#### **Regional Summary:**

- COVID-19 cases
  - Guam has reported 19,566 total cases and 270 deaths with 139 new cases (↑ from 61 last week) and 0 new deaths reported this week (– from 0 last week); test positivity 4.7% (↑ from 2.2% last week)
  - CNMI has reported 3,287 total cases and 14 deaths; 646 new cases ( $\uparrow$  from 219 last week) and 6 new deaths this week ( $\uparrow$  from 0 last week)
  - o American Samoa has reported 11 total cases (all imported) with 0 new cases reported this week
  - Palau has reported 10 total cases (8 travelers in restricted movement, 2 contacts) with 2 new cases this week detected among travelers on day 4 post-travel testing; contact tracing identified 49 contacts, all in quarantine with testing on days 1, 5 and 10
  - FSM and RMI have had no community transmission
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
  - Pediatric formulation of the Pfizer vaccine was ordered and delivered to each of the 6 USAPI, pediatric vaccination campaigns have started in American Samoa, Chuuk, CNMI, Guam, Kosrae, Majuro, Palau, and Yap
  - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 279,000 people in the region are fully vaccinated (78.8% of all eligible individuals / -2.4% / pediatric rollouts began in Kosrae and Yap and pediatric and adolescent rollouts began in Chuuk; denominators were adjusted to include newly eligible populations)
    - An additional 20,000 people in the region are partially vaccinated (5.5% of eligible individuals in the region)
    - Note: eligible individuals are 5+ for American Samoa, Chuuk, CNMI, Guam, Kosrae, Majuro, Palau, and Yap 12+ for Kwajalein and RMI Outer Islands – 18+ for Pohnpei
  - Based on data submitted into Tiberius via WebIZ: 80% of all people aged 5 years and older have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 71% are fully vaccinated. This percentage includes Pohnpei (FSM) who has yet to start vaccinating adolescents or children.
  - o Current percentages of eligible population aged 5 and over fully vaccinated (from Tiberius via WebIZ)
    - American Samoa: 76% (+1%)
    - FSM: Chuuk: 41% (--%), Kosrae: 59% (--%), Pohnpei: 49% (--%), Yap: 63% (--%)
    - Guam: 82% (--%)
    - RMI: 50% (--%)
    - CNMI: 82% (+1%)
    - Palau: 100% (+2%)
  - Outer island vaccinations: Outer Island coverage rates from jurisdictional outer island outreach activities due to difficulty in determining denominators and true residence in Tiberius.
    - RMI Outer Islands: At least one dose 59% (--%); Fully 46% (--%) (denominators adjusted based on OI reports and expanded to 12+)
    - Yap Outer Islands: At least one dose 98% (--%); Fully 95% (--%) (denominators adjusted to locally collected denominators for 18+)
    - Chuuk Outer Islands (out of the lagoon): Fully 31% (--%) (OI numbers are incomplete)
    - Pohnpei Outer Islands: Fully 63% (--%) (denominator adjusted based on OI reports for 18+)
  - Boosters: A total of 59,160 boosters/additional doses have been provided across the USAPI: American Samoa: 3,405; FSM: 3,669; Guam: 32,876; RMI: 1,222; CNMI: 13,708; Palau: 4,280
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
  - Guam is allowing vaccinated travelers or unvaccinated travelers with negative test 72 hours prior to arrival to enter without testing or quarantine.
  - CNMI is allowing vaccinated travelers with approval to enter without quarantine with testing on arrival and unvaccinated travelers to enter with facility quarantine requirement for 7 days with testing on day 7.
  - Palau is running regular Guam and Taiwan flights with restriction of movement for vaccinated travelers with negative PCR test within 3 days of departure to Palau or negative antigen test within 1 day of departure to Palau and testing on day 4.

- RMI has regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/in-country quarantine and testing requirements.
- AS is running HNL flights using "Talofa Pass" system with pre-travel testing and 10-day AS quarantine.
- FSM continues smaller repat flights with Guam/FSM quarantine and testing requirements.
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
  - Supplies of Abbott ID NOW, Abbott BinaxNOW, and GeneXpert are low in some USAPI as travel testing demands increase; difficulties with procurement.





#### US-affiliated Pacific Islands Region










#### Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands








