• COVID-19 Containment strategies

- Guam is allowing travelers to enter with 10-day home quarantine with exemptions for vaccinated travelers and unvaccinated travelers with negative
 PCR test 72 hours or antigen test 24 hours prior to arrival.
- CNMI is allowing vaccinated travelers to enter without quarantine and unvaccinated travelers to enter with 5-day quarantine, both with testing on day 5.
- o Palau is running regular Guam and Taiwan flights with restriction of movement for vaccinated travelers with negative PCR test within 3 days of departure to Palau or negative antigen test within 1 day of departure to Palau and testing on day 4.
- o AS has suspended all air and sea travel under Code Red.
- o RMI has regular repatriation flights ongoing with HNL with in-country quarantine and testing requirements.
- o FSM has suspended all repatriation flights.

COVID-19 Laboratory Testing capacity

 Supplies of Abbott ID NOW, Abbott BinaxNOW, and GeneXpert are low in some USAPI as outbreak testing demands increase; difficulties with procurement.





US-affiliated Pacific Islands Region




