#### **COVID-19 Containment strategies**

- Guam no longer requires quarantine for travelers and DPHSS has ceased processing travelers at ports of entry.
- CNMI is allowing vaccinated travelers to enter without quarantine, unvaccinated travelers must home quarantine for 5 days.
- o Palau is running regular Guam and Taiwan flights with restriction of movement for vaccinated travelers with negative PCR test within 3 days of departure to Palau or negative antigen test within 1 day of departure to Palau and testing on day 4.
- Solution AS is running limited flights under Talofa Pass system with in-country quarantine and testing requirements and has not yet opened borders.
- o RMI has regular repatriation flights ongoing with HNL (3 days) and in-country quarantine (14 days) and testing requirements.
- FSM has resumed repatriation flights and has reduced guarantine to 5 days in Guam then at least 5 days in FSM with testing requirements.


