#### **Regional Summary:**

- COVID-19 cases
  - Guam has reported 20,594 total cases and 274 deaths with 1,028 new cases (↑ from 139 last week) and 4 new deaths reported this week (↑ from 0 last week); test positivity 14.6% (↑ from 4.7% last week)
  - CNMI has reported 3,561 total cases and 19 deaths; 274 new cases (↓ from 646 last week) and 5 new deaths this week (↓ from 6 last week)
  - Palau has reported 18 total cases (14 travelers in restricted movement, 4 contacts) with 8 new cases this week: 6 identified through day 4 postarrival testing and 2 from contact tracing
  - o American Samoa has reported 11 total cases (all imported) with 0 new cases reported this week
  - FSM and RMI have had no community transmission; 3 individuals repatriated to Kwajalein MB by USAG-KA tested positive in HI and will not be
    included in RMI's case count
- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 25 updated tables and figures listed below)
  - Pediatric formulation of the Pfizer vaccine was ordered and delivered to each of the 6 USAPI, pediatric vaccination campaigns have started in American Samoa, Chuuk, CNMI, Guam, Kosrae, Majuro, Palau, and Yap
  - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 280,000 people in the region are fully vaccinated (76.8% of all eligible individuals / -2.0%)
    - An additional 19,000 people in the region are partially vaccinated (5.3% of eligible individuals in the region)
    - Note: eligible individuals are 5+ for American Samoa, Chuuk, CNMI, Guam, Kosrae, Majuro, Palau, and Yap 12+ for Kwajalein and RMI Outer Islands 18+ for Pohnpei
  - Based on data submitted into Tiberius via WeblZ: 80% of all people aged 5 years and older have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine; 72% are fully vaccinated. This percentage includes Pohnpei (FSM) who have yet to start vaccinating adolescents or children.
  - Current percentages of eligible population aged 5 and over fully vaccinated (from Tiberius via WeblZ)
    - American Samoa: 82% (+6%)
    - FSM: Chuuk: 41% (--%), Kosrae: 59% (--%), Pohnpei: 49% (--%), Yap: 63% (--%)

      Palau: 100% (--%)
  - Outer island vaccinations: Outer Island coverage rates from jurisdictional outer island outreach activities due to difficulty in determining denominators and true residence in Tiberius.
    - RMI Outer Islands: At least one dose 59% (--%); Fully 46% (--%) (denominators adjusted based on OI reports and expanded to 12+)
    - Yap Outer Islands: At least one dose 98% (--%); Fully 95% (--%) (denominators adjusted to locally collected denominators for 18+)
    - Chuuk Outer Islands (out of the lagoon): Fully 31% (--%) (OI numbers are incomplete)
    - Pohnpei Outer Islands: Fully 63% (--%) (denominator adjusted based on OI reports for 18+)
  - Boosters: A total of 63,570 boosters/additional doses have been provided across the USAPI: American Samoa: 3,971; FSM: 3,887; Guam: 34,428;
     RMI: 1,605; CNMI: 14,552; Palau: 5,127
- COVID-19 Containment strategies
  - Guam is allowing vaccinated travelers or unvaccinated travelers with negative test 72 hours prior to arrival to enter without testing or quarantine.
  - cNMI is allowing vaccinated travelers with approval to enter without quarantine with testing on arrival and unvaccinated travelers to enter with facility quarantine requirement for 5 days with testing on day 5.
  - o Palau is running regular Guam and Taiwan flights with restriction of movement for vaccinated travelers with negative PCR test within 3 days of departure to Palau or negative antigen test within 1 day of departure to Palau and testing on day 4.

- o RMI has regular repat flights ongoing with HNL/in-country quarantine and testing requirements.
- o AS is running HNL flights using "Talofa Pass" system with pre-travel testing and 10-day AS quarantine.
- o FSM continues smaller repat flights with Guam/FSM quarantine and testing requirements.
- COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity
  - Supplies of Abbott ID NOW, Abbott BinaxNOW, and GeneXpert are low in some USAPI as travel testing demands increase; difficulties with procurement.





#### Age group coverage rates as of 12/31/2021







### Age group coverage rates as of 12/31/2021







#### Age group coverage rates as of 12/31/2021







#### Age group coverage rates as of 12/31/2021







#### Age group coverage rates as of 12/31/2021








#### Age group coverage rates as of 12/31/2021




#### Republic of the Marshall Islands

#### Age group coverage rates as of 12/31/2021






#### Republic of Palau
