 jurisdictions except for most outer islands in FSM and RMI
 - Based on jurisdictional reports: a total of 309,136 people in the region are fully vaccinated (82.0% of all eligible individuals / +0.3%)
 - An additional 27,305 people in the region are partially vaccinated (7.3% of eligible individuals in the region)
 - Note: eligible individuals are 5+ for American Samoa, Chuuk, Northern Mariana Islands, Guam, Kosrae, Kwajalein, Majuro, Palau, Pohnpei and Yap


