#### COVID-19 Containment strategies

- American Samoa runs limited flights under the Talofa Pass system for vaccinated travelers with pre-departure testing (for travelers from outside the US and Samoa) and arrival testing for all travelers with mask requirements on the vessel until receipt of arrival testing results.
- FSM runs regular flights for fully vaccinated travelers. Yap, Pohnpei, and Kosrae have no quarantine or testing requirements for entry; Chuuk continues state-mandated 14-day travel quarantine and pre-/post-arrival testing requirements.
- Guam has no entry requirements.
- RMI has re-opened its borders and ended its Safe Travel program. Travelers must be fully vaccinated with primary series and booster as eligible; required mask-wearing enroute, testing on arrival, and 5-day home quarantine. Travel to neighboring islands is restricted.
- CNMI has no entry requirements.
- Palau runs regular Guam and Taiwan flights for vaccinated travelers with mitigation orders on arrival.


