Regional Summary:

- COVID-19 cases
 - o Guam has reported 19,366 total cases and 270 deaths with 63 new cases (↓ from 64 last week) and 3 new deaths reported this week (↑ from 1 new death last week); test positivity 1.8% (-- from 1.8% last week)
 - CNMI has reported 2,422 total cases and 8 deaths; 648 new cases (↓ from 712 last week) and 2 new deaths this week (↓ from 3 new deaths last week); cases identified from community-based testing and contact tracing; widespread community transmission ongoing
 - American Samoa has reported 11 total cases (all imported) with 1 new case reported this week identified on day 3 of quarantine among a fully vaccinated, asymptomatic traveler that arrived from Hawaii
 - Palau has reported 8 total cases (6 travelers in restricted movement, 2 contacts) with 0 new cases this week; no community transmission
 - FSM and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
 - Pediatric formulation of the Pfizer vaccine was ordered and delivered to each of the 6 USAPI, pediatric vaccination campaigns have started in American Samoa, CNMI, Guam, Majuro, Palau, and Yap
 - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 272,000 people in the region are fully vaccinated (78.2% of all eligible individuals / +1.1%)
 - An additional 23,000 people in the region are partially vaccinated (6.8% of eligible individuals in the region)
 - Note: eligible individuals are 5+ for American Samoa, CNMI, Guam, Majuro, Palau, and Yap 12+ for Kosrae, Kwajalein and RMI Outer Islands 18+ for Chuuk and Pohnpei
 - o Based on data submitted into Tiberius via WeblZ: **79% of all people <u>aged 5 years and older</u> have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 70% are fully vaccinated.** This percentage includes Pohnpei and Chuuk (FSM) who have yet to start vaccinating adolescents or children.
 - o Current percentages of eligible population aged 5 and over fully vaccinated (from Tiberius via WeblZ)
 - American Samoa: 74% (+1%)
 - FSM: Chuuk: 41% (--%), Kosrae: 58% (--%), Pohnpei: 49% (--%), Yap: 62% (--%)
 - Guam: 82% (+1%)
 RMI: 49% (--%)
 CNMI: 79% (+1%)
 Palau: 96% (--%)
 - Outer island vaccinations: Outer Island coverage rates from jurisdictional outer island outreach activities due to difficulty in determining denominators and true residence in Tiberius.
 - RMI Outer Islands: At least one dose 59% (+1%); Fully 46% (--%) (denominators adjusted based on OI reports and expanded to 12+)
 - Yap Outer Islands: At least one dose 98% (--%); Fully 95% (--%) (denominators adjusted to locally collected denominators for 18+)
 - Chuuk Outer Islands (out of the lagoon): Fully 31% (--%) (OI numbers are incomplete)
 - Pohnpei Outer Islands: Fully 63% (--%) (denominator adjusted based on OI reports for 18+)
 - Boosters: A total of 52,900 boosters/additional doses have been provided across the USAPI: American Samoa: 3,072; FSM: 3,270; Guam: 30,459;
 RMI: 900; CNMI: 11,854; Palau: 3,345
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
 - Guam is allowing vaccinated travelers or unvaccinated travelers with negative test 72 hours prior to arrival to enter without testing or quarantine.
 - CNMI is allowing vaccinated travelers with approval to enter without quarantine with testing on arrival and unvaccinated travelers to enter with facility quarantine requirement for 7 days with testing on day 7.
 - o Palau is running regular Guam and Taiwan flights with restriction of movement for vaccinated travelers with negative PCR test within 3 days of departure to Palau or negative antigen test within 1 day of departure to Palau and testing on day 4.

- o RMI has regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/in-country quarantine and testing requirements.
- o AS is running HNL flights using "Talofa Pass" system with pre-travel testing and 10-day AS quarantine.
- o FSM continues smaller repat flights with Guam/FSM quarantine and testing requirements.
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
 - Supplies of Abbott ID NOW, Abbott BinaxNOW, and GeneXpert are low in some USAPI as travel testing demands increase; difficulties with procurement.




