities vary

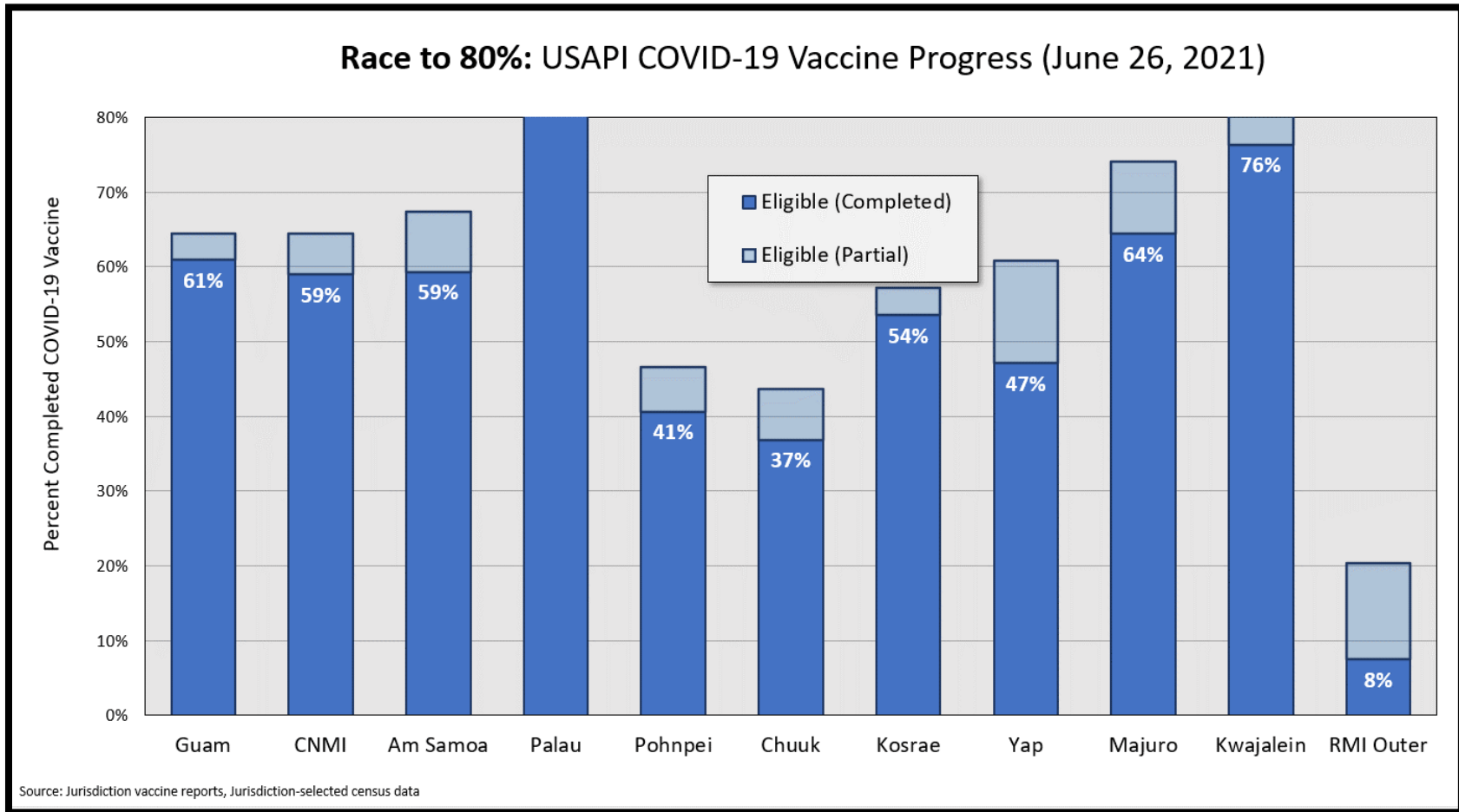

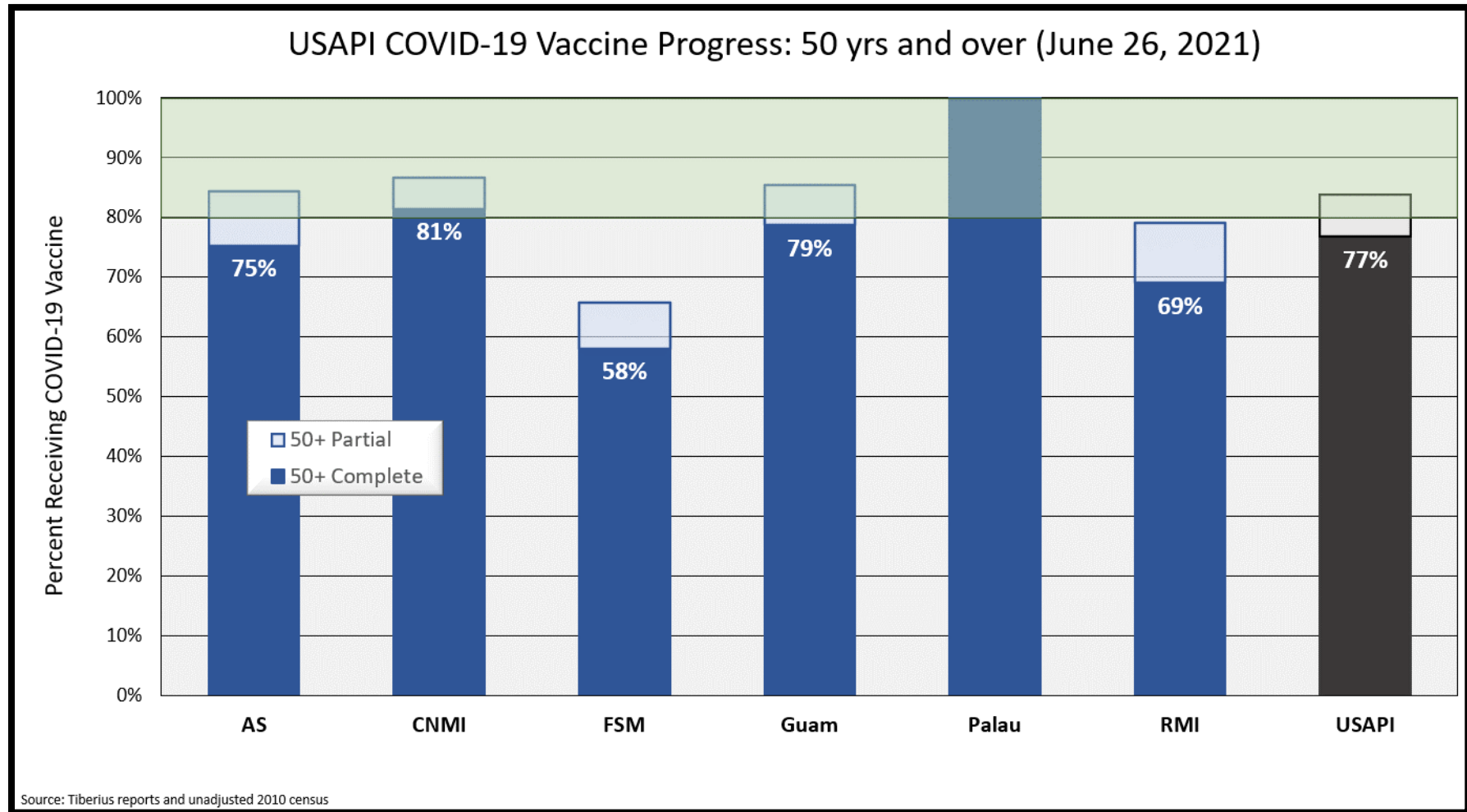

5. Protecting the Most Vulnerable in the USAPI: Vaccine Progress for 50 years and over



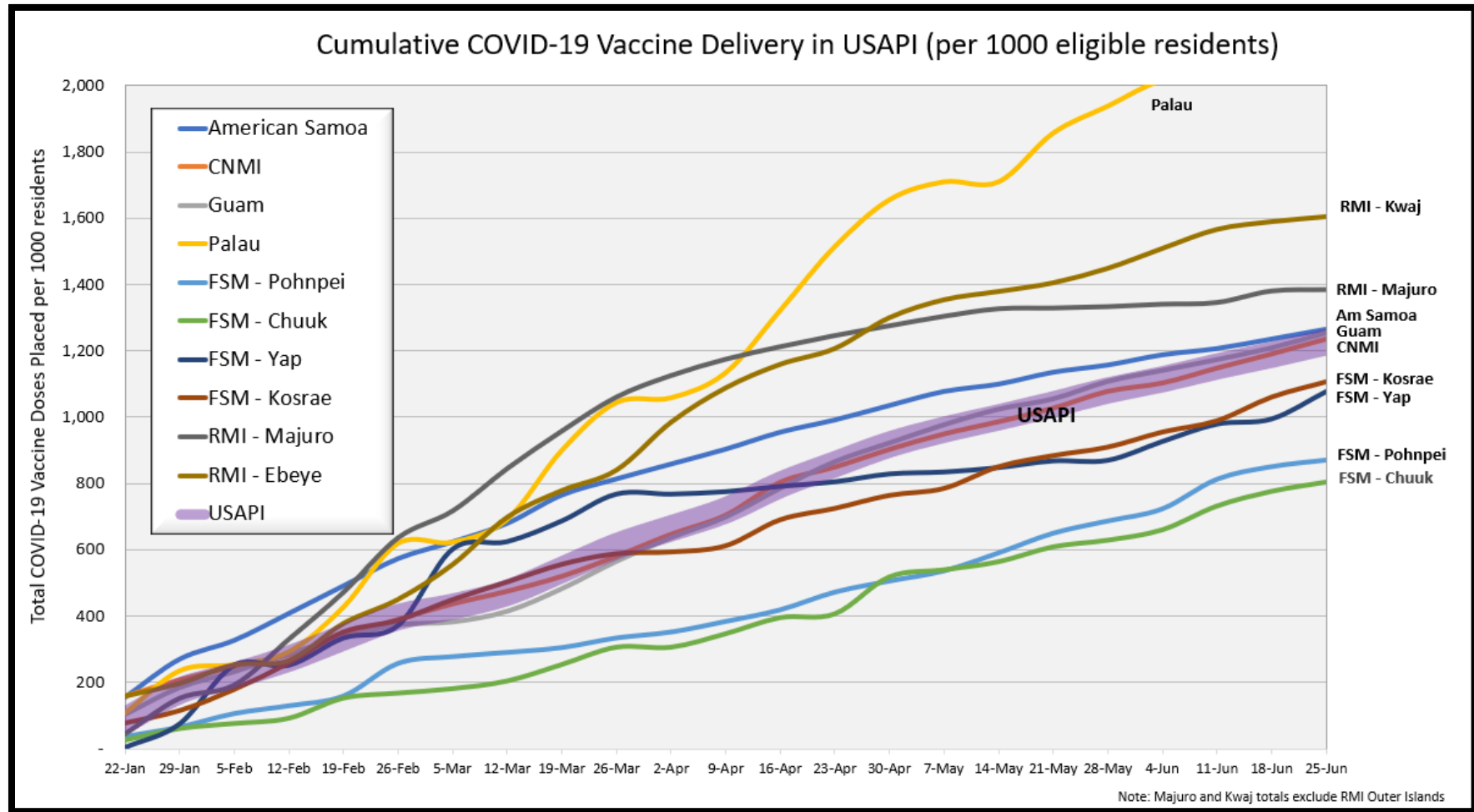

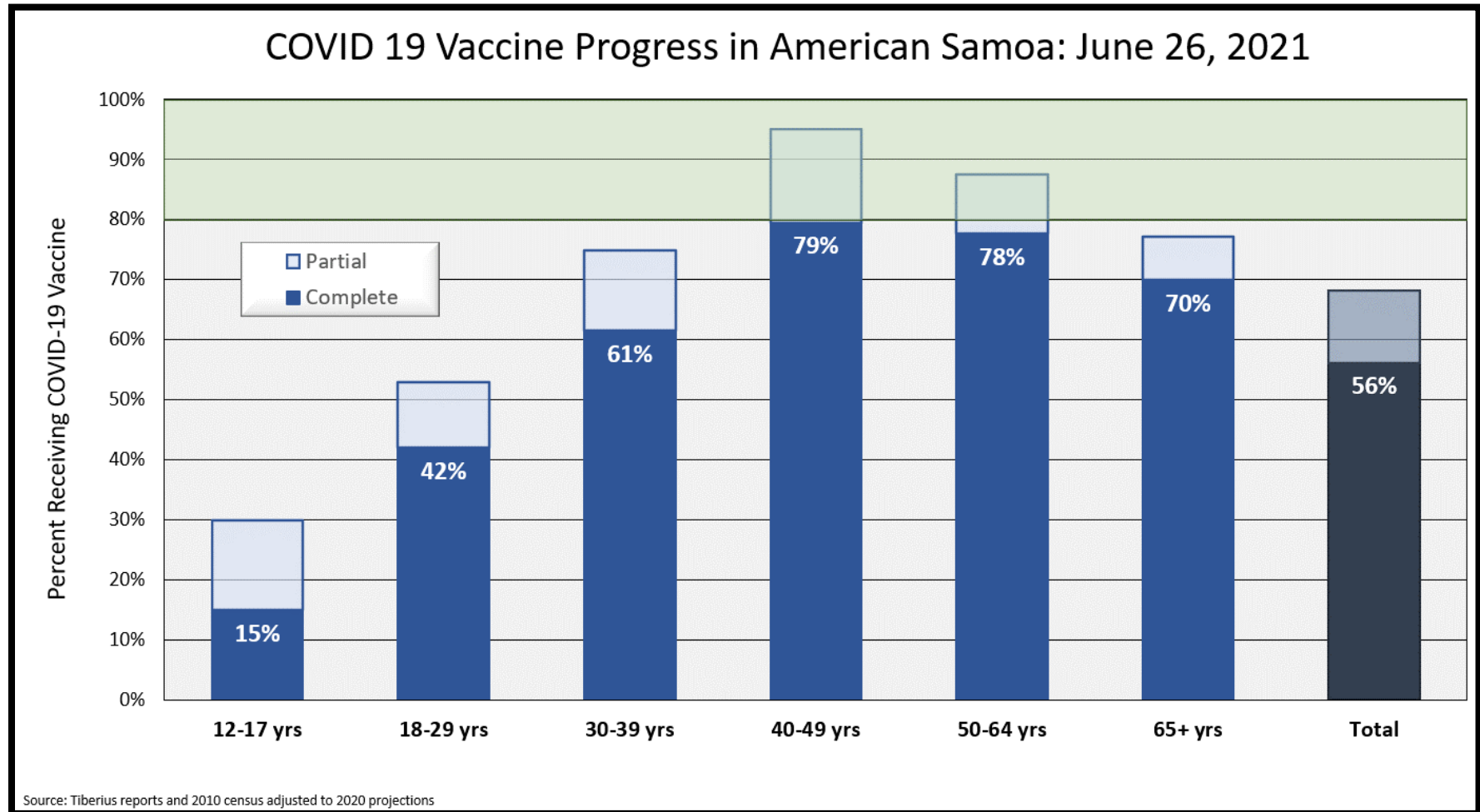
7. Pace of Vaccine Delivery in USAPI (excluding the FSM and RMI outer islands)

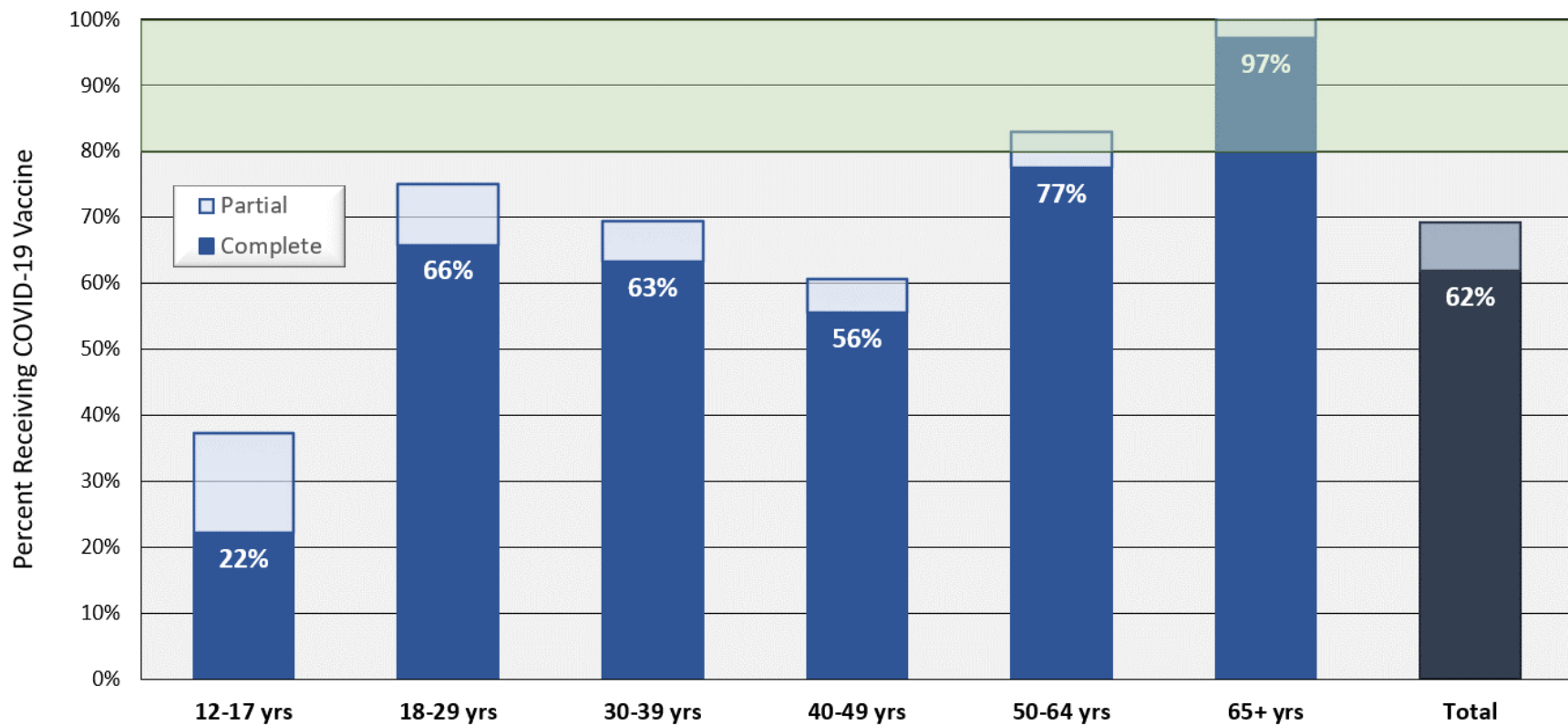
8. Vaccine Delivery in all USAPI Jurisdictions by Age (as of 06-26-2021)

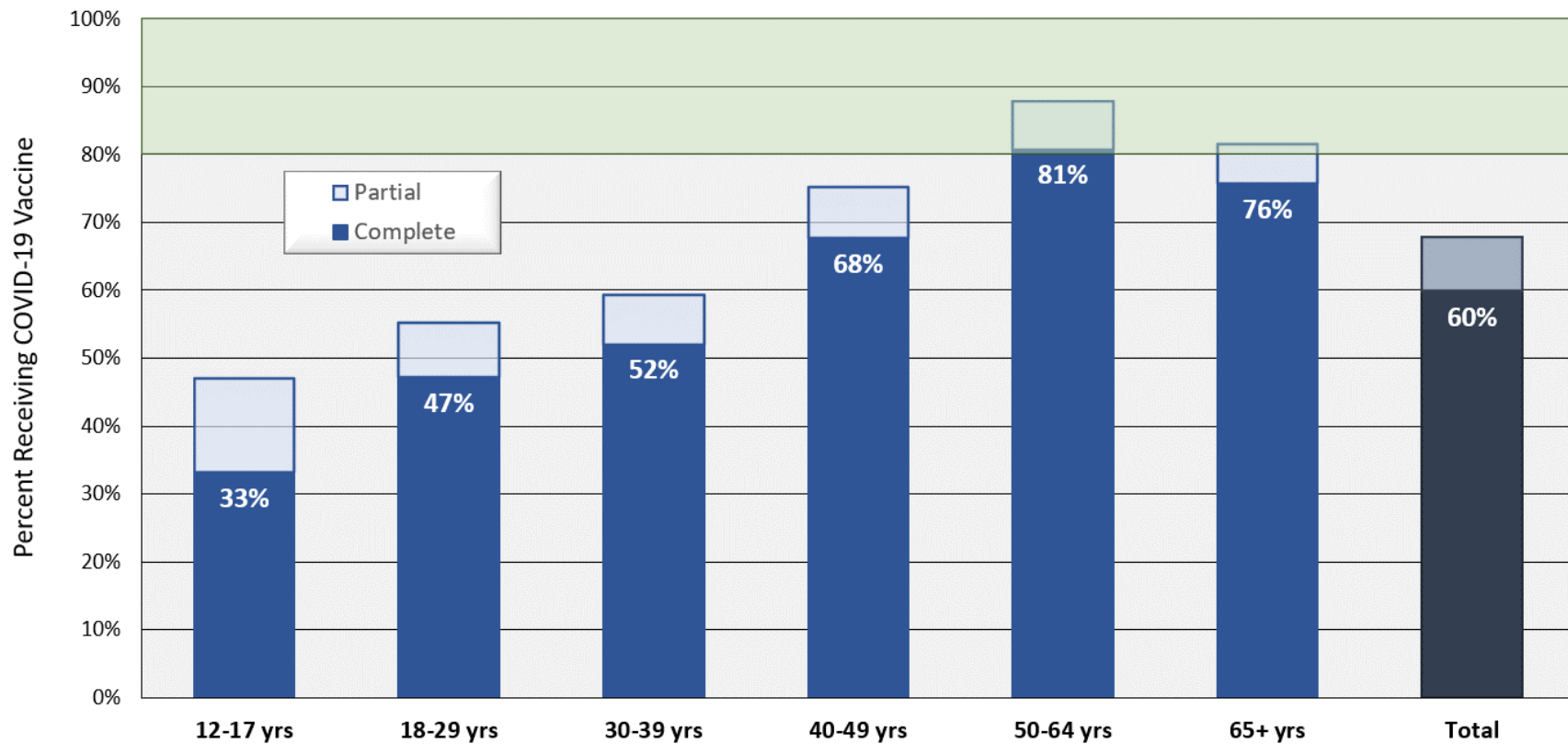
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in CNMI: June 26, 2021

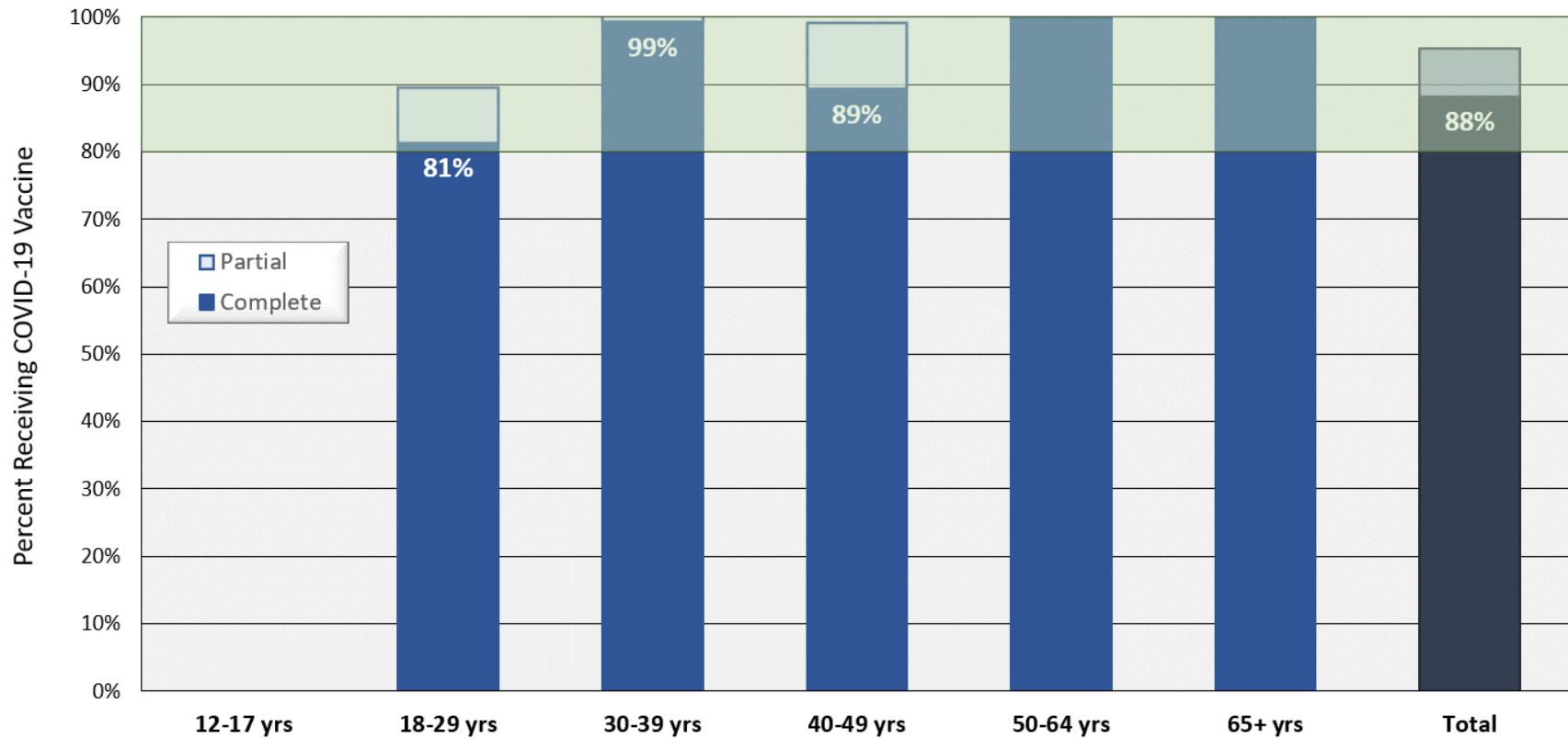
COVID 19 Vaccine Progress in Guam: June 26, 2021

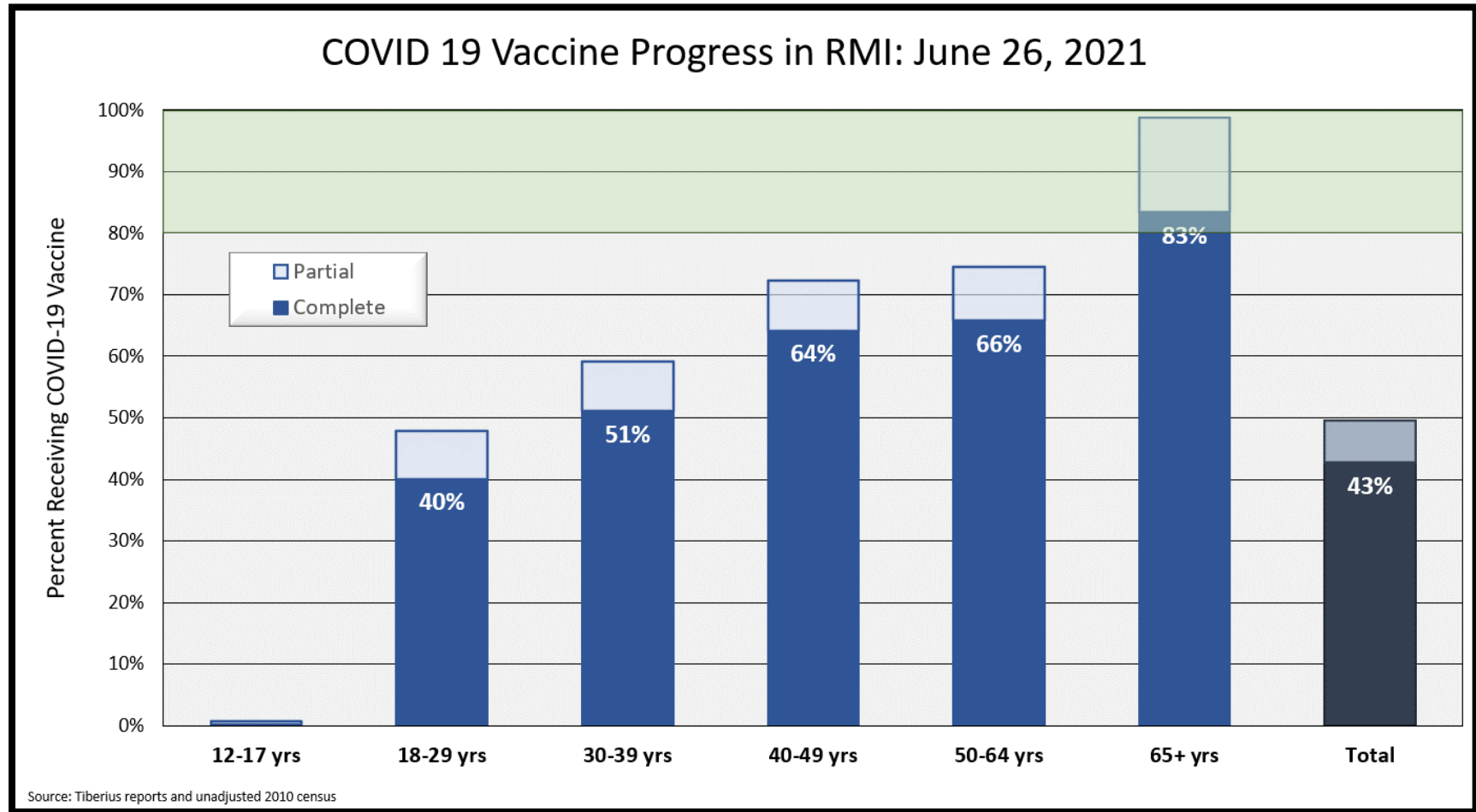

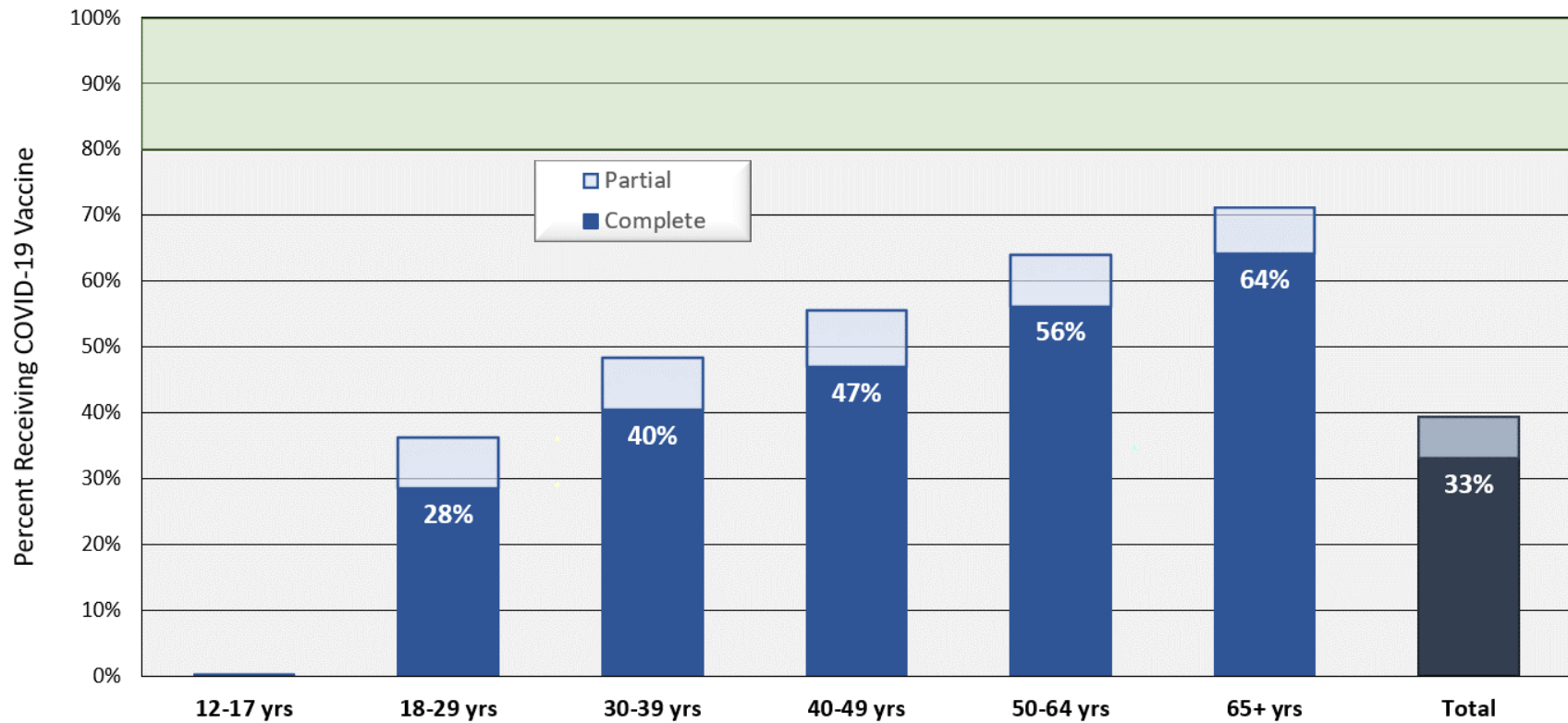
