#### **Regional Summary:**

- COVID-19 cases
  - Guam has reported 18,863 total cases and 258 deaths with 258 new cases (↓ from 435 last week) and 10 new deaths reported this week (-- from 10 new deaths last week); test positivity 6.0% (↓ from 8.0% last week)
  - CNMI has reported 381 total cases and 3 deaths; 42 new cases (5 imported and 37 community, 1 from 37 last week) and 0 new deaths reported this week; cases continue to be identified from community-based testing and contact tracing with transmission primarily in households and most cases linked to known clusters; one case hospitalized for precautionary observation; schools to reopen 11/29
  - o Palau has reported 8 total cases (6 travelers in restricted movement, 2 contacts) with 0 new cases this week; no community transmission
  - American Samoa has reported 5 total cases (all imported) with 1 new case reported this week (fully vaccinated traveler in border quarantine)
  - FSM and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
  - Pediatric formulation of the Pfizer vaccine ordered and delivered to each of the 6 USAPI, many campaigns started this week (pediatric rollout began 11/9 in Guam and 11/6 in CNMI; to begin on 11/15 in American Samoa)
  - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 262,000 people in the region are fully vaccinated (79.0% of all eligible individuals / -1% / denominators now include newly eligible 5-11 age group in CNMI and Guam hence the decrease)
    - An additional 17,946 people in the region are partially vaccinated (5.5% of eligible individuals in the region)
    - Note: eligible individuals are 5+ for CNMI, Guam 12+ for AS, Palau, Kosrae, Yap and RMI 18+ for Chuuk and Pohnpei
  - Based on data submitted into Tiberius via WebIZ: 88% of all people aged 12 years and older have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 79% are fully vaccinated. This percentage includes Pohnpei and Chuuk (FSM) who have yet to start vaccinating adolescents.
  - Current percentages of eligible population aged 12 and over fully vaccinated (with change from last week's data in parenthesis):
    - American Samoa: 84% (--%)
    - FSM: Chuuk: 49% (--%), Kosrae: 70% (+1%), Pohnpei: 58% (--%), Yap: 68% (--%)
    - Guam: 90% (--%)
    - RMI: 60% (+2%)
    - CNMI: 85% (+1%)
    - Palau: >99% (--%)
  - Outer island vaccinations: Outer Island coverage rates from jurisdictional outer island outreach activities due to difficulty in determining denominators and true residence in Tiberius.
    - RMI Outer Islands: At least one dose 52% (+1%); Fully 40% (+1%) (denominators adjusted based on OI reports and expanded to 12+)
    - Yap Outer Islands: At least one dose 98% (--%); Fully 95% (--%) (denominators adjusted to locally collected denominators for 18+)
    - Chuuk Outer Islands (out of the lagoon): Fully 31% (--%) (OI numbers are incomplete)
    - Pohnpei Outer Islands: Fully 63% (--%) (denominator adjusted based on OI reports for 18+)
  - o Boosters: 23,757 total boosters/additional doses have been provided in the USAPI: AS: 776; FSM: 656; Guam: 14,640; RMI: 373; CNMI: 5,227; Palau: 2,085
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
  - Guam is allowing vaccinated travelers or unvaccinated travelers with negative test 72 hours prior to arrival to enter without testing or quarantine.
  - CNMI is allowing travelers with facility quarantine requirement (5-day test out option if vaccinated; 10-day if unvaccinated).
  - Palau is running regular Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (but with restricted movement) and testing on days 1&5.
  - o RMI has regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/in-country quarantine and testing requirements.
  - o AS is running HNL flights using "Talofa Pass" system with pre-travel testing and 10-day AS quarantine (no longer HNL quarantine).
  - FSM continues smaller repat flights with Guam/FSM quarantine and testing requirements.
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
  - Supplies of Abbott ID NOW, Abbott Binax, and GeneXpert are low in some USAPI as travel testing demands increase; difficulties with procurement.






# Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands




