#### **Regional Summary:**

- COVID-19 cases
  - Guam has reported 11,106 total cases and 151 deaths with 1,060 new cases (个10%) and 8 new deaths reported this week; test positivity 14.5% (个 from 12.3% last week)
  - o CNMI has reported 250 total cases and 2 deaths with 7 new cases (imported) and 0 new deaths reported this week; no community transmission
  - o Palau has reported 3 total cases (all travelers in restricted movement) including 1 new case this week; no community transmission detected
  - American Samoa, FSM, and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
  - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 234,131 people in the region are fully vaccinated (73% of all eligible individuals)
    - An additional 17,897 people in the region are partially vaccinated (6% of eligible individuals in the region)
    - Note: eligible individuals are now 12+ for AS, CNMI, Guam and Palau, Kosrae but still 18+ for Chuuk, Pohnpei, Yap, and RMI
  - Based on data submitted into Tiberius via WeblZ: 78% of all people aged 12 years and older have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 68% are fully vaccinated. This percentage includes islands who have yet to start vaccinating their adolescents due to no Pfizer availability: RMI and Pohnpei, Chuuk, and Yap of the FSM.
  - Current percentages of eligible population aged 12 and over fully vaccinated (with change from last week's data in parenthesis):
    - American Samoa: 72% (+2%)
    - FSM: Chuuk: 41% (1%), Kosrae: 54% (1%), Pohnpei: 48% (+2%), Yap: 64% (+1%)
    - Guam: 79% (+2%)
    - RMI: 54% (+1%)
    - CNMI: 80% (+1%)
    - Palau: 99% (--%)
  - Outer island vaccinations: Outer Island coverage rates from jurisdictional outer island outreach activities due to difficulty in determining denominators and true residence in Tiberius.
    - RMI Outer Islands: At least one dose 33% (--%); Fully 24% (--%)
    - Yap Outer Islands: At least one dose 67% (--%); Fully 63% (--%)
    - Chuuk Outer Islands (out of the lagoon): Fully 14% (--%) (no OI numbers reported in the past several weeks from Chuuk)
    - Pohnpei Outer Islands: Underway, awaiting numbers.
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
  - Guam is allowing vaccinated travelers or unvaccinated travelers with negative test 72 hours prior to arrival to enter without testing or quarantine.
     All others are subject to a 10-day quarantine at a government facility.
  - CNMI is allowing travelers with facility guarantine requirement (5-day test out option).
  - o Palau is running regular Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (but with restricted movement) and testing on days 1&5.
  - o RMI has regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/in-country quarantine and testing requirements.
  - AS is running HNL flights using "Talofa Pass" system with pre-travel testing and AS quarantine (no longer HNL quarantine).
  - o FSM continues smaller repat flights with Guam/FSM quarantine and testing requirements.
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
  - Supplies of Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax, and GeneXpert are low in some USAPI as travel testing demands increase; difficulties with procurement.
- Community mitigation strategies
  - o Guam is in PCOR-3 but is now requiring vaccination to enter indoor locations; schools also remain closed due to delta surge.
  - CNMI, American Samoa, FSM, Palau, and RMI have relaxed most mitigation measures.




Eligible Population Defined Based on Vaccine Type Availability in a Jurisdiction: American Samoa - 12+ yrs Percentages are capped at 100%






Eligible Population Defined Based on Vaccine Type Availability in a Jurisdiction: CNMI - 12+ yrs Percentages are capped at 100%














Eligible Population Defined Based on Vaccine Type Availability in a Jurisdiction: RMI - 18+ yrs Percentages are capped at 100%
