Regional Summary:

- COVID-19 cases
 - Guam has reported 56,625 total cases with 385 deaths and 54,632 recovered; 1,417 new cases (↓ from 1,607 last report) and 5 new deaths this report (↑ from 4 last report); 7-day average test positivity 7.9% (↓ from 8.8% last report); 19 hospitalized cases (↓ from 20 last report)
 - CNMI has reported 12,925 total cases with 38 deaths and 12,629 recovered; 227 new cases (↓ from 505 last report) and 0 new deaths this report (↓ from 3 last report); 7-day average test positivity 5.5% (↓ from 7.4% last report); 5 new COVID-19-related hospitalizations (-- from 5 last report)
 - American Samoa has reported 8,031 total cases with 33 deaths and 7,873 recovered; 276 new cases (↓ from 295 last report) and 0 new deaths this report (-- from 0 last report); 3,159 (39%) treated with therapeutics; 2 new COVID-19-related hospitalizations (↓ from 10 last report)
 - FSM has reported 7,125 total cases and 18 deaths (Pohnpei: 5,847 cases with 15 deaths; Kosrae: 1,093 cases with 3 deaths; 128 cases with 0 deaths in Yap; 57 cases with 0 deaths in Chuuk); 2,930 new cases and 14 new deaths since last report; 10 cases currently hospitalized in Pohnpei (99 total hospitalizations in FSM recorded); community transmission ongoing in Pohnpei and Kosrae though case rate has slowed in recent weeks; cases continue to be identified in border quarantine in Yap and Chuuk
 - Palau has reported 5,246 total cases with 6 deaths and 5,238 recovered; 14 new cases (↓ from 25 last report) and 0 new deaths this report (-- from 0 last report); 0 cases hospitalized (-- from 0 last report)
 - RMI has identified community transmission in Majuro, Kwajalein and Wotje with 1,250 total cases reported (1,145 Majuro, 103 Kwajalein and 2 in Wotje) and 2 deaths; community cases linked to quarantine spillover; 9 total hospitalizations; rapid spread in Majuro with 535 cases in last 24 hours

- COVID-19 Vaccine distribution summary (See USAPI Vaccine Summary with 22 updated tables and figures listed below)
 - Vaccination for children 6 months through 5 years of age are now available in all USAPI jurisdictions.
 - Based on data submitted into Tiberius via WebIZ: **94% of all people aged 5 years and older have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine (--% from last report); 84% are fully vaccinated (--% from last report); and 41% have had at least one additional dose (--% from last report).**

- COVID-19 Containment strategies
 - American Samoa is running limited flights under the Talofa Pass system for vaccinated travelers with pre-departure testing (for travelers from outside the US and Samoa) and arrival testing for all travelers with mask requirement on vessel until receipt of arrival testing results.
 - CNMI no longer requires quarantine for travelers.
 - FSM enacted Healthy Border Act on August 1 which removed quarantine requirement; Chuuk and Yap continue state-mandated travel quarantine with testing, travel requirements include vaccination and pre-arrival negative test (for states without active transmission)
 - Guam no longer requires quarantine for travelers.
 - Palau is running regular Guam and Taiwan flights for vaccinated travelers with mitigation orders on arrival.
 - RMI has regular repatriation flights ongoing with in-country quarantine of 14 days and testing requirements.

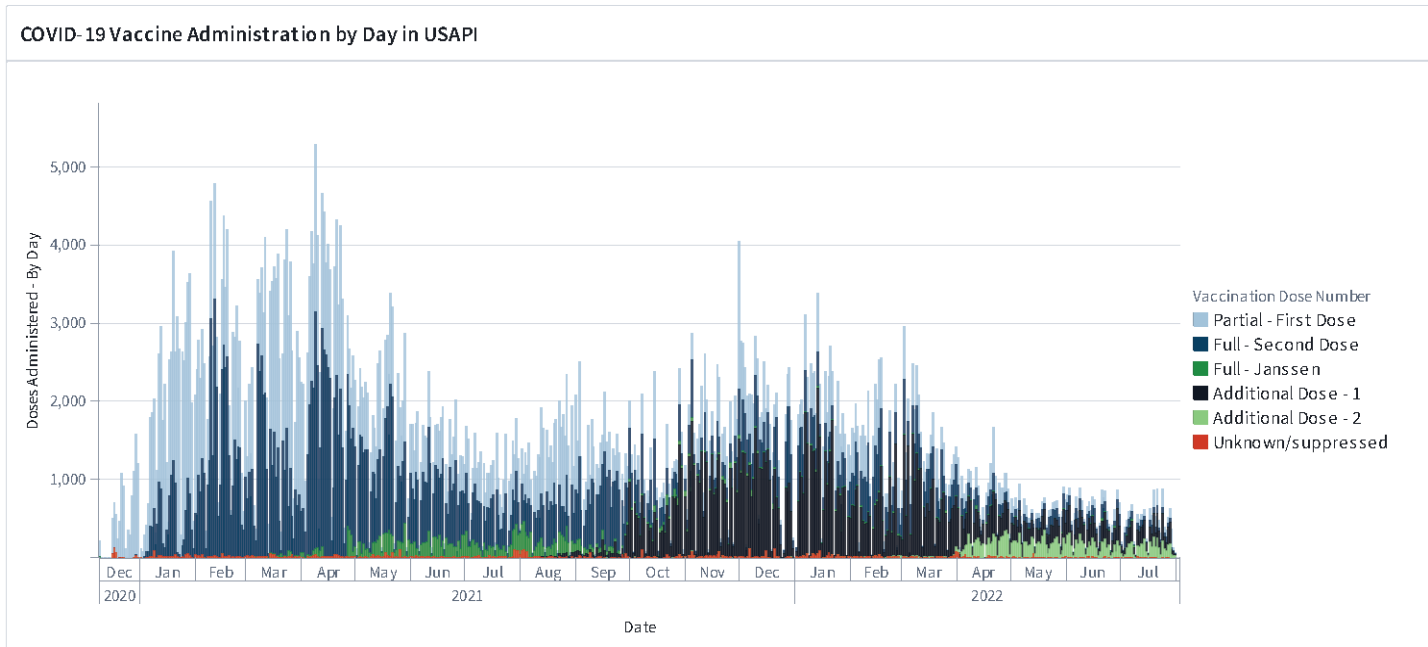

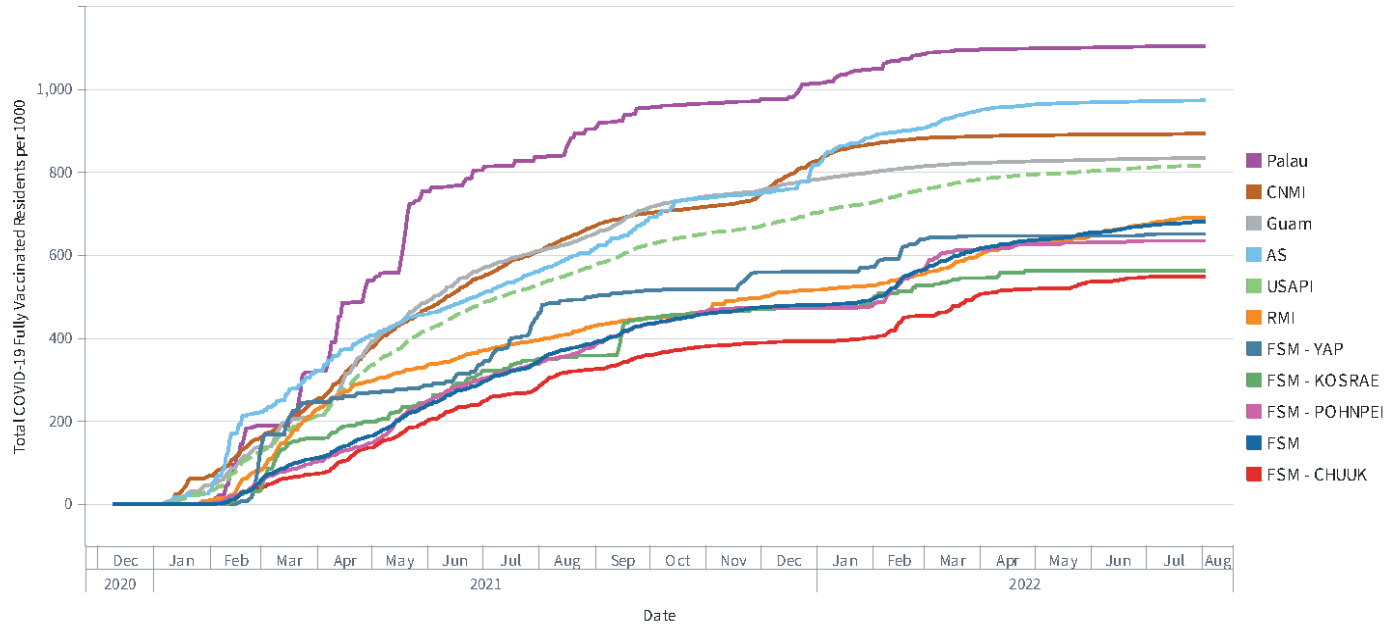
US-affiliated Pacific Islands Region

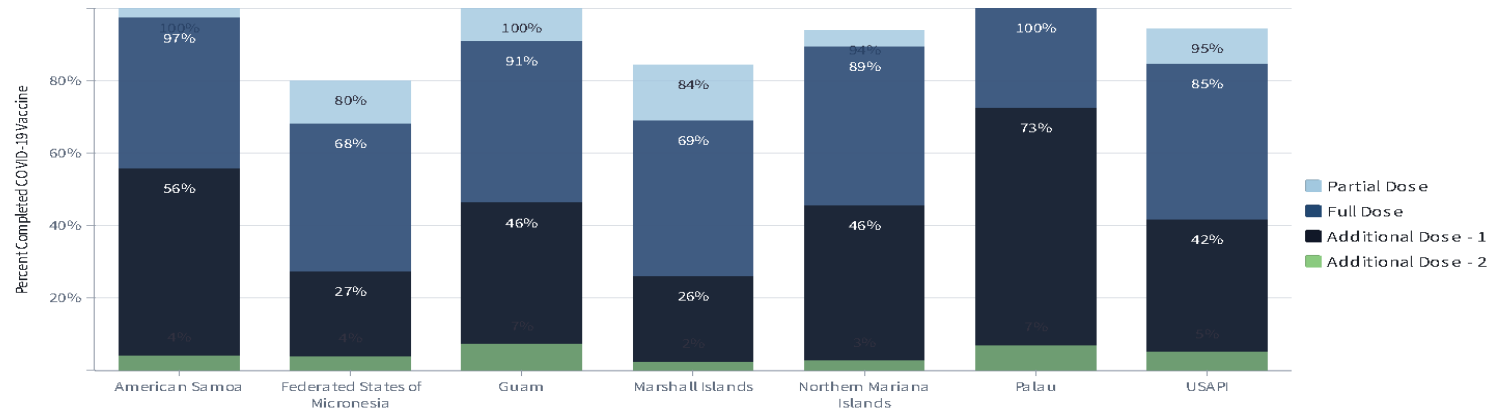

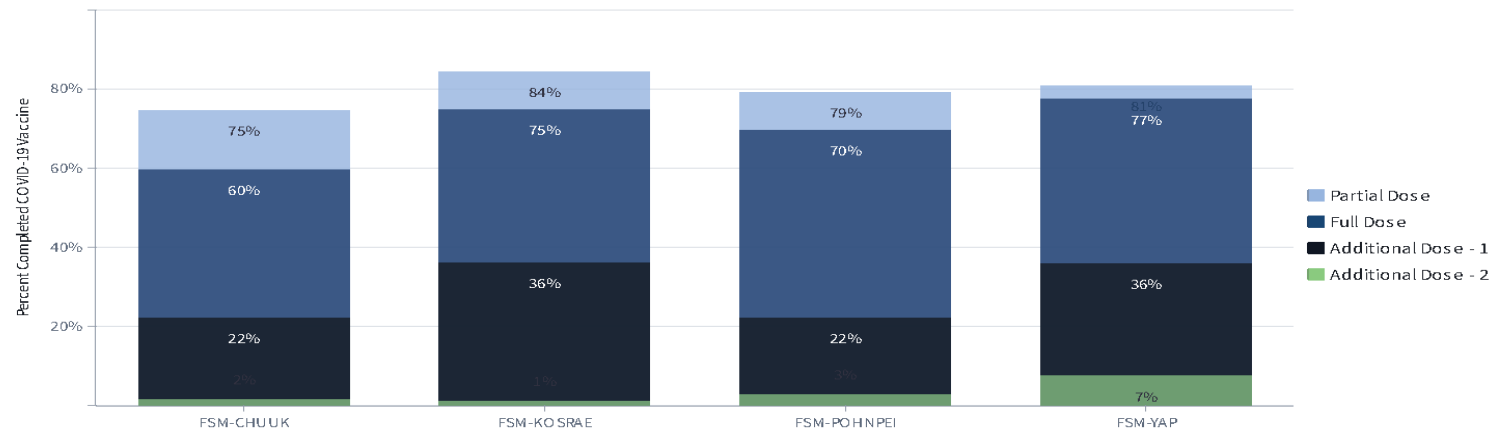

Striving for 80%: USAPI 5+ COVID-19 Vaccine Progress



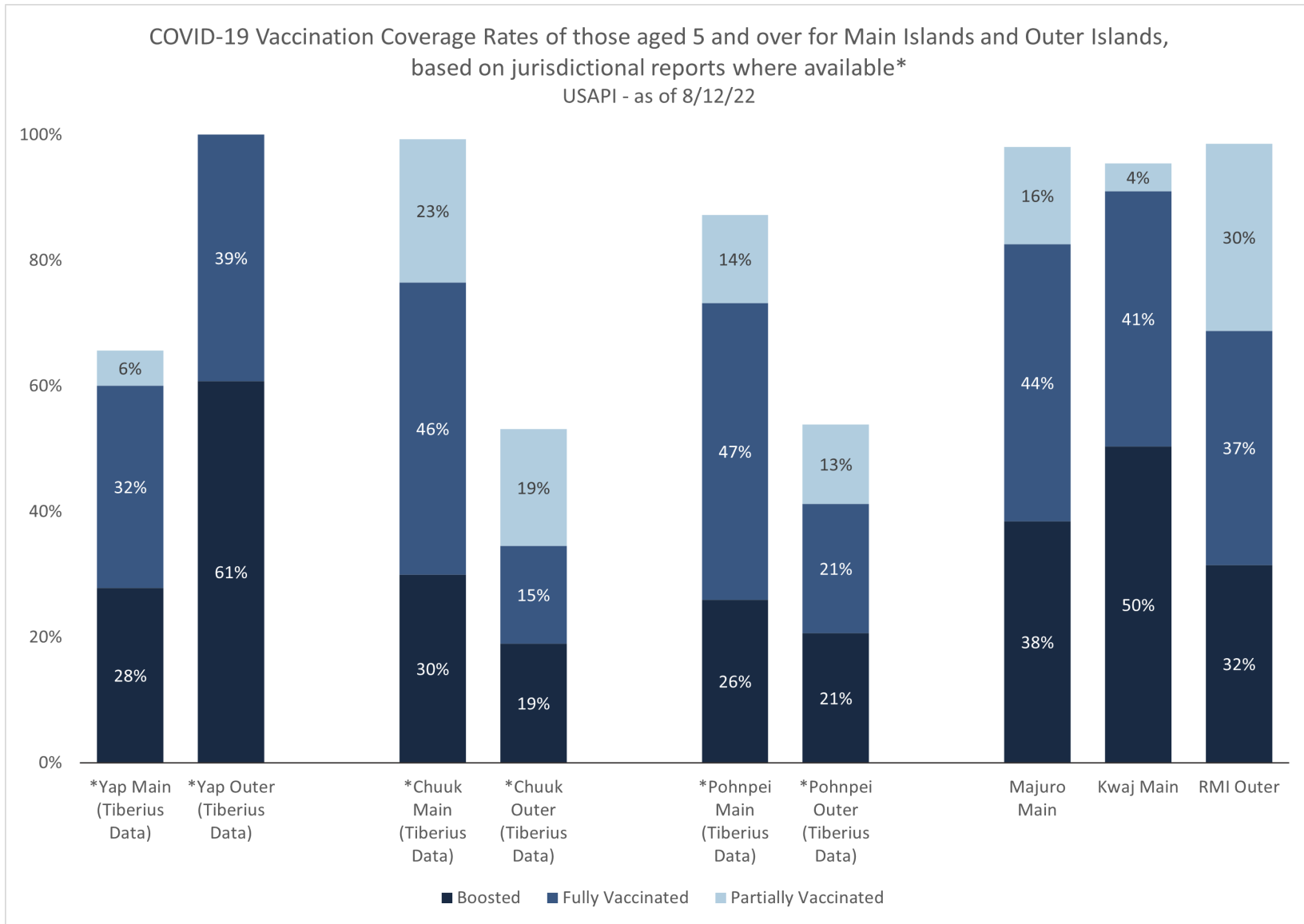

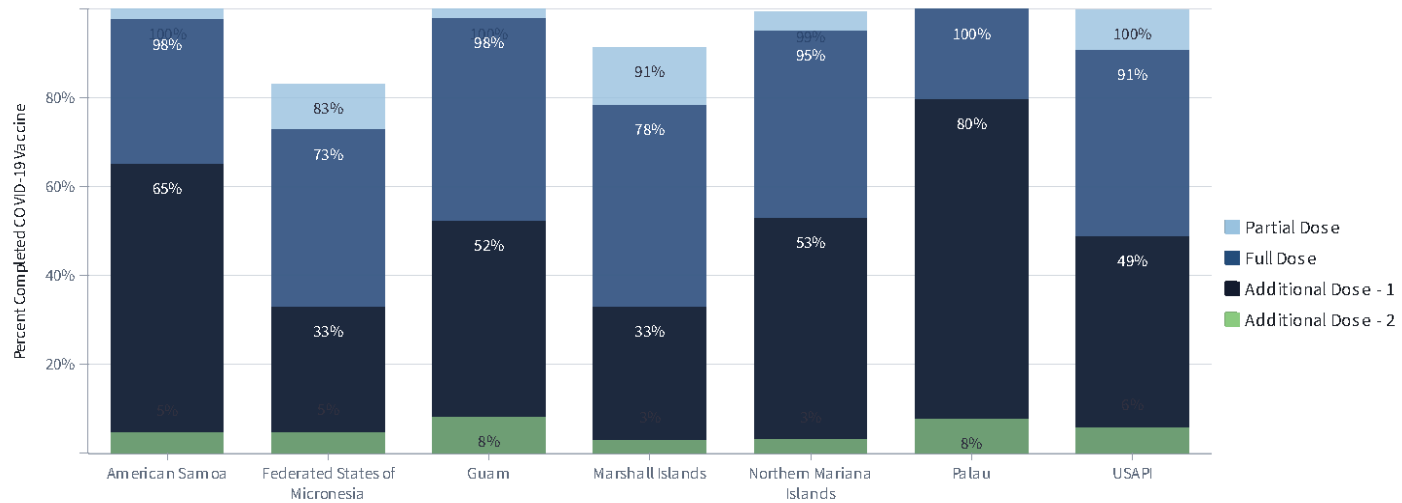

Striving for 80% USAPI 12+ COVID-19 Vaccine Progress



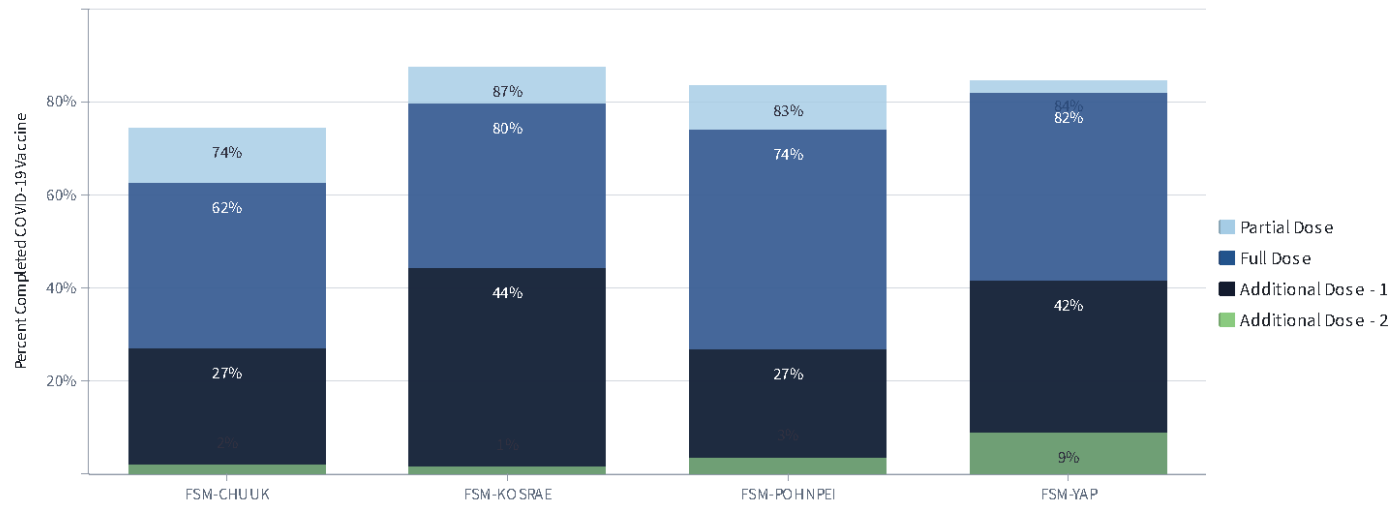

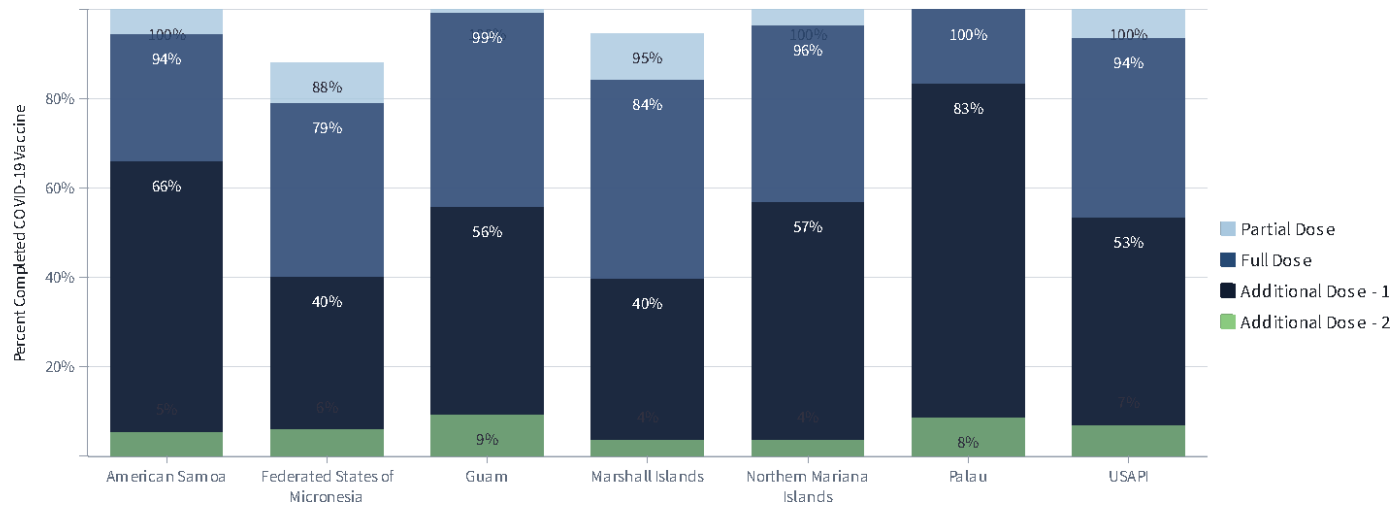
Striving for 80% USAPI 12+ COVID-19 Vaccine Progress (FSM States)

Striving for 80%: USAPI 18+ COVID-19 Vaccine Progress



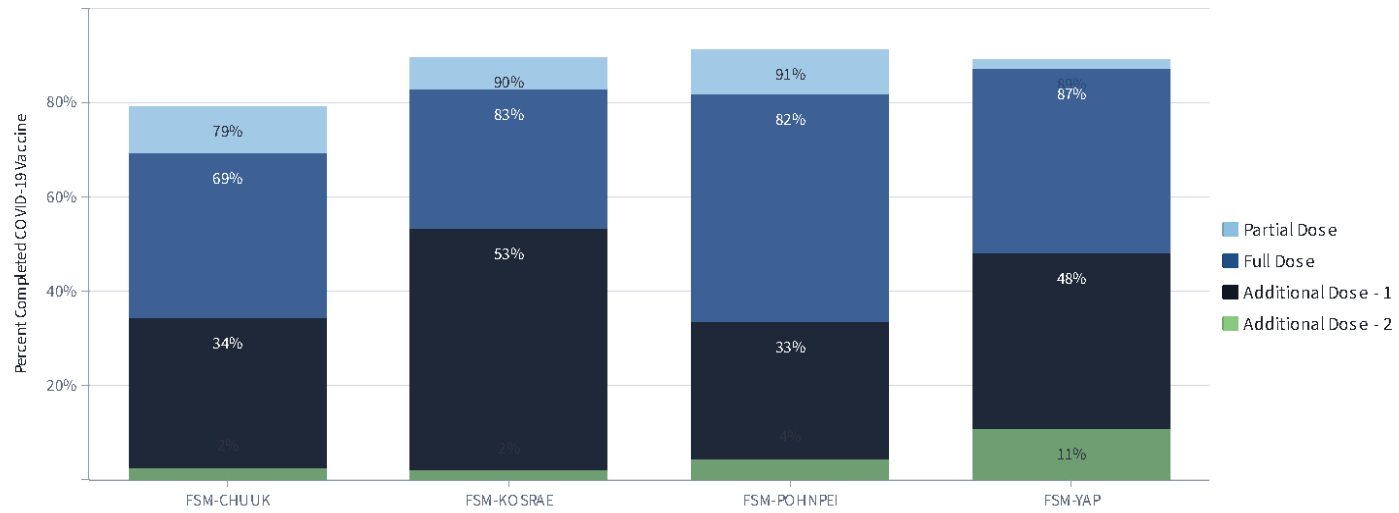

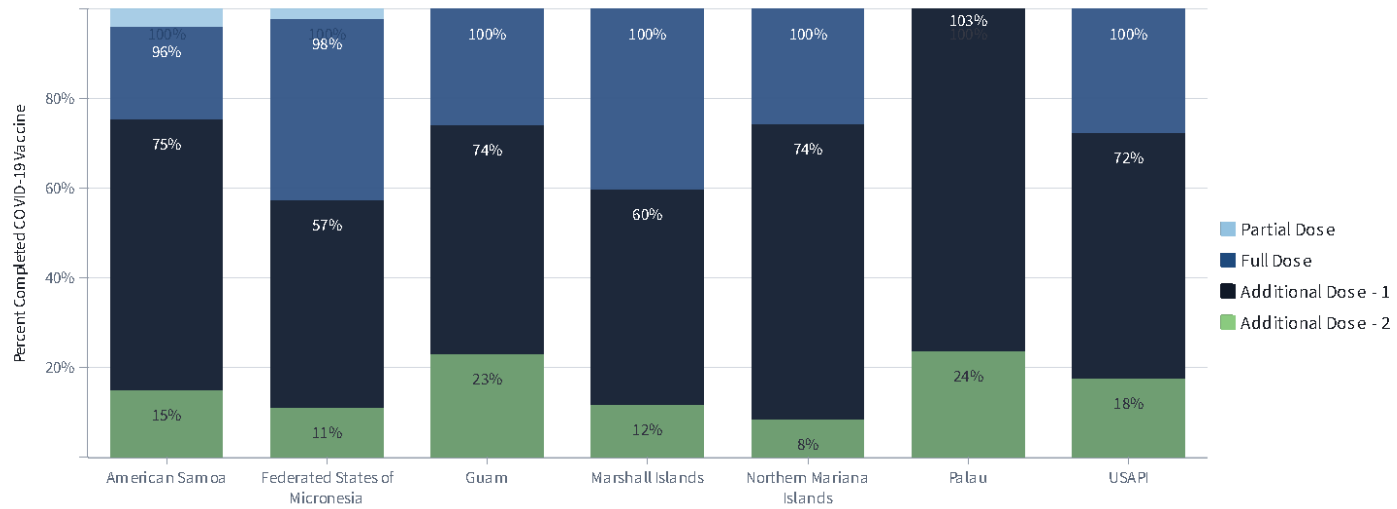

USAPI COVID-19 Vaccine Progress: 50 yrs and over



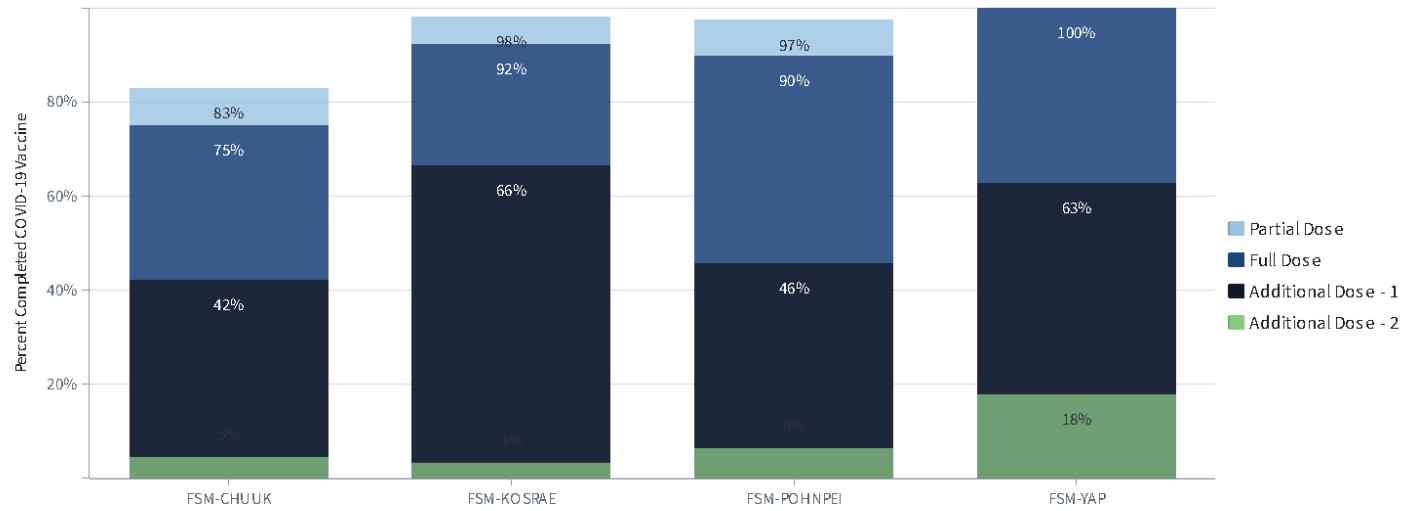

USAPI COVID-19 Vaccine Progress: 50 yrs and over (FSM States)



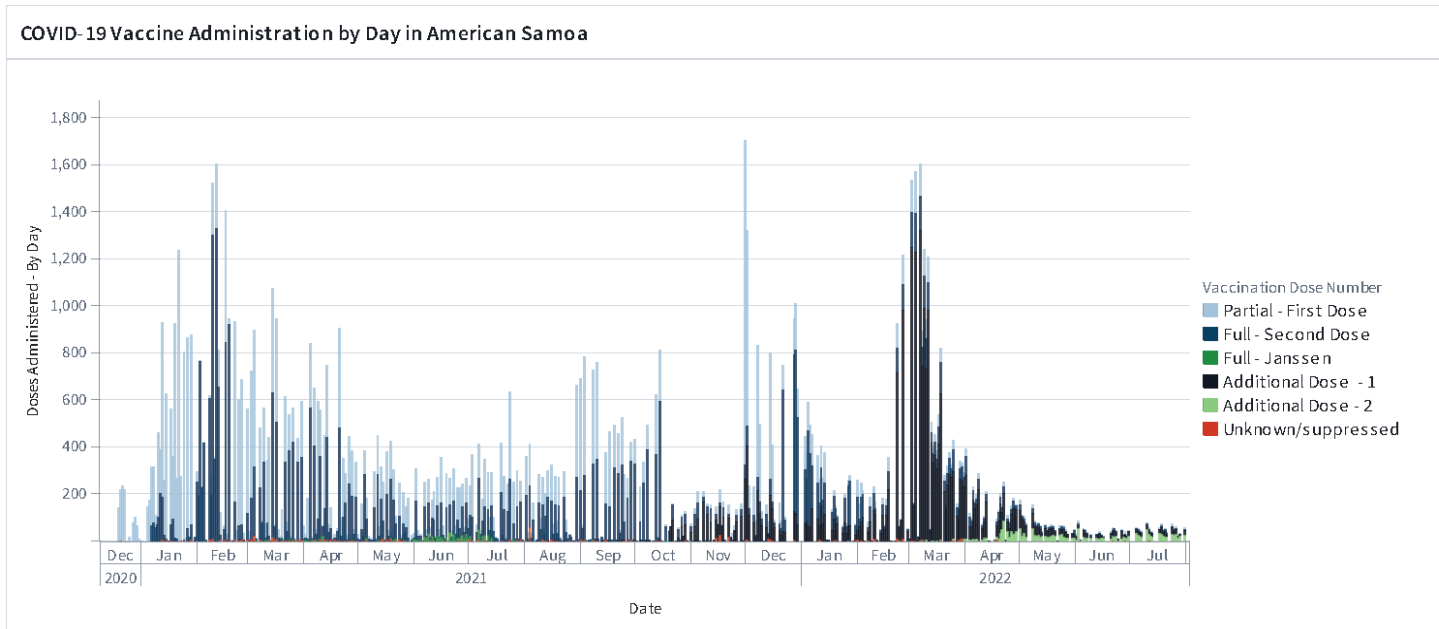

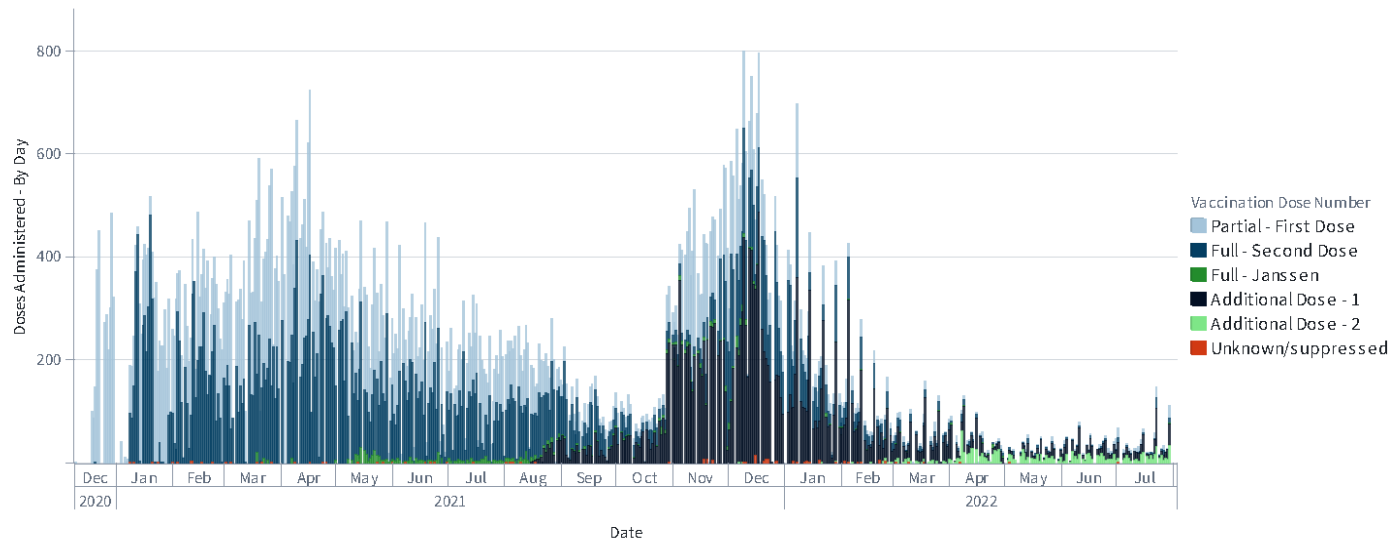

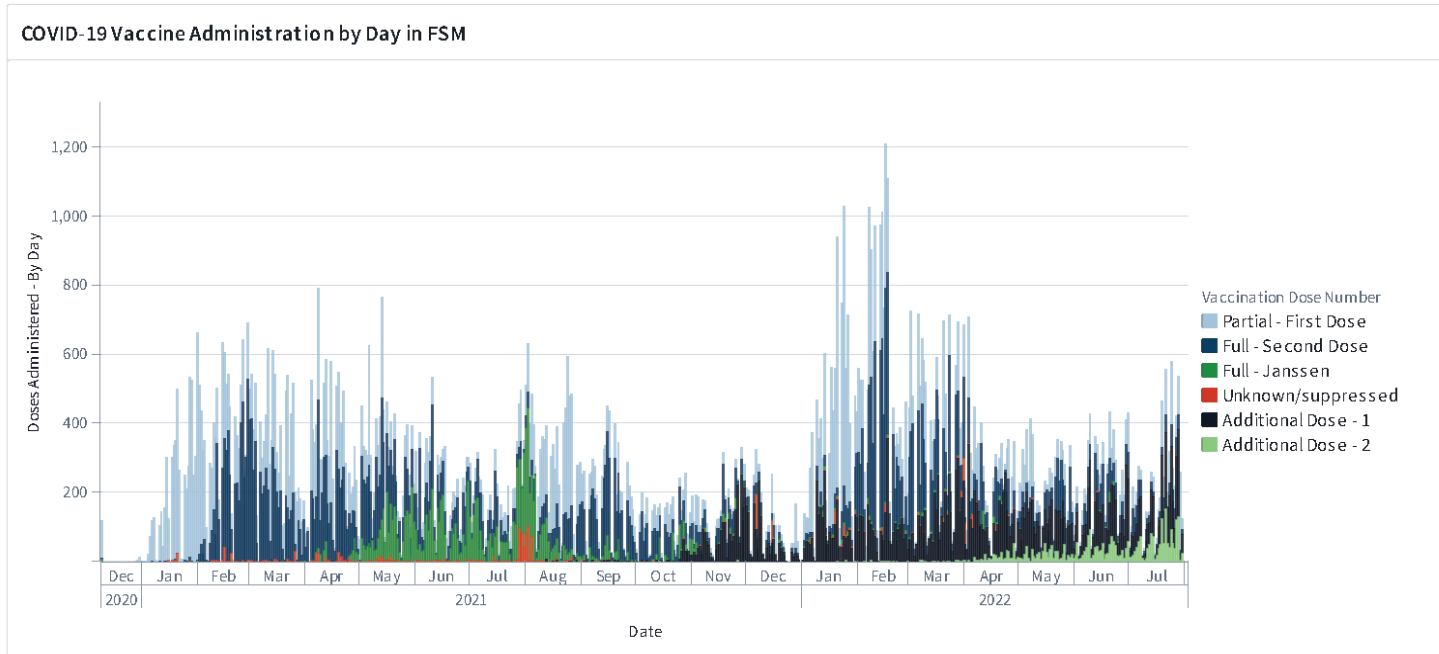
COVID-19 Vaccine Administration by Day in CNMI

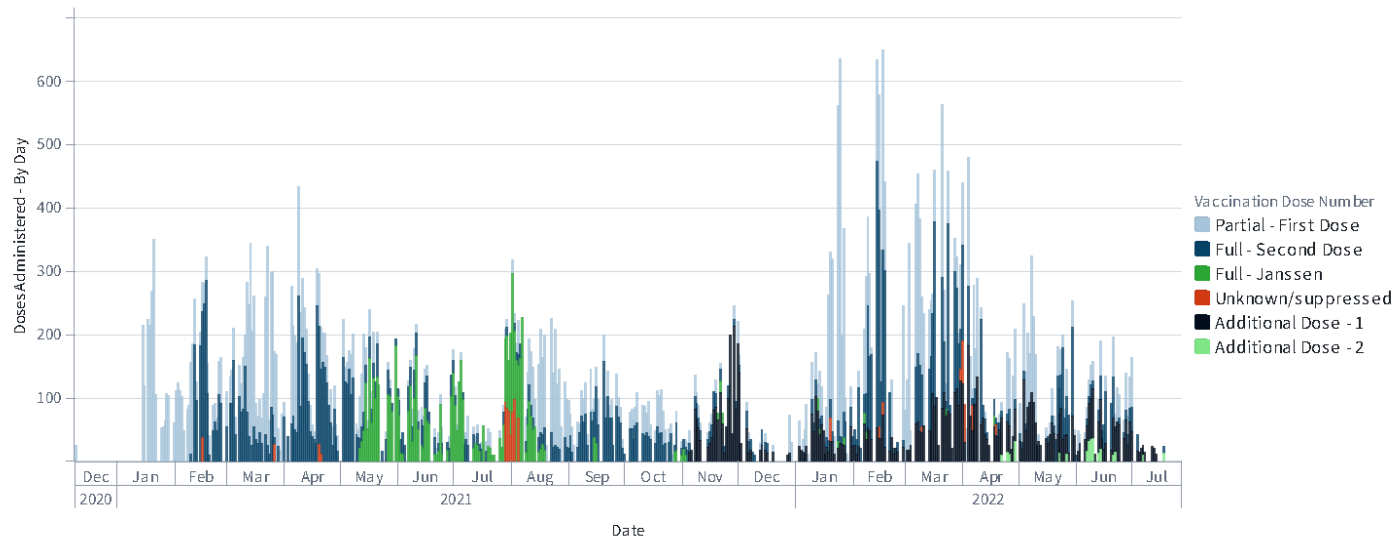

COVID-19 Vaccine Administration by Day in FSM - Chuuk

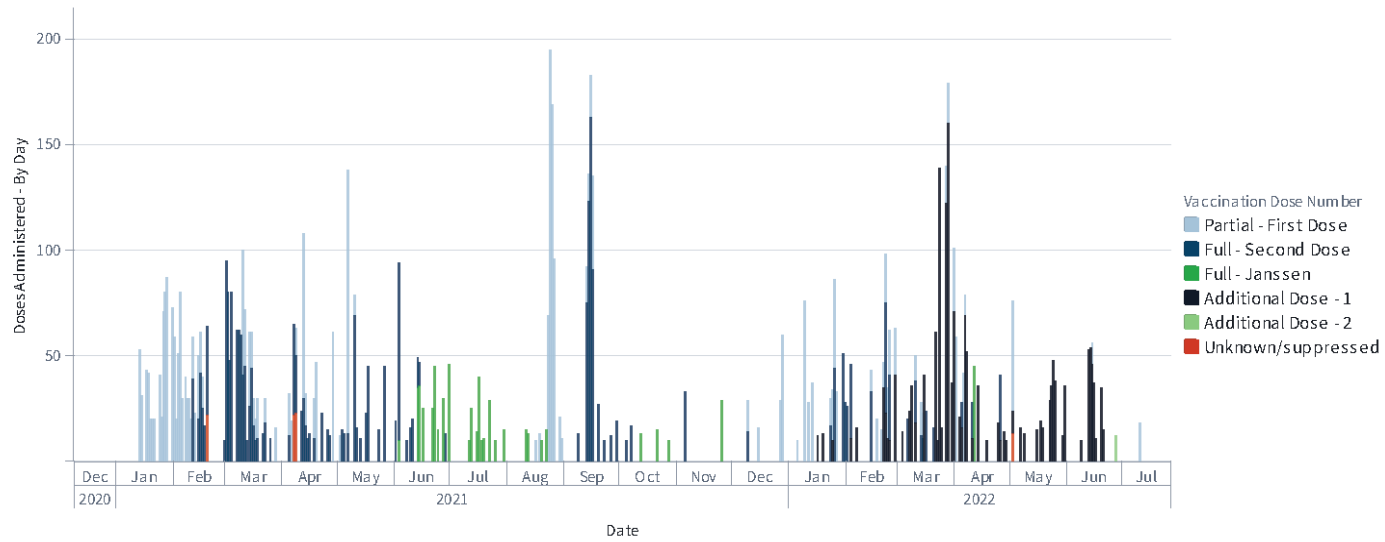

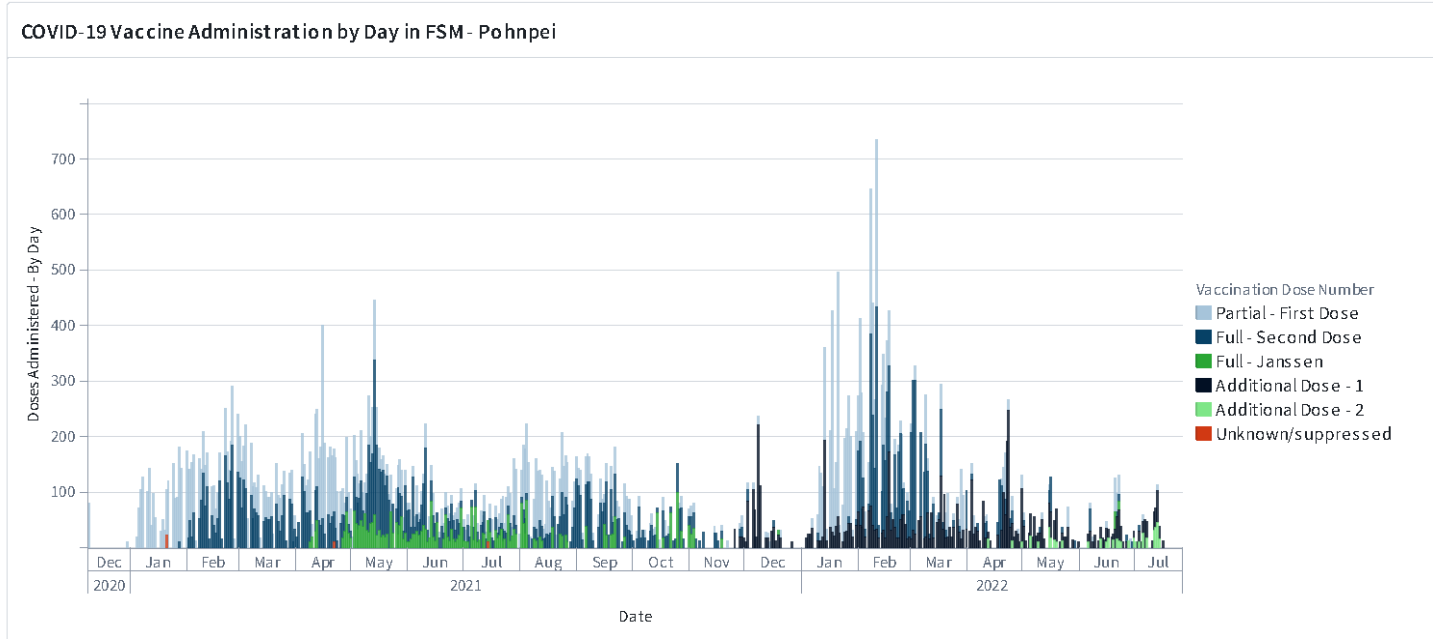
COVID-19 Vaccine Administration by Day in FSM - Kosrae

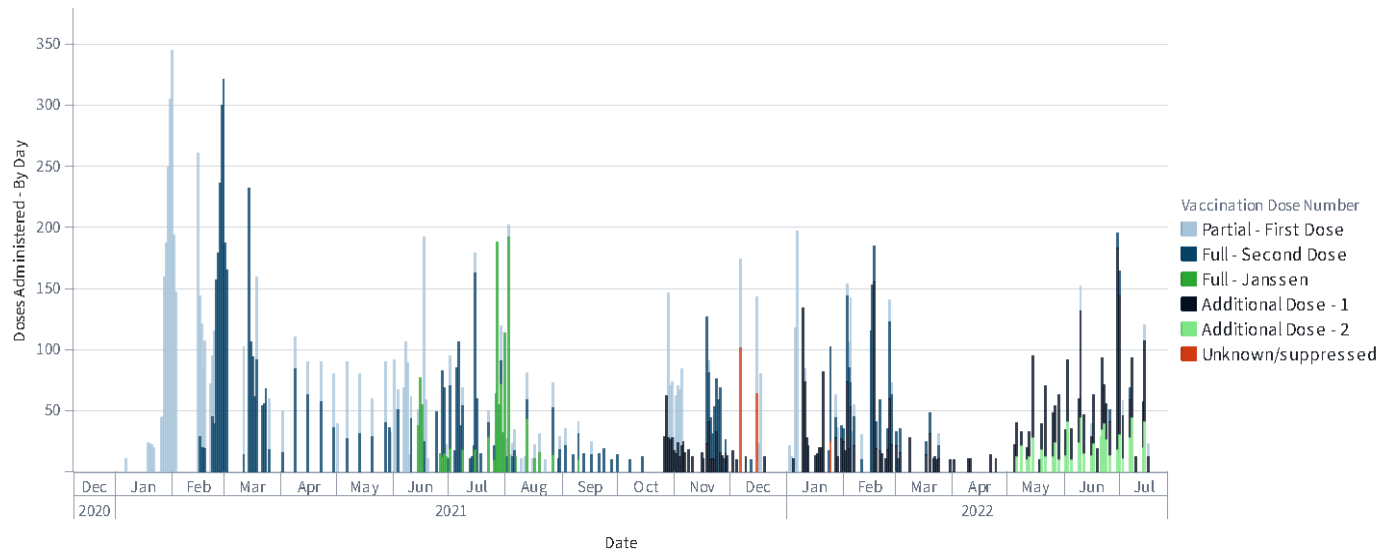

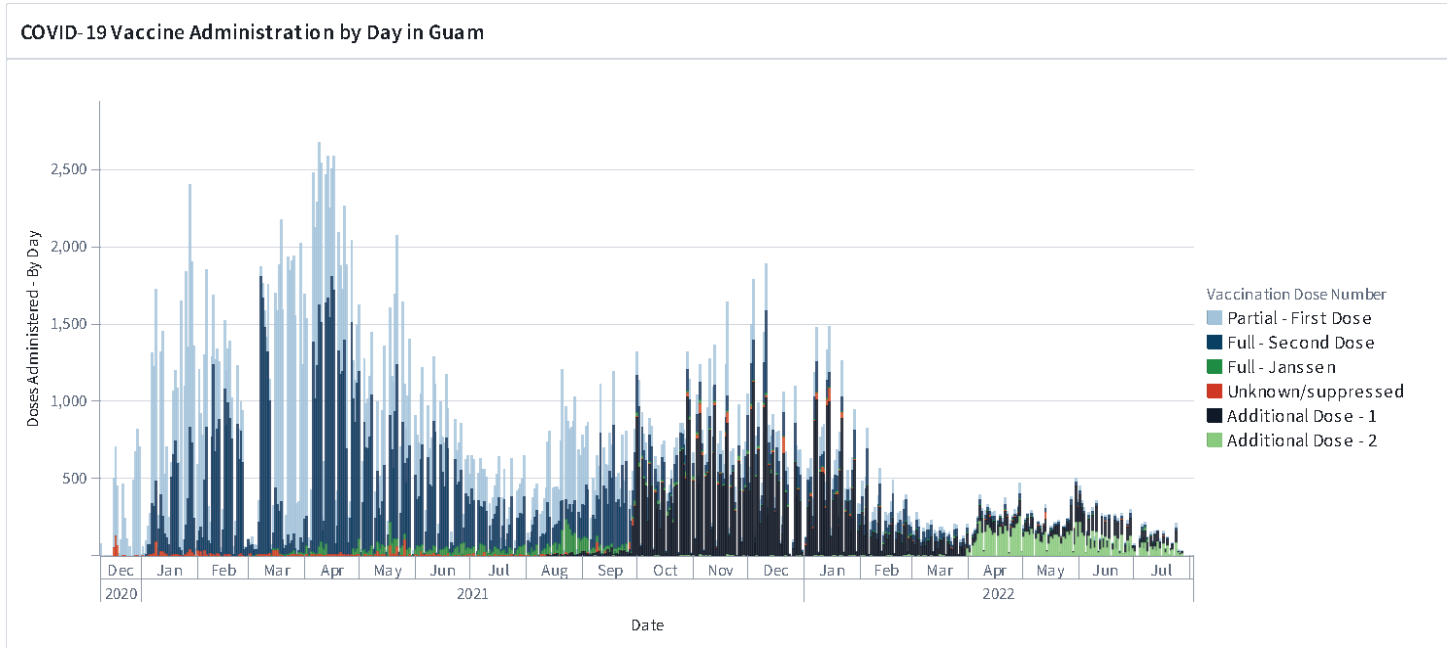
COVID-19 Vaccine Administration by Day in FSM - Yap

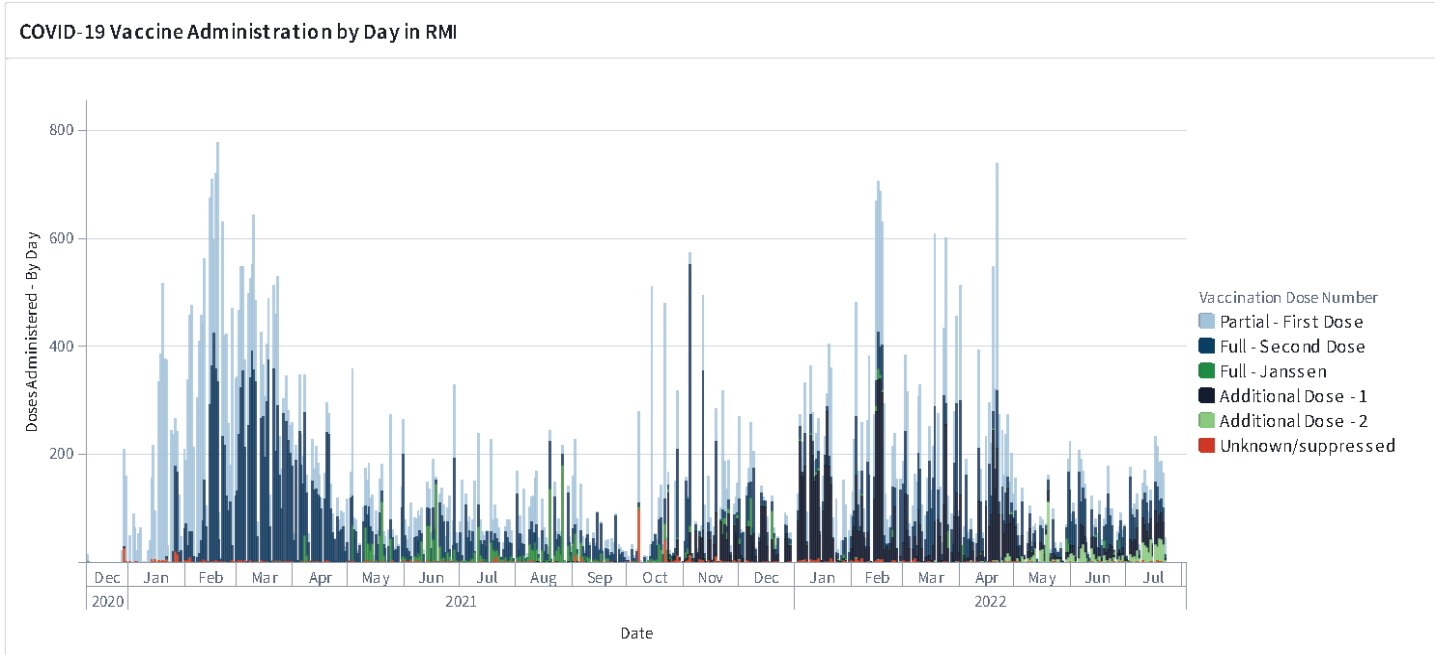

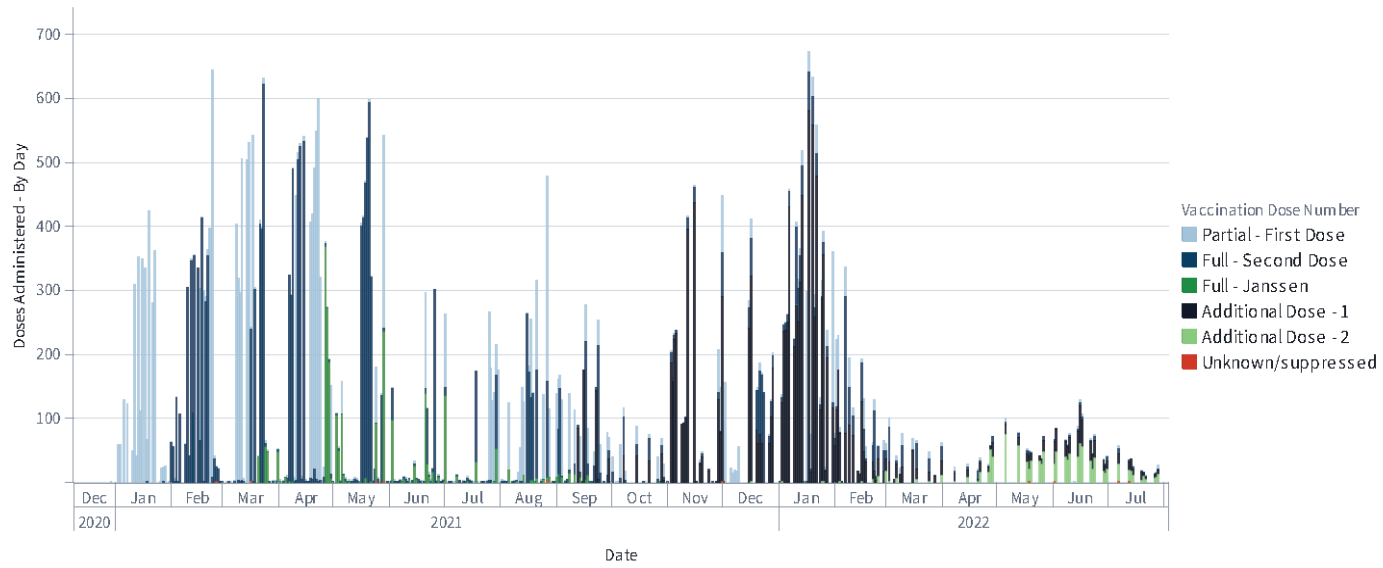
