#### **Regional Summary:**

- COVID-19 cases
  - Guam has reported 18,586 total cases and 248 deaths with 435 new cases (↓ from 679 last week) and 10 new deaths reported this week (↓ from 11 new deaths last week); test positivity 8.0% (↓ from 11.1% last week)
  - CNMI has reported 339 total cases and 3 deaths; 35 new cases (2 imported and 33 community) and 0 new deaths reported this week; community clusters identified through school testing after months without any reported community transmission; additional cases identified from community-based testing and contact tracing; cases continue to be identified in travel quarantine; vaccine uptake increased sharply after identification of cases
  - Palau has reported 8 total cases (6 travelers in restricted movement, 2 contacts) with 0 new cases this week; no community transmission
  - American Samoa has reported 4 total cases (all imported) with 0 new cases reported this week
  - o FSM and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
  - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 260,459 people in the region are fully vaccinated (80% of all eligible individuals / --%)
    - An additional 15,753 people in the region are partially vaccinated (5% of eligible individuals in the region)
    - Note: eligible individuals are 12+ for AS, CNMI, Guam, Palau, Kosrae, Yap and RMI but still 18+ for Chuuk and Pohnpei
  - Based on data submitted into Tiberius via WebIZ: 87% of all people aged 12 years and older have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 79% are fully vaccinated. This percentage includes islands who have yet to start vaccinating their adolescents due to no Pfizer availability: Pohnpei, Chuuk, and Yap of the FSM. Note: RMI began Pfizer rollout in Majuro this week and Yap to begin Pfizer rollout next week.
  - Current percentages of eligible population aged 12 and over fully vaccinated (with change from last week's data in parenthesis):
    - American Samoa: 84% (+1%)
    - FSM: Chuuk: 49% (+1%), Kosrae: 69% (+1%), Pohnpei: 57% (+2%), Yap: 68% (--%)

       Palau: >99% (--%)
  - Outer island vaccinations: Outer Island coverage rates from jurisdictional outer island outreach activities due to difficulty in determining denominators and true residence in Tiberius.
    - RMI Outer Islands: At least one dose 51% (--%); Fully 39% (--%) (denominators adjusted based on OI reports and expanded to 12+)
    - Yap Outer Islands: At least one dose 98% (--%); Fully 95% (--%) (denominators adjusted to locally collected denominators for 18+)
    - Chuuk Outer Islands (out of the lagoon): Fully 31% (--%) (OI numbers are incomplete)
    - Pohnpei Outer Islands: Fully 63% (--%) (denominator adjusted based on OI reports for 18+)
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
  - Guam is allowing vaccinated travelers or unvaccinated travelers with negative test 72 hours prior to arrival to enter without testing or quarantine.
  - CNMI is allowing travelers with facility quarantine requirement (5-day test out option).
  - o Palau is running regular Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (but with restricted movement) and testing on days 1&5.
  - RMI has regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/in-country quarantine and testing requirements.
  - AS is running HNL flights using "Talofa Pass" system with pre-travel testing and AS quarantine (no longer HNL quarantine).
  - FSM continues smaller repat flights with Guam/FSM quarantine and testing requirements.
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
  - o Supplies of Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax, and GeneXpert are low in some USAPI as travel testing demands increase; difficulties with procurement.






#### Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands








#### Republic of Palau
