#### **Regional Summary:**

- COVID-19 cases
  - Guam has reported 19,155 total cases and 263 deaths with 94 new cases (↓ from 198 last week) and 1 new death reported this week (↓ from 4 new deaths last week); test positivity 2.8% (↓ from 4.6% last week)
  - CNMI has reported 649 total cases and 3 deaths; 218 new cases (2 imported and 216 community,  $\uparrow$  from 50 last week) and 0 new deaths reported this week; cases identified from community-based testing and contact tracing with rise in cases linked to transmission in congregated living settings
  - Palau has reported 8 total cases (6 travelers in restricted movement, 2 contacts) with 0 new cases this week; no community transmission
  - American Samoa has reported 5 total cases (all imported) with 0 new cases reported this week
  - o FSM and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
  - Pediatric formulation of the Pfizer vaccine was ordered and delivered to each of the 6 USAPI, pediatric vaccination campaigns have started in American Samoa, CNMI, and Guam
  - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 264,000 people in the region are fully vaccinated (77.8% of all eligible individuals /+0.5%)
    - An additional 19,000 people in the region are partially vaccinated (5.8% of eligible individuals in the region)
    - Note: eligible individuals are 5+ for CNMI, Guam, and American Samoa 12+ for Palau, Kosrae, Yap and RMI 18+ for Chuuk and Pohnpei
  - Based on data submitted into Tiberius via WeblZ: 75% of all people aged 5 years and older have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 68% are fully vaccinated. This percentage includes Pohnpei and Chuuk (FSM) who have yet to start vaccinating adolescents or children.
  - Current percentages of eligible population aged 5 and over fully vaccinated (with change from last week's data in parenthesis are blank due to the expanded eligible population):
    - American Samoa: 72% (--%)
    - FSM: Chuuk: 40% (--%), Kosrae: 57% (--%), Pohnpei: 48% (--%), Yap: 60% (--%)
    - Guam: 80% (--%)
    - RMI: 48% (--%)
    - CNMI: 73% (--%)
    - Palau: 95% (--%)
  - Outer island vaccinations: Outer Island coverage rates from jurisdictional outer island outreach activities due to difficulty in determining denominators and true residence in Tiberius.
    - RMI Outer Islands: At least one dose 53% (+1%); Fully 45% (+3%) (denominators adjusted based on OI reports and expanded to 12+)
    - Yap Outer Islands: At least one dose 98% (--%); Fully 95% (--%) (denominators adjusted to locally collected denominators for 18+)
    - Chuuk Outer Islands (out of the lagoon): Fully 31% (--%) (OI numbers are incomplete)
    - Pohnpei Outer Islands: Fully 63% (--%) (denominator adjusted based on OI reports for 18+)
  - Boosters: A total of 34,894 boosters/additional doses have been provided across the USAPI: American Samoa: 1358; FSM: 984; Guam: 22,125; RMI: 637; CNMI: 57181; Palau: 2,609
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
  - o Guam is allowing vaccinated travelers or unvaccinated travelers with negative test 72 hours prior to arrival to enter without testing or quarantine.
  - CNMI is allowing vaccinated travelers with approval to enter without quarantine with testing on day 5 and unvaccinated travelers to enter with facility quarantine requirement with testing on day 7.
  - o Palau is running regular Guam flights with quarantine exemptions for vaccinated travelers (but with restricted movement) and testing on days 1&5.
  - o RMI has regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/in-country quarantine and testing requirements.
  - AS is running HNL flights using "Talofa Pass" system with pre-travel testing and 10-day AS quarantine.

- o FSM continues smaller repat flights with Guam/FSM quarantine and testing requirements.
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
  - o Supplies of Abbott ID NOW, Abbott BinaxNOW, and GeneXpert are low in some USAPI as travel testing demands increase; difficulties with procurement.






#### Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands






#### Federated States of Micronesia
















#### Republic of Palau
