• COVID-19 cases

- Guam has reported 13,349 total cases and 179 deaths with 1,122 new cases (↑6%) and 20 new deaths (↑250%) reported this week; test positivity 13.5% (↓ from 14.3% last week)
- o CNMI has reported 258 total cases and 2 deaths with 8 new cases (imported) and 0 new deaths reported this week; no community transmission
- Palau has reported 5 total cases (3 travelers in restricted movement, 2 contacts) with 3 new cases this week; no community transmission detected
- o American Samoa reported their first imported case this week (traveler from Honolulu who tested positive in quarantine)
- FSM and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
 - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 239,029 people in the region are fully vaccinated (75% of all eligible individuals)
 - An additional 16,427 people in the region are partially vaccinated (5% of eligible individuals in the region)
 - Note: eligible individuals are now 12+ for AS, CNMI, Guam and Palau, Kosrae but still 18+ for Chuuk, Pohnpei, Yap, and RMI
 - Based on data submitted into Tiberius via WebIZ: 79% of all people aged 12 years and older have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 69% are fully vaccinated. This percentage includes islands who have yet to start vaccinating their adolescents due to no Pfizer availability: RMI and Pohnpei, Chuuk, and Yap of the FSM.
 - Current percentages of eligible population aged 12 and over fully vaccinated (with change from last week's data in parenthesis):
 - American Samoa: 72% (--%)
 - FSM: Chuuk: 42% (1%), Kosrae: 56% (2%), Pohnpei: 50% (+2%), Yap: 65% (+1%)
 - Guam: 80% (+1%)
 - RMI: 55% (+1%)
 - CNMI: 81% (+1%)
 - Palau: >99% (--%)
 - Outer island vaccinations: Outer Island coverage rates from jurisdictional outer island outreach activities due to difficulty in determining denominators and true residence in Tiberius.
 - RMI Outer Islands: At least one dose 39% (+6%); Fully 25% (+1%)
 - Yap Outer Islands: At least one dose 67% (--%); Fully 63% (--%)
 - Chuuk Outer Islands (out of the lagoon): Fully 14% (--%) (no OI numbers reported in the past several weeks from Chuuk)
 - Pohnpei Outer Islands: Fully 16% (+16%)
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
 - Guam is allowing vaccinated travelers or unvaccinated travelers with negative test 72 hours prior to arrival to enter without testing or quarantine.
 - CNMI is allowing travelers with facility quarantine requirement (5-day test out option).
 - Palau is running regular Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (but with restricted movement) and testing on days 1&5.
 - RMI has regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/in-country quarantine and testing requirements.
 - o AS is running HNL flights using "Talofa Pass" system with pre-travel testing and AS quarantine (no longer HNL quarantine).
 - FSM continues smaller repat flights with Guam/FSM quarantine and testing requirements.
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
 - o Supplies of Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax, and GeneXpert are low in some USAPI as travel testing demands increase; difficulties with procurement.
- Community mitigation strategies
 - o Guam is in PCOR-3 but is now requiring vaccination to enter indoor locations; schools also remain closed due to delta surge.
 - CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed most mitigation measures.





US-affiliated Pacific Islands Region








Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands




Republic of Marshall Islands


