Regional Summary:

- COVID-19 cases
 - Guam has reported 8,501 total cases and 143 deaths with 24 new cases and 1 new death reported this week
 - o CNMI has reported 188 total cases and 2 deaths with 1 new case (imported) and 0 new deaths reported this week
 - Kosrae found an individual with a positive PCR test in their recent repatriation cohort. Further testing indicates that this case was a historical case with
 low infectious risk. Despite the low infectious risk, the Kosrae health department has implemented full isolation of the case with appropriate quarantine
 of contacts.
 - o American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
 - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 204,847 people in the region are fully vaccinated (64% of all eligible individuals)
 - An additional 13,512 people in the region are partially vaccinated (4% of eligible individuals in the region)
 - Based on CDC submitted into Tiberius via WebIZ: **67% of all people aged 12 years and older have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 60% are fully vaccinated.** This percentage includes islands who have yet to start vaccinating their adolescents due to no Pfizer availability: Palau, Marshall Islands, and FSM. Note that Palau has received their first Pfizer shipment and will initiate adolescent vaccinations this week.
 - Current percentages of eligible population aged 12 and over fully vaccinated (with change from last week's data in parenthesis):
 - American Samoa: 62% (+1%)
 - FSM: Chuuk: 33% (+1%), Kosrae: 48% (+1%), Pohnpei: 40% (+1%), Yap: 50% (+6%)
 - Guam: 71% (+1%)
 - RMI: 48% (+1%)
 - CNMI: 70% (+2%)
 - Palau: 91% (+2%)
 - Outer island vaccinations: Outer Island coverage rates from jurisdictional outer island outreach activities due to difficulty in determining denominators and true residence in Tiberius.
 - RMI Outer Islands: At least one dose 25% (+2%); Fully 16% (+1%)
 - Yap Outer Islands: At least one dose 36% (+0%); Fully 24% (+1%)
 - Chuuk Outer Islands (out of the lagoon): Fully 14% (+14%) (only J3 being used in these remote islands). Note these first numbers are partial numbers and expect more refinement each week.
 - Pohnpei Outer Islands: Not yet initiated
 - Vaccine redistribution: The first vaccine redistribution for USAPI occurred last week. Palau transferred 1000 Johnson & Johnson/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine to FSM (Yap) July 15, 2021. Guam transferred 2000 Johnson & Johnson/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine to FSM (Chuuk) on July 12, 2021.
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
 - Guam and CNMI are allowing travelers with facility quarantine and testing requirements (some exceptions for vaccinated travelers)
 - Palau has just opened regular Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (but with restricted movement)
 - AS and RMI have regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/in-country quarantine and testing requirements
 - o FSM continues smaller repat flights with Guam/FSM quarantine and testing requirements
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
 - Some stock-outs of Abbott ID NOW being reported
- Community mitigation strategies
 - Guam is in PCOR-3 with some mitigation measures still in place
 - o CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed most mitigation measures




